In brief...

→ A short guide to what you need to do when you enrol your child in school.

How do you enrol your child in school?

-  1 Your home address must be in Lausanne.
-  2 Complete and sign the enrolment form: 
-  3 Attach copies of the parents' and child's passport/identity card.
-  4 If your child does not attend a state school in the Canton of Vaud, attach a copy of their school reports.

Once you have completed the enrolment application, you will be contacted by the school that will welcome your child.

 Does your child not speak French?
You will be invited to a welcome interview at the Resource centre for German-speaking pupils (Centre de ressources pour élèves allophones – CREAL) with your child to decide on the most appropriate pathway for them.
