



Lenten Small Groups A Season of Growth and Reflection

This year we'll use "Meeting Jesus at the Table" as our guide for small group gatherings. The Gospels are full of stories of Jesus sharing meals with disciples, friends, even tax collectors and Pharisees. Whether multiplying bread to feed a whole crowd, relaxing with his inner circle, or telling curious stories about even greater banquets, Jesus imparts wisdom as he shares the wine and grants forgiveness as he distributes the fish. This Lenten study provides biblical insights along with thought-provoking queries regarding our own time, such as whom should we invite to Sunday dinner and who is left out and left behind in our culture today.



Groups will meet for 5 weeks, one hour each week, beginning the week of March 9. Perfect attendance is not required!




March 2 @ 11:30am Sunday Funday


MARCH 16 - CHAOS MS 5:30-6:30 / HS 7:00-8:00 Chopped Challenge

Good Friday Tenebrae April 18th @ 7pm


