## **Exodus 20:4-5 (NLT2)\***

**4 “You must not make for yourself an idol of any kind or an image of anything in the heavens or on the earth or in the sea. 5 You must not bow down to them or worship them, for I, *אֱלֹהִים* your God, am a jealous God who will not tolerate your affection for any other gods.**

## Acts 17:29 (NIV)

29 "Therefore since we are God's offspring, **we should not think that the divine being is like gold or silver or stone--an image made by man's design and skill.**

## Exodus 32:1-4 (TEV)

<sup>1</sup> When the people saw that Moses had not come down from the mountain but was **staying there a long time**, they gathered around Aaron and said to him, "We do not know what has happened to this man Moses, who led us out of Egypt; **so make us a god to lead us.**"

<sup>2</sup> Aaron said to them, "Take off the gold earrings which your wives, your sons, and your daughters are wearing, and bring them to me."

<sup>3</sup> So all the people took off their gold earrings and brought them to Aaron. <sup>4</sup> He took the earrings, melted them, poured the gold into a mold, and **made a gold bull-calf**. The people said, "Israel, this is **our god, who led us out of Egypt!**"

## 1 Samuel 8:6-9 (TEV)

<sup>6</sup> Samuel was displeased with **their request for a king**; so he prayed to **יהוה**, <sup>7</sup> and **יהוה** said, "Listen to everything the people say to you. You are not the one they have rejected; **I am the one they have rejected as their king.**

<sup>8</sup> **Ever since I brought them out of Egypt, they have turned away from me and worshiped other gods; and now they are doing to you what they have always done to me.** <sup>9</sup> So then, listen to them, but give them strict warnings and explain how their kings will treat them."

## **Isaiah 42:8 (NLT2)**

**8** “I am **אֲנִי**; that is my name!

**I will not give my glory to  
anyone else, nor share my praise  
with carved idols.**

## **Romans 1:25, 28 (TEV)**

**<sup>25</sup> They exchange the truth about God for a lie; they worship and serve what God has created instead of the Creator himself, who is to be praised forever! Amen. <sup>28</sup> Because those people refuse to keep in mind the true knowledge about God, he has given them over to corrupted minds, so that they do the things that they should not do.**

## **Genesis 11:3-4 (NIV)**

**<sup>3</sup> They said to each other, "Come, let's make bricks and bake them thoroughly." They used brick instead of stone, and tar for mortar. <sup>4</sup> Then they said, "Come, let us build ourselves a city, with a tower that reaches to the heavens, so that we may make a name for ourselves and not be scattered over the face of the whole earth."**



## Romans 12:1-2 (TEV)

<sup>1</sup> So then, my friends, because of God's great mercy to us I appeal to you: **Offer yourselves as a living sacrifice to God, dedicated to his service and pleasing to him.** This is the true worship that you should offer. <sup>2</sup> **Do not conform yourselves to the standards of this world, but let God transform you inwardly by a complete change of your mind.** Then you will be able to know the will of God—what is good and is pleasing to him and is perfect.

## **Exodus 20:4-5 (NLT2)**

**4 “You must not make for yourself an idol of any kind or an image of anything in the heavens or on the earth or in the sea. 5 You must not bow down to them or worship them, for I, אלהים your God, am a jealous God who will not tolerate your affection for any other gods. I lay the sins of the parents upon their children; the entire family is affected—even children in the third and fourth generations of those who reject me.**

## **Exodus 20:6 (NLT2)**

**<sup>6</sup> But I lavish unfailing love for a thousand generations on those who love me and obey my commands.**

## **Psalm 103:15-17 (NLT2)\***

**<sup>15</sup> Our days on earth are like grass; like wildflowers, we bloom and die. <sup>16</sup> The wind blows, and we are gone— as though we had never been here. <sup>17</sup> But the love of אלהים remains forever with those who fear him. His salvation extends to the children's children**
