(We bet you knew.)





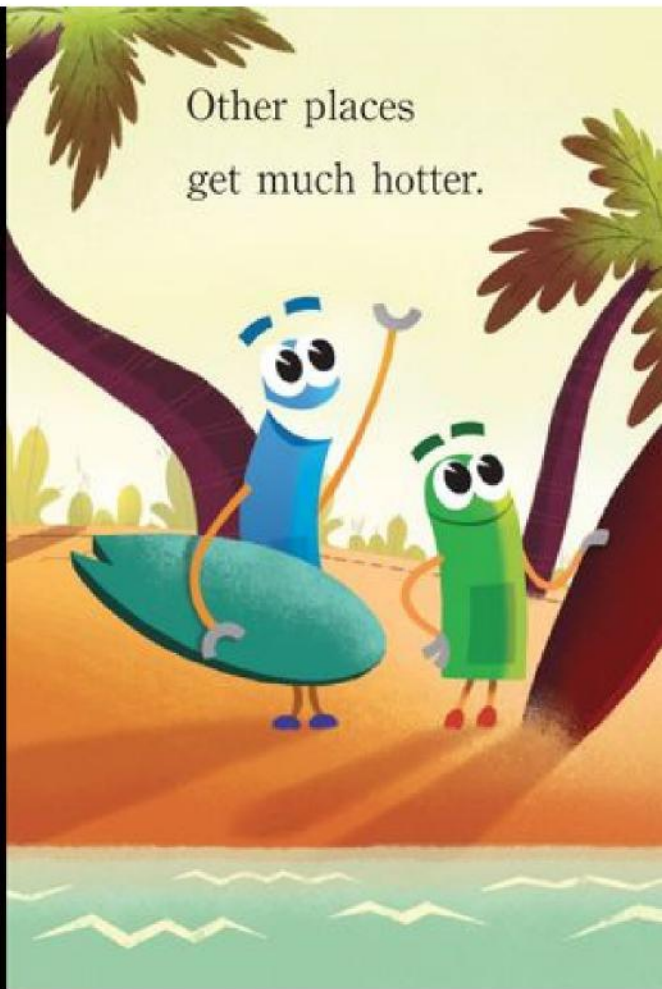

are capped with ice.

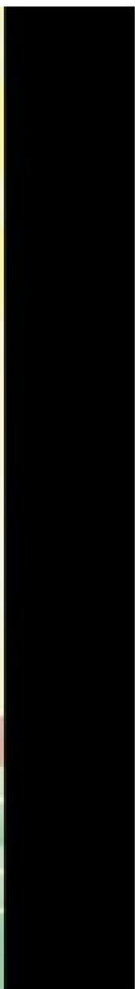


The polar bears

get much hotter.



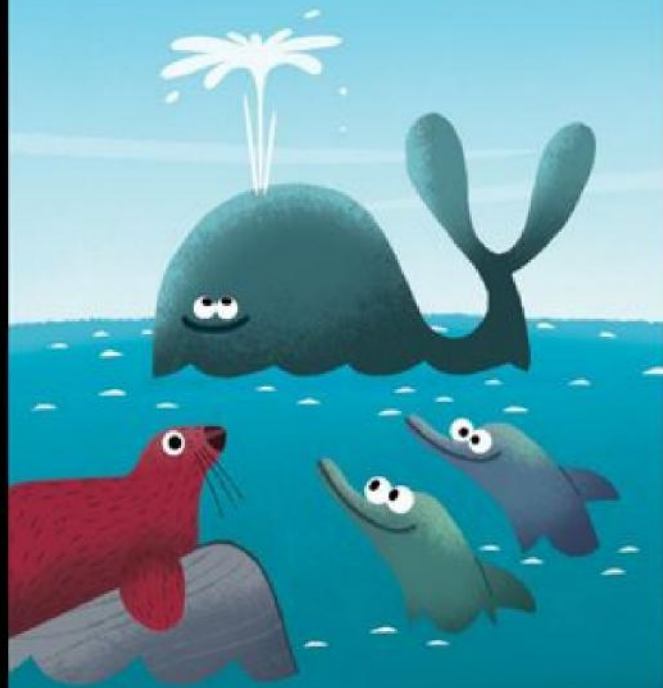
