

Greetings from the Chapter President Welcome to the 75th Chapter Anniversary Celebration



This year Delta Psi Omega Chapter celebrates 75 years of sisterhood, service and scholarship in the Washtenaw County community. Chartered on December 4, 1948, Delta Psi Omega has stood steadfast through these last seven decades.

From the Civil Rights Movement through Black Lives Matter, Delta Psi Omega Chapter has advocated for social justice and racial equity, promoted voter education, mobilized voter registration, and supported the preservation and sharing of African American culture and history. The chapter was instrumental in the founding of the African American Cultural and Historical Museum of Washtenaw County, of which every member of the chapter is a member, and of which several chapter members serve in its leadership.

Over its many years, Delta Psi Omega Chapter has supported our local youth, including through the awarding of hundreds of scholarships, for need and merit; the engagement of middle and high school students in our leadership development and college readiness programs; and our engagement of elementary students through our Martin Luther King, Jr. Day of Service Literacy Program, through which we read to young students books featuring black characters, history and culture. Just this year, Delta Psi Omega Chapter implemented Alpha Kappa Alpha's most ambitious childhood hunger program to date, the Childhood Hunger Initiative Power Pack program. Implemented to reduce childhood hunger in local communities, Delta Psi Omega Chapter currently supports more than 50 children with demonstrated need, who attend, or have siblings who attend, Estabrook Elementary, with meals and snacks to support their food needs on weekends and holidays during the school year.

In its signature event, Delta Psi Omega Chapter celebrates the community's black men. Often overlooked and underappreciated, Delta Psi Omega Chapter recognizes and honors, in its annual Celebration of Black Men, the accomplishments of Black men who have achieved in scholarship, service, and profession, and positively impacted the local community.

This is but a few of Delta Psi Omega Chapter's many programs and accomplishments since that wonderful day on December 4, 1948, when it began.

So, it is with a great deal of pride, tempered by the humility of knowing that we did not do it alone, but rather with the love and support of our families, friends and community, that we take a moment to celebrate these 75 years of sisterhood, scholarship and service. It is only made better that you have joined us in the celebration.

Two members, Roberta Ellis Britt and Catharine Roberts Williams, from Ann Arbor, Michigan attended the twenty-seventh Boule meeting in Cleveland, Ohio from August 18-23, 1947. Their motivation was the desire to secure approval for chartering a graduate chapter in the Ann Arbor area.

In 1947, the Beta Eta Chapter at the University of Michigan was a combination chapter with both undergraduate and graduate members meeting together. The members who traveled to Cleveland successfully obtained the permission they sought from the Boule.

Between September 1947 and
December 1948, many members met
to complete and comply with the
requirements necessary for
chartering the graduate chapter.
After fifteen months of hard work, on
Saturday, December 4, 1948, the
chartering of Delta Psi Omega
Chapter took place at the Britt House
in Ann Arbor.

- Dorothy Smith Educator & Professor at Central State University;
- Gertrude Frances Warren-Educator, Detroit Public Schools;
- Catharine R. Williams-Medical Social Worker, University of Michigan. She was active with Delta Psi Omega until her death in 1991, recognized as the longest active member & 1st Golden Member.
- Yvonne Williams Educator, Ypsilanti Public Schools.
