SUN SAFE ON SITE:

SKIN CANCER PREVENTION FOR OUTDOOR WORKERS

Let's face it working outdoors in the summer sun can feel great at first. Vitamin D, fresh air, golden tans... what's not to love? But that sunshine can pack a serious punch if you're not careful and we're not just talking about a bad sunburn.





The Silent Risk: Skin Cancer

Skin cancer is one of the most common cancers in the UK. According to Cancer Research UK, over 80% of skin cancers are caused by too much UV radiation — most of it coming from the sun. If your job keeps you outside (construction, landscaping, delivery driving, etc.), you're in a higher-risk category.

Spot the Danger Before It Spots You

UV rays can be harmful even on cloudy days, and they're strongest between 11 a.m. and 3 p.m. So that lovely mid-day break in the sun? Maybe grab some shade instead. And no, a tan doesn't protect you—it's literally your skin crying for help.

So, What Can You Do?

- Slip, Slop, Slap: Slip on a long-sleeve shirt (light and breathable), slop on some SPF 30+ sunscreen, and slap on a hat — ideally one with a brim or neck flap.
- Reapply Often: Sunscreen isn't a one-and-done.
 Reapply every 2 hours, or more often if you're sweating buckets.
- Sunglasses Matter: UV rays can damage your eyes too. Go for wrap-around styles with 100% UV protection.
- Shade is Your Friend: Try to take breaks in the shade.
 If none's available, create your own with canopies or umbrellas.
- Know the Signs: New moles, weird patches, or any changes in your skin? Get them checked. Early detection saves lives.

Symptoms include:


- Headaches

Alcohol and the Heat Don't Mix



WORKPLACE FATALITIES A STARK REMINDER THAT SAFETY MATTERS EVERYWHERE



The Health and Safety Executive (HSE) has released its latest work-related fatal injury statistics for Great Britain (April 2024 to March 2025). While many of these tragic incidents occurred in high-risk industries like construction and agriculture, the findings offer an urgent reminder: no workplace is immune to risk — whether you're operating in hospitality, education, or an office environment.

Key Findings You Should Know

124 workers lost their lives in work-related incidents last year. While this is lower than the previous year (138), it aligns with prepandemic figures, showing that the danger hasn't gone away.

The most common causes of fatal injuries — including falls from height (35 deaths), being struck by moving objects (18 deaths), and collapse/overturning incidents (17 deaths) — can happen in any workplace, not just high-risk settings.

Tragically, 92 members of the public also died in work-related incidents. These were individuals not employed at the workplace — such as visitors, customers, parents, delivery drivers, or contractors. This highlights the critical importance of protecting everyone, not just employees.

Mesothelioma Still a Major Threat

In 2023, 2,218 people died from mesothelioma, a cancer caused by past asbestos exposure. This remains a real concern in older buildings, especially in schools, offices, and hospitality venues. Effective asbestos management must remain a top priority in buildings constructed before 2000.


