

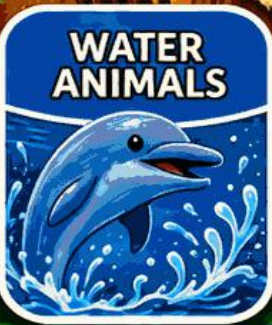
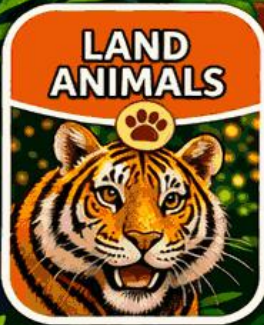

# LION



## 1. What is a Lion?

A lion is a big and strong wild animal. It is called the "King of the Jungle".

## 2. Appearance

- Lions have a big body and four strong legs.
- Male lions have a thick mane around the head.
- Their body color is usually golden or yellowish.

## 3. Where Do Lions Live?

Lions live in forests, grasslands and savannahs in Africa and a small part of Asia. They live in groups called prides.



### Fun Fact!

A lion's roar can be heard up to 5 miles (about 8 kilometers) away!

## 4. What Do Lions Eat?

Lions are carnivores. This means they eat the meat of other animals. They eat animals like deer, zebra, buffalo and other big animals.



## 5. Life in a Pride

- Lions live in groups called prides.
- A pride includes one male lion, many lionesses and cubs.
- Lionesses usually hunt for food, while the male lion protects the pride.

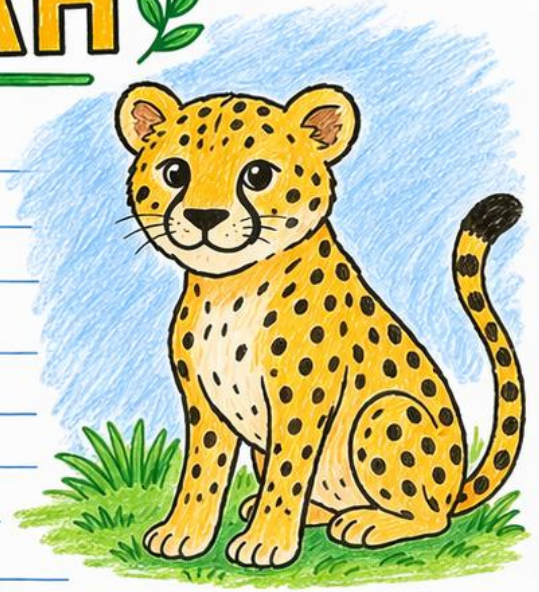

## 1. What is a Cheetah?

A cheetah is a wild cat that is very fast.  
It is the fastest land animal in the world!



## 2. Appearance

- Cheetahs have a slim body and long legs.
- Their fur is yellowish with many small black spots.
- They have black "tear marks" on their face.
- They have a long tail that helps them balance.

## 3. Where Do Cheetahs Live?

Cheetahs live in grasslands and savannas in Africa and a small part of Asia.  
They like open spaces where they can run fast.



### Fun Fact!

A cheetah can run up to 70 miles per hour (about 113 kilometers per hour)! That's faster than a car in a neighborhood!

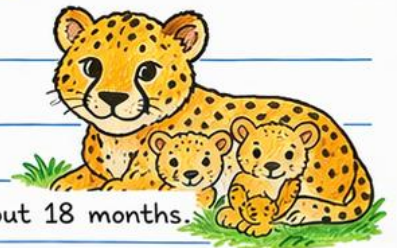
## 4. What Do Cheetahs Eat?

Cheetahs are carnivores. They mainly eat small to medium animals like gazelles, impalas, and rabbits.



## 5. Life of a Cheetah

- Cheetahs usually live alone.
- A mother cheetah is called a cheetah mother or female.
- She gives birth to 3 to 5 cubs. Cubs stay with their mother for about 18 months.

## 1. What is a Kangaroo?

A kangaroo is a marsupial animal from Australia. It is famous for jumping and has a strong body.

## 2. Appearance

- Kangaroos have a strong body with large back legs.
- They have short front arms, big feet and a long tail.
- Their fur color is usually brown or grey.
- They have large ears and sharp eyes.

## 3. Where Do Kangaroos Live?

Kangaroos live in grasslands and open areas called outback in Australia. They live in groups called mobs.

## 4. What Do Kangaroos Eat?

Kangaroos are herbivores. They eat grass, leaves, flowers, and shrubs.

## 5. Life of a Kangaroo

- A baby kangaroo is called a joey.
- A joey is born very small and lives in the mother's pouch.
- It stays in the pouch for about 6 to 8 months and then comes out.



### Fun Fact!

Kangaroos can't walk forward! They can only hop forward using their strong back legs and tail for balance.

They live in herds to stay safe from predators.

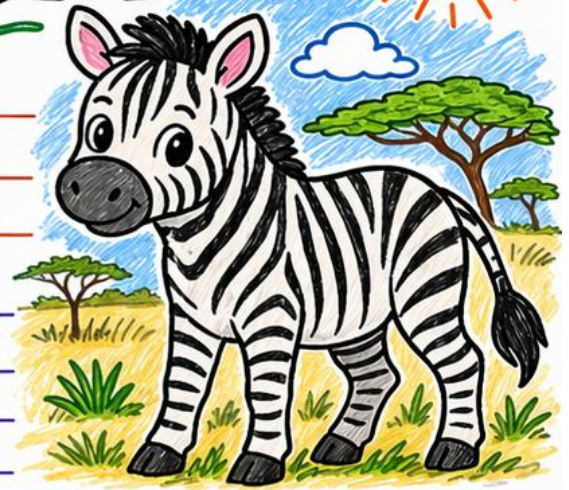
## 4. What Do Zebras Eat?

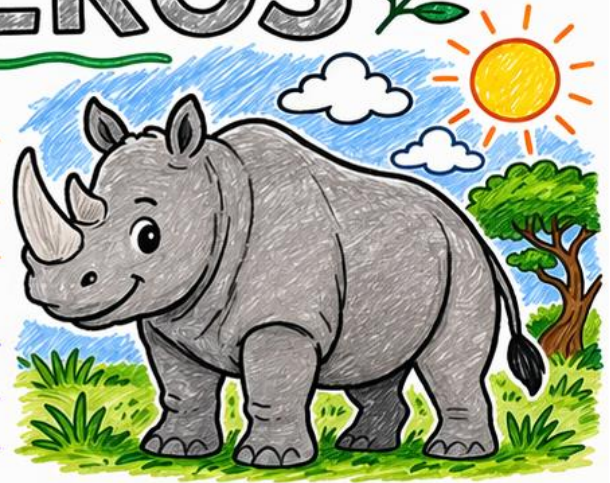


# RHINOCEROS

## 3. Where Do Rhinoceroses Live?

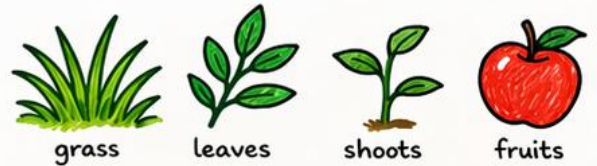
Rhinoceroses live in Africa and Asia.

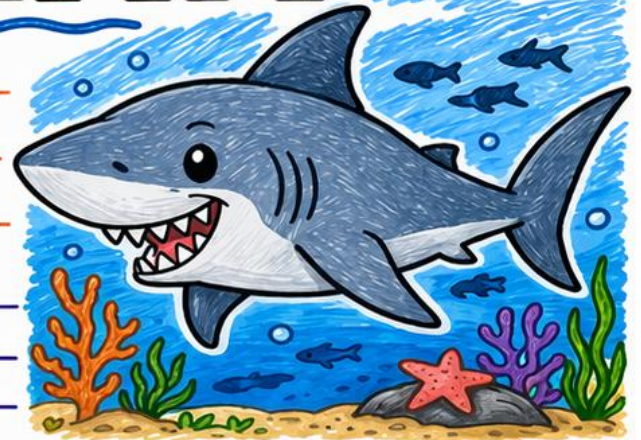

- Some jellyfish glow in the dark. This is called bioluminescence.

They can be found near the surface or in deep water.

They use their tentacles with stinging cells to catch food.

- Polyps attach to rocks and grow into adult jellyfish.
- Adult jellyfish drift and swim with the ocean currents.
- Jellyfish have no brain or heart, but they can still sense light and movement.

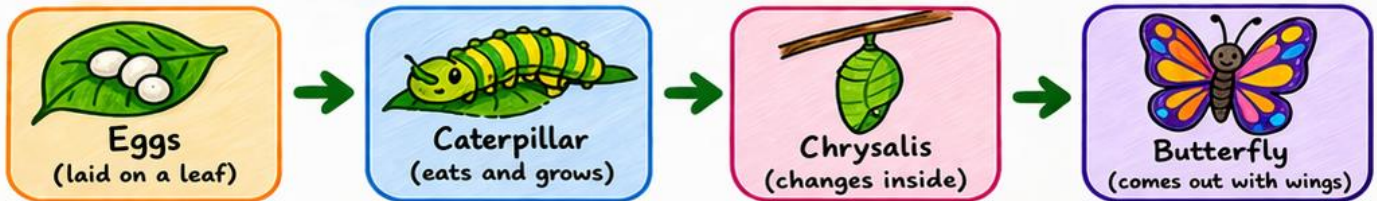
- Butterflies live in many places like gardens, flower fields, and near trees.

- They have six legs. Their back legs are strong and made for jumping.

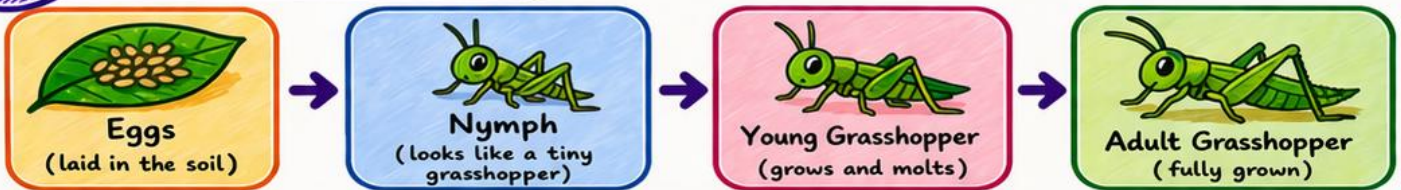
## 3. Where Do Grasshoppers Live?

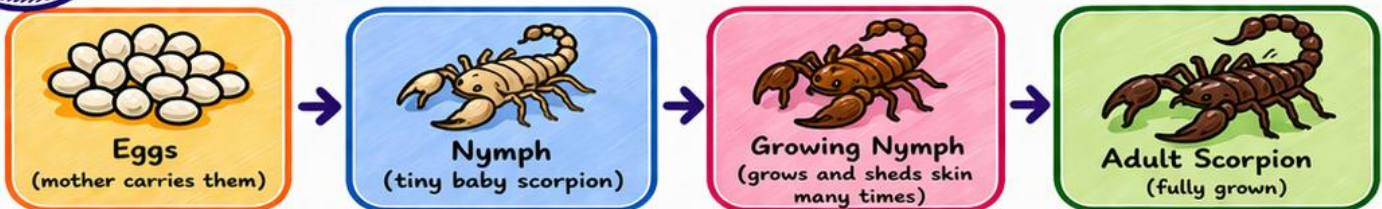
