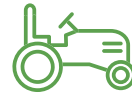

TIPS & TRICKS



The tour is rain or shine! In the event of inclement weather, some farms may close to keep the public and the farm safe. We'll post notice of any such closures on our website and social media pages, as well as on the interactive Google Map.

Plan your route in advance! Some farms are located in rural areas that don't have good signal for smartphones or GPS devices.

Look for red tomato signs along the road near host farms. They'll point you in the right direction and help you find participating farms!

Plan to visit a maximum of 3 to 4 farms a day. Anticipate spending 1-2 hours at each farm you visit, and account for travel time between each farm. Consider making the most of your time by visiting tour kickoff farms, which open early at 12pm each day! All other farms open at 2pm.

Bring a cooler and cash. Some farms may not accept credit cards, so come prepared to pay in cash for the wonderful variety of local produce, meat, plants, dairy, flowers, gifts, snacks, and more available for purchase at the host farms! Visit the tour website to learn what products each host farm plans to offer.

Keep a close eye on kids! Remember that these are working farms with electric fences, heavy equipment, and animals. Do not enter animal pens, and only allow children to touch farm animals with the express permission of the host farmer. No handling of poultry is permitted at any host farm.

Wash up and prevent the spread of germs. Take time to wash your hands after petting any animals and before eating. Hand washing units and hand sanitizer will be available on all farms. You'll also be required to disinfect your shoes at farms with animals to prevent farm-to-farm transmission of germs that may affect livestock.

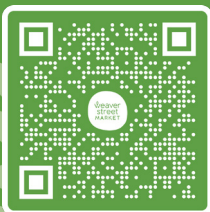

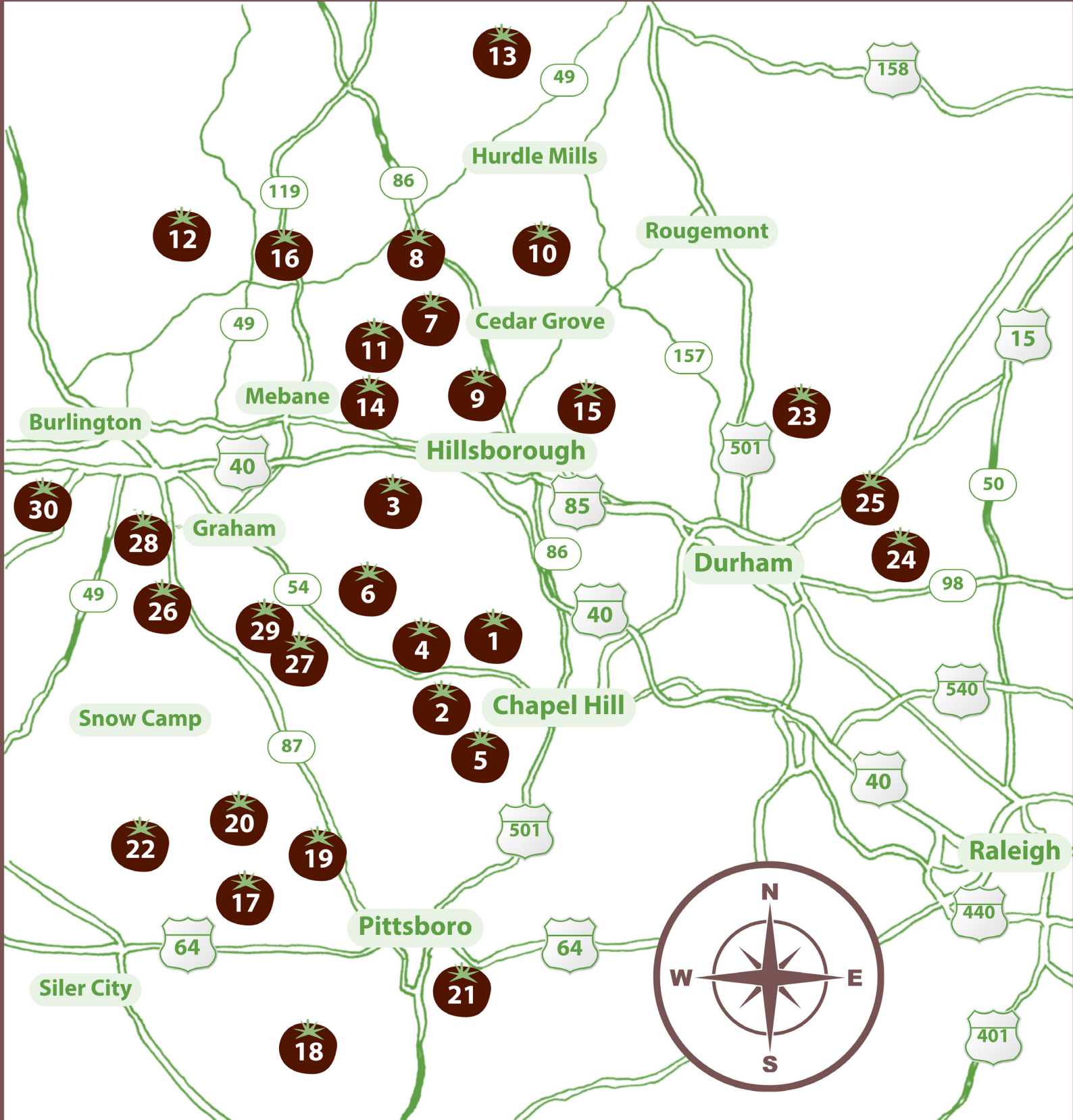

Rooted in generations of stewardship, YESA shares knowledge about land, food, and community through Indigenous teachings and hands-on learning. In late April, visitors will see hoop houses filled with tower gardens, leafy greens, early crops, and blooming pollinator habitat. Guests can explore herb gardens and raised beds while learning traditional planting methods, including mound growing. Guided walks highlight traditional ecological knowledge, seed stewardship, and watershed protection. Our family has stewarded this land for over 300 years. YESA means “the People” in the Occaneechi-Saponi language.
