- Round 2 Counseling: August 2023
- Mop-Up Round: September 2023


- NEET: Awarded to students who have scored 600 or above on average across all exams till date.


Plot and Structure: The novel begins with a bang—literally. 

In Greek culture, xenia ( $\xi \epsilon v \iota a$ ) was the concept of guest-friendship, a sacred bond of trust and respect between a host and their guest, often associated with the protection of travelers and strangers. The root xenos means "stranger" or "guest." Over time, xenial emerged in English as an adjective describing the warm and generous treatment of guests, reflecting the deep cultural value placed on hospitality in ancient societies.
