ABOUT CWSP

CORPORATE WORK STUDY PROGRAM SAN DIEGO HIGH SCHOOL

The Corporate Work Study Program (CWSP) is a separately incorporated entity within Cristo Rey San Diego High School that places every student in a professional job five full days a month, all four years of high school. Cristo Rey students are employees of CWSP, not of your company. Corporate Partners pay a competitive annual service fee to the program for students' college-preparatory education. CWSP operates similarly to a temporary staffing agency with the explicit awareness and approval of relevant state agencies and the U.S. Department of Labor.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

A team of student interns can be placed in one or more of your departments (on-site, remote, or hybrid) and perform a wide range of responsibilities on the job, such as data entry, translation services, IT support, project research, marketing, talent acquisition, and ERG support, and many other entry-level skills-based tasks. The Corporate Work Study office works directly with you to generate a job description and a partnership experience that is mutually rewarding for your company and our student interns.

CWSP ONBOARDING AND TRAINING

- Obtains special provisions from the U.S.
 Department of Labor to employ high school students.
- Employs student interns and manages employment eligibility verification, payroll, insurance, taxes, and other employer responsibilities.
- Assign your company an Account Manager to provide supervisor training and ongoing support.
- Matches student interns to your company based on job descriptions and student skill sets.
- 5. Transports students to and from the job location from late August through mid-May.
- 6. Engages student interns in ongoing workplace training at the school.

WORK SCHEDULE

Student interns typically work in a four-person job-sharing team to fill one full-time position during standard business hours, Monday through Friday, for the full academic year. While this is the most common structure, team size can be adjusted based on partner needs. Schedules are built so students never miss class. This integrated model is a defining element of the Cristo Rey academic experience.
