I was recently watching a news story entitled, “It is the way the game is supposed to be played so, why is it such a big deal?” The story took place in June of 2016 at the Indiana State Baseball Championships, during which a player from the winning team went onto the mound to console the losing pitcher, who was laying on the ground visibly upset, rather than embarking in a celebration with his teammates.

At the end of the story, the newscaster made a point to say, “The actions of the player reflected on the coaches and the parents of the kid. Somebody is doing something very right.” Adults in the player’s life, leading by example.

When the newscast finished, I pondered about why the story made the news. I was happy that the actions of the boys made national headlines, but saddened that acts of sportsmanship are not the norm. The realization that stories like this are highlighted because they are seen as something special and extraordinary was disheartening to me.

Throughout this year, the NMAA and our member schools are focusing on the importance of sportsmanship by coaches, players and spectators. When you attend a game as a spectator, remember that you too are setting an example for the kids on the court or field and for the individuals around you. Remember that it takes just one person to make a difference and the way you act can set an example for your community.

Be mindful of the example you set in whichever role you play in interscholastic athletics – as a coach, a parent, a player or a spectator. Be POSITIVE and support your team, without being negative towards opponents or contest officials. We need to all be a part of changing the culture of interscholastic athletics so that doing what is right is no longer newsworthy. Competing with Class should be the rule, not the exception.

Let us all band together and lead by example. Show the youth of today that sportsmanship matters. Show our student-athletes the proper way to win and lose. Show our “leaders of tomorrow” that their character far outweighs their performance. In New Mexico, our news story should always read, “It is the way the game is supposed to be played so, why is it such a big deal?” In New Mexico, let good sportsmanship and positive behavior always be the norm.





Legend of the Course Janice Tosa, Jemez Valley High School



Janice Tosa is not only a successful runner from the Land of Enchantment, she is a positive role model who teaches pride, resilience and self-determination.

Tosa grew up on the Pueblo of Jemez and learned the importance of maintaining traditions in the community. One of those traditions is running.

“I started when I was in elementary,” said Tosa. “We had a cross country team that participated in different races every year. I was there because everybody else was running. It’s something everybody did. It’s the same today.”

The more she ran, the faster times she posted but it also took its toll. “My sophomore year, I developed a bad case of shin splints and they told me I had to stop running. That was the hard part.” After spending time off the course to recover, Tosa set her goal for a state title. In 2000, Tosa claimed the cross-country A-AA top honors crossing the finish line in a time of 20:39. Her first-place finish helped her Jemez Valley squad claim the girls’ team state title that year. “I think that was the greatest accomplishment for all of us because we were preparing for it the past couple

years. We were only a couple points off the year before. It was the greatest day, not only for our team, but for our community. Winning that title was one of the greatest accomplishments for the community. It told everyone our traditions are still strong. It was the first one for Jemez Valley.”

The following season, her senior year, Tosa followed up her state title performance with another individual first-place finish in cross country, bettering her previous state time by 10 seconds. On the track, her success was the same. Tosa finished first at the state track meet in the 3200m run with a time of 11:55.92. Little did she know, her success on the course and the track would lead to a college scholarship. Tosa went on to run for the University of New Mexico.

“I never knew I had the opportunity to run in college,” explained Tosa. “I knew I was going to go to college, but I never knew where or for what. My senior year, my teacher asked me if I knew about the opportunity to run in college. It never occurred to me that was an option.”

Currently, Tosa is a research associate for the Pueblo of Jemez Department of Education. “I help various programs that provide assistance with prevention. We teach them at an early age to have confidence in themselves and say no to peer pressure. We expose them to core values.” She also serves as the President on the Board of Directors for the RezRIDERS Organization, a group serving at-risk Native American youth through the use of extreme sports (rock climbing, snowboarding, rafting). “Having run at a Division I school allowed me to see what is out there besides the Pueblo and take advantage of it. Most of our students haven’t even gone snowboarding. We provide them opportunities.”

Tosa believes in creating opportunities for young Native American youth and challenging them to a healthier lifestyle.

Her competitive running days are behind her, but she still lends a helping hand to the young kids (even her own).

“Every now and then I go to Jemez Day School, my seven-year-old daughter runs, and I help with their practices. I miss running competitively. I miss the feeling of adrenaline of each race and being in the greatest shape. I don’t run as much as I used to. I miss having that ability to train. When you race, it brings out a different part of you.”

And, Janice Tosa definitely brings out the best in others.

What was it like growing up on the Pueblo of Jemez?


I would say I was brought up traditionally. Every year, we follow a traditional calendar. Everything from big events open to the public and the ones closed to the outside. Most of them would happen in the fall. Men would mostly do the foot races, but women would get the opportunity, too. There were the regular feast days. I never got into making dresses or crafts. I was taught some of the traditional cooking.

What do you like most about running?

I enjoy it because it allows me to be free. It’s just me and my thoughts. I’m able to really challenge myself. It teaches me to better myself in all aspects of life.

What sort of challenges/obstacles did you have to overcome growing up?

After my injuries my sophomore year, I knew I didn’t want to be in that situation again. So, I took steps to avoid being in that situation. I went through more stretching and getting the right shoes. I didn’t know there were actual running shoes that were different for the way you run. I didn’t know that until the injury. It was a learning curve.



What other lessons did you learn through running in high school?

Senior year, I think the biggest thing at that time was knowing what I had accomplished in the past helped motivate me. I treated myself like I was an underdog. I had to work even harder. I was always thinking people are training to beat me. In order to be the best, you have to train harder than everyone else.

What’s next for you?

I’d like to make these (prevention) programs even bigger and nationwide. There’s an epidemic of substance abuse out there. I think this is a program that other reservations can take advantage of and grow new leadership. I want to help our students see themselves as leaders who lead their own way and build a better path for those behind them. I want to make it more known, so others can have that same opportunity.



CLEVELAND STORM WIN 2017 BOYS' CROSS COUNTRY TITLE



The Cleveland Storm returned to the victory stand for the first time since 2012 at the 2017 Laguna Development Corporation State Cross Country Championships. This marked the Storm's third blue trophy in school history; the first came in 2011.
