History of the NIAA



The Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association (NIAA) is the governing body of high school athletics in the Silver State as recognized by the Nevada State Legislature. It is important to note the NIAA does not receive direct state funding. The NIAA's revenue streams are corporate partnerships, event ticket sales and member schools' dues.

The original Nevada Interscholastic League (NIL) was formed in 1922. It became affiliated with the National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS) in 1939. School administrators established the League to enforce a standardized set of rules for sports in high schools.

The NIL became the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association in 1967. The first full-time salaried Executive Director was hired in 1974 and an office was established in Carson City. The NIAA office moved to Reno in 1997 and to its current location in Sparks in 2018. The five individuals to have served as full-time Executive Directors of the NIAA are Bert Cooper (July 1974 – June 1989), Dr. Jerry Hughes (July 1989 – December 2006), Eddie Bonine (January 2007 – February 2015), Bart Thompson (July 2015 – 2021) and Donnie Nelson (2021 – current).

The Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association is incorporated in compliance with NRS 81.170-81.280 and was recognized in 1974 under the provisions of NRS 385B.010-.190. The NIAA's Handbook (rules and regulations) was assumed in chapter 385B of the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC). The NIAA is responsible for sanctioning athletics, conducting post-season tournaments, regulating officials, certifying coaches, and providing a host of services to its member schools surrounding health and welfare standards.

As of August 2023, the NIAA had 123 member schools divided into five classifications. The NIAA provides the following services to its member schools in addition to the 118 league/region tournaments and 95 state championship tournaments it conducts:

- * Awards an academic team champion in each NIAA-sanctioned sport and honors individuals on the All-State Academic Team (4.0 GPA);

- * Hosts a Hall of Fame banquet and induction ceremony,

which honors outstanding student-athletes, coaches, officials, administrators and contributors who have had a significant and positive impact on Nevada's youth;

- * Honors the top 10 student-athletes in both northern and southern Nevada;

- * Certifies coaches (Nevada Coaching Education Program) and contest officials;

- * Promotes cooperative spirit among member schools through its special Citizenship Through Sports program;

- * Publishes NIAA informational materials (Year In Review, Record Book, etc.) for all member schools, sponsors, the media and the public;

- * Oversees the Sports Medicine Advisory Committee (SMAC);

- * Endorses the Drug, Alcohol and Tobacco policy; and

- * Works to prevent the exploitation of student-athletes by special interest groups.

PURPOSE AND INTENT

"In recognition of the many educational values to be derived from participation in all forms of interscholastic activities, and in recognition of the need for guidance and direction in the conduct of these activities, it shall be the purpose of this Association to promote, coordinate and regulate league, region and statewide activities to the end that they shall be part of and contribute to the total educational program of the students in the secondary schools of the State of Nevada."

ORGANIZATION

Legislative Commission

The policy-making authority of the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association is vested in the Legislative Commission. The Commission consists of the superintendents of each of the 17 county school districts of Nevada (with the exception that Esmeralda County does not have a high school).

History of the NIAA



Board of Control

The governing body of the NIAA is a Board of Control. This Board of Control has 12 voting representatives from the four administrative regions. The state is divided into regions based upon population. Each representative must be elected by the county boards of school trustees from within the region they represent.

The Class 1A, 2A, 3A, 4A/5A South, 4A/5A North and three student representatives all serve as non-voting liaisons to the Board of Control. Other liaisons to the Board include a representative from the Superintendents' association, the state's private schools, the state's charter schools, the Athletic Directors association, and the state

officials association. The Board holds regular (quarterly) meetings throughout the year to conduct the affairs of the NIAA. The Board elects a president and vice-president for a term of two years at its winter or spring meeting in odd numbered years. Member schools and the public are notified of these meetings in a timely manner.

Member Schools

The member schools are formed into classifications and regions/leagues to facilitate scheduling and interscholastic competition.
