A Level & A+ Programmes

Sixth Form Academic Route (Level 3)

In 2022, 87.3% of students achieved A*-C grades in their A Level results.

Quick overview: Typically, students choose to study three A Level subjects over two years. However, you can choose to study two A Level subjects and one A+ Programme (BTEC Extended Certificate – equivalent to one A Level) over two years.

To study, you will need: A minimum of five GCSEs at grade 5 or above including maths and English Language in subjects relevant to your chosen course.*

What you can do next: You can progress to university, a university level course here at NSCG, a higher apprenticeship at NSCG or to employment.

Vocational Programmes

Sixth Form Vocational Route (Level 3)

In 2022, 49% of Level 3 vocational programme students achieved high grades of DDD or above (equivalent to three 'A' grades at A Level)

Quick overview: Choose from a wide-range of courses which you will study for two years.

To study, you will need: A minimum of four or more high grades at GCSE in subjects relevant to the course you'd like to study, including maths and/or English Language at grade 4 or above.

What you can do next: You can progress to university, a university level course here at NSCG, an apprenticeship at NSCG or to employment.

Progression and Skills Pathways

Quick overview: If you're not quite ready to join a Level 3 programme, our vocational Progression Pathways allow you to study at Entry Level, Level 1 or Level 2 and will prepare you to progress onto a higher level vocational course.

Level 2, Level 1 & Entry Level

Alternatively, if you want skills based training in areas such as hairdressing, beauty and construction, you'll start your journey on a Level 1 Skills Pathway, before progressing to higher levels.

Whichever path you choose, your personalised study programme will help you to prepare for your next steps whether it's university, an apprenticeship, further training or employment.

T-Levels

Sixth Form T-Level Route (Level 3)

Quick overview: A T-Level is an industryrecognised, two-year course that is an alternative to A Levels and vocational programmes. They bring classroom learning and an extended industry placement (at least 45 days) together on a course designed with businesses and employers.

To study, you will need: Typically, a minimum of five GCSEs at grade 5 or above, including maths and English Language, in subjects relevant to your chosen course.*

What you can do next: You can progress to university, a university level course here at NSCG, an apprenticeship at NSCG or to employment.

Apprenticeships

Available at Levels 2 to 5

Our apprenticeship achievement rates are more than 13% above the national average.

Quick overview: Apprenticeships are great if you want to jump straight into the world of work, earn a wage and pick up technical and practical skills while you study for a nationally recognised qualification.

To study, you will need: Two or more GCSEs at grade 4 or above in subjects relevant to your course. However, in some sectors, employers ask for a minimum of grade 4/5 in maths and English.

What you can do next: You can progress to a higher level apprenticeship, full-time course at NSCG or full-time employment.

GCSE Maths & English

If you haven't yet achieved grades 9-4 in these important subjects, maths and/or English sessions will be on your timetable and you'll retake qualifications alongside your main course.

A Levels & A+ Program

If you are an academic learner and want to progress to university or a higher apprenticeship, our two-year A Level or A+ Programmes could be a great option for you.

Most students study three subjects. But if you have a track record of high achievement, you might decide to study four A Level subjects, or take an Extended Project Qualification as your fourth subject. You must be comfortable studying for, and taking, external exams because that's how most A Level subjects are assessed at the end of the two years.

An A+ Programme lets you combine A Level subjects with a BTEC Extended Certificate for a better balance of exams and coursework.



T-Levels are a BRAND NEW two-year qualification that you can study as an alternative to A Levels or vocational programmes and on completion, you'll receive an industry recognised qualification that is equivalent to three A Levels.

They bring classroom learning and an extended industry placement together on a course designed with businesses and employers.

Each T-Level includes an in-depth industry placement that lasts at least 45 days. Students get valuable experience in the workplace; employers get early sight of the new talent in their industry.





Skills & Progressic Pathways

If you're not quite ready to join a Level 3 programme, our vocational Progression Pathways allow you to study at Entry Level, Level 1 or Level 2.

Whether you've struggled at school, lack confidence or need an extra push these programmes will help prepare you to progress onto a higher level vocational course, employment or an apprenticeship. Alongside your chosen subject, there is also a big focus on improving your maths and English skills.

Alternatively, if you are looking for skills-based training in an area like Hairdressing & Beauty or Construction, as part of our Skills Pathway, you'll start your journey on a Level 1 course and progress to higher levels.

If this is you:

- · I like applied learning, but I want to build my skills, knowledge and confidence first
- Then I'd like to study a higher-level vocational or skills programme, get an apprenticeship or get a job






