Day 1 – August 26 – Welcome to Ireland

We will undertake a panoramic tour of Dublin with some free time to stretch our legs and grab a bite to eat before checking into our city centre hotel. Tonight, we meet as a group and get to know on another while enjoying a welcome dinner at our hotel.

### Day 2 – August 27 - Dublin's Fair City!

Today is yours to discover Dublin, consider purchasing a Hop-on Hop-off bus pass. Visit the library at Trinity College to view The Book of Kells, Kilmainham Gaol, Phoenix Park, Glasnevin Cemetery, Guinness Storehouse or Jameson Distillery Tour. Tonight is free to indulge in traditional Irish fayre from a vast selection of restaurants and bistros, some with lively entertainment.

### Day 3 – August 28 - Saint Patrick's Country and Titanic

Our travels take us through the majestic Mountains of Mourne into Saint Patrick's Country to visit the grave of Ireland's Patron Saint. In Belfast we'll visit the Harland & Wolff Shipyard and the Titanic Experience, where you will take a self-guided tour of the #1 attraction in Europe.

### Day 4 – August 29 - Belfast

This morning, we have a guided tour of Belfast City Hall before undertaking a panoramic tour which will include the Protestant Shankhill and Catholic Falls Road. Remainder of the day & evening are at leisure. You may wish to explore the Cathedral Quarter of town, home to many great restaurants and lively pubs.

Option to attend the Belfast Quilt Fayre this afternoon for those who are interested.

# Day 5 – August 30 - Giant's Causeway and Derry

We drive north along the scenic Causeway Coastal Route through the Glens of Antrim to the iconic pillars of The Giant's Causeway, a UNESCO world heritage site. We continue to Derry (Londonderry), where a local guide will tell the "Story of Derry" on a fascinating walking tour of this historic walled city.

# Day 6 – August 31 - Donegal and Belleek

Enjoy an Irish Coffee while learning the history of Donegal Tweed, including a weaving demonstration on a 200-year-old Hand Loom. There will be time to shop for fashionable woollens and a selection of Irish knitwear. Back into Northern Ireland to visit Belleek Pottery, home to Ireland's oldest working fine China pottery before we enter the romantic domain of WB Yeats, and sites associated with the poet before arriving in Westport.

# Day 7 – September 01 – Connemara

This morning, we travel the Wild Atlantic Way into the rugged wilds of Connemara for a guided tour of Kylemore Abbey, a monastery founded in 1920 for Benedictine Nuns who fled Belgium in WW1. This afternoon is free for you to explore the pretty Georgian town of Westport. Famous for its stoned bridges, tree lined promenades, historical sites, and plenty of shops and galleries. This evening you may wish to dine at a local pub or restaurant. Overnight, The Westport Coast Hotel, Westport

## Day 8 – September 02 - Cliffs of Moher

Journey south along the picturesque shores of Lough Mask and Lough Corrib to Galway. Enjoy free time to wander or have a pint in one of the many pubs on Shop Street. In Doolin we board a tour boat for a unique view of the mighty Cliffs of Moher from the Atlantic.

This evening, an optional medieval banquet in an Irish castle is on offer.

# Day 9 – September 03 - Limerick and Killarney

After breakfast we tour Limerick City before travelling to Adare, one of the prettiest villages in Ireland, home to thatched roof cottages, quirky shops and cute cafes. Then onward to the beautiful town of Killarney, our home for the next 3 nights. We dine at our hotel before an evening performance of The Celtic Steps Show, featuring world-renowned musicians & dancers.

### Day 10 – September 04 – Dingle

Today's adventure takes us along the Dingle Peninsula offering breath-taking views of rugged cliffs & coastline. In Dingle you will have free time to stroll the harbour, shop for handcrafts, and enjoy freshly caught seafood in a local fish shack or pub. Upon return to the hotel, the quilters among us will get to visit with local legend Nikki Foley as she provides a "trunk show" just for us!

Tonight, you may wish to enjoy a night on the town and dine in a local pub.

# Day 11 – September 05 - Ring of Kerry

This morning, we begin our drive along the scenic Ring of Kerry through Moll's Gap and on to Kissane Sheep Farm for an entertaining display of sheepdogs hard at work. Back in Killarney we'll meet local Jarvies and take a jaunting car ride through town to Quill's Farmhouse, where we will enjoy a traditional Irish farmhouse dinner while being entertained by local musicians.

# Day 12 - September 06 - Blarney and Cahir Castle

Our first stop today is the village of Blarney. Shop for handcrafts, or for those who are feeling energetic, climb the 127 steps of Blarney Castle for the opportunity to kiss the 'stone of eloquence' (paid locally). We will also enjoy a guided tour of the 13th century Cahir Castle before we arrive at the medieval city of Kilkenny, our home for the next 2 nights.

## Day 13 – September 07 - Waterford and Dunbrody

This morning, we travel through the pretty village of Inistioge then on to Waterford Viking City for some free time. Be sure to visit the House of Waterford! This afternoon, we'll follow in the footsteps of a group of famine emigrants as we board the vessel, Dunbrody.

This evening, we will dine together at our hotel. After dinner you may wish visit Kyteler's Pub but be on the lookout for resident ghost Dame Alice while you are there!

# Day 14 – September 08 - Irish National Stud and Malahide

En route to our hotel in County Dublin, we undertake a guided tour of the Irish National Stud and Japanese Gardens. Home to many of Ireland's most famous champion racehorses. While there, you can take a stroll through the Japanese Gardens, one of the most beautiful gardens of its kind in Europe. There will be free time to explore the seaside town of Malahide before joining our travelling companions for a farewell drink and dinner at the hotel on this our last night.




