Our mission is to shape the future of market innovation and competition through pioneering research, global collaboration, and the development of policies that promote growth and entrepreneurial dynamism.


Situated in the heart of the nation's capital, our decentralized structure enables us to engage with stakeholders across continents and major jurisdictions.


