## Spond Usage



For the 25/26 season, we would encourage all members to join the club spond app. It can be accessed via a web browser or using the mobile Spond app, which is available for both Android and iPhone.

Spond will be one of our prime methods of keeping members up to date.

Booking onto our harbour training sessions will only be available via the spond app. Training dates will appear 14 days before the event and members can sign up for either Swimmer / Boat Crew or shore Volunteer roles.

If insufficient safety crew or shore volunteers come forward to meet the needs of the swimmers, as defined in the risk assessment for the activity, then that session will have to be cancelled.

### **THE DOOK 2025**

With over 150 dookers pre-registered for the event, and around 100 turning up on the day, 254 hardy souls took to the waters of Broughty Ferry Harbour on what turned out to be a relatively nice day weather wise.

That was not the case in the run up to the day with strong to gale force winds, it was looking like that the event might not go ahead.

At 2:15, the club placed flowers in the Tay in memory of Frank Chalmers whilst the piper played a lament from the end of the pier, beside Franks family who were there to witness the event.

At 2:30 the piper piped the dookers into the water.

There were no stalls this year, which we hope to resolve for the 2026 event.

However, we were pleased with the number of spectators who turned up to watch the event take place, we hope that everyone had a good experience.

Course is free for club members.




### MISSING TROPHIES

# Treasurers Update

So at the last newsletter, we had a little over £43K in the bank. Over the winter period we have been pushing on with the updates to the clubhouse.

So far we have completed the following works:

- Sealing of the whole roof.
- Replacment of the 3 heaters in the committee and changing rooms.
- All lights now controlled by sensors so cannot be left on accidently.
- New Roller Door fitted to clubhouse.
- Broken window replaced in gents changing room.
- New Roller shutter over old information window
- All windows in the building now have grilles fitted.
- Bothouse roller door motor replaced.

There are still dome tasks to do in 2025, e.g.

- Interior decoration of clubhouse
- Get current sponsors details onto the blue boats.
- PAT testing of electrical goods
- Maintanence work needed on Boat Trailers
- Look at the flooring in the Boatshed
- Get the drains checked (issue with kitchen sink drainage)

We are aiming to get as much of this work completed by the start of the new swimming season in April.

As well as all this work, we have had a few planning sessions over the winter months to get a head start for the season ahead.
