



The VIPA Apprenticeship Program serves as an Education Lab for Venice High School juniors and seniors, offering hands-on experience in the performing arts while earning a wage. This immersive program allows students to work in various aspects of theatre production, including lighting, sound, rigging, front of house, box office, and hospitality. New this year is the addition of an AV Team, where students will gain specialized skills in audio-visual technology, a growing field in the industry.
