Where our story began...
Two Rivers Grill



Six years ago, we were getting ready to open our little restaurant in West Columbia, Texas. The day we were supposed to sign the papers was the very same day the pandemic hit. At the time, we both worked in the plant and had no clue what the future was going to hold. With so much uncertainty, we made the difficult decision to walk away from our dream.

A huge thank you to *Kenny Stanford Sr.* for being so understanding and allowing us to withdraw from our contract. We were absolutely heartbroken, but God had other plans.

Just a few weeks later, my daughter *Kristina Crouch* took a different route to work and spotted a "For Rent" sign in the window of a little restaurant in Brazoria. That little restaurant, known then as Two Rivers Grill, is the very place we've now called home for the last *6 years.*
