## Ontario Launches New Energy Efficiency Programs to Save You Money

Rebates for home renovations include new windows, doors, insulation, smart thermostats, heat pumps and rooftop solar panels to reduce energy bills

January 07, 2025

### Energy Efficiency Incentives for Small Businesses

The province is expanding the Peak Perks program to small businesses, including convenience stores and restaurants. Enroll now to receive \$75 upfront and \$20 annually for each eligible smart thermostat connected to central air or heat pump systems.

Additionally, 12 Save on Energy programs remain available, including the Retrofit Program, supporting businesses, municipalities, institutions, and more with energy-saving initiatives.





## Life can be expensive. How can the CRA help?

Raising children, paying rent, or just keeping up with the bills is not always easy.

### How do you get benefits and credits?

You and your spouse or common-law partner need to do your taxes each year to get the benefits and credits you may be eligible for, even if you had no income. If you live in Quebec, you also have to do a provincial tax return. You have until April 30 each year to do your taxes and continue getting your benefits.

### How much could you get per year?

**Canada child benefit** – up to \$7,787 for each child under 6 years of age and up to \$6,570 for each child aged 6 to 17. You need to apply for all children in your household if you have not applied previously and nobody is receiving it for them.

**Goods and services tax/harmonized sales tax (GST/HST) credit** – up to \$519 for an eligible individual and up to \$1,038 for an eligible couple with two children.

**Disability tax credit** – eligible individuals with a disability or their supporting family member may claim \$9,872 as a non-refundable tax credit. Persons under 18 years of age at the end of the year may also be eligible for an additional amount of up to \$5,758. Go to [canada.ca/disability-tax-credit](https://canada.ca/disability-tax-credit).

**Canada workers benefit** – up to \$1,590 for an eligible individual and up to \$2,739 for an eligible family as a refundable credit. This credit reduces the tax you owe first and any remaining credit is refunded to you.

If you have a modest income and a simple tax situation, you may be able to get your taxes done by a volunteer for free. #### Register for My Account

To avoid delays, make sure your personal information (such as your marital status, your address, or your bank account) is up to date in My Account or call the CRA.

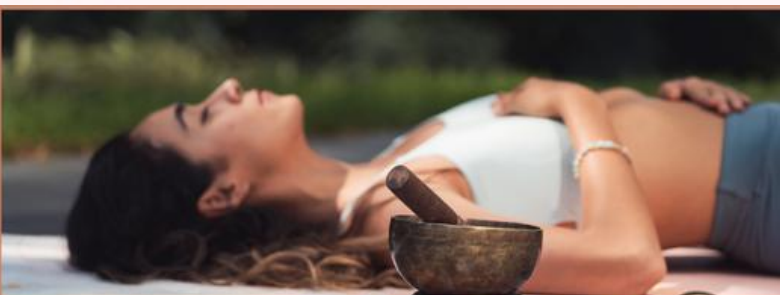
