BIKTARVY does not cure HIV-1 or AIDS. HIV-1 is the virus that causes AIDS.

Do NOT take BIKTARVY if you also take a medicine that contains:

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- any other medicines to treat HIV-1

BEFORE TAKING BIKTARVY

Tell your healthcare provider if you:

- Have or have had any kidney or liver problems, including hepatitis infection.
- Have any other health problems.
- Are pregnant or plan to become pregnant. Tell your healthcare provider if you become pregnant while taking BIKTARVY.
- Are breastfeeding (nursing) or plan to breastfeed. Talk to your healthcare provider about the risks of breastfeeding during treatment with BIKTARVY.

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
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

Bob Frankich, the female trio singers conisiting of Tiffany, Madison and Stella (hope I got it right).



As Arc Fest enters its fifth year, it has achieved what many once thought almost impossible for Chicago: 1) Creating a tangible meeting place for all those who have dedicated their careers to house music, and 2) Establishing a profitable celebration that successfully unites the diverse, often fragmented house music scenes not only within the city but around the globe.

In Chicago, particularly on the South Side, house music serves as the soundtrack to our daily lives. Yet, it's not often that we get the chance to experience the eclectic sounds of international artists like UK's Disclosure, Carl Cox, or NY's Armand Van Heiden. For three days, Auris Presents managed to curate what felt like Chicago's own house music conference, an unintentional gathering of artists and fans from all over the world, celebrating a genre that originated as a youth movement in the city during the 1980s.

As someone deeply immersed in the house scene, I can attest that it's rare for all of us to gather in one place at the same time. For this reason, Arc Fest is a tremendous gift to both the city and the culture. As a first-time attendee this year, I found myself engaged in meaningful conversations with fellow artists, forging relationships that will undoubtedly enhance my current projects. The festival showed genuine care for both the invitees and the performers.

I admit that I spent a good amount of time backstage, catching up with familiar faces and enjoying the local vendors that Arc had carefully selected. After a grueling year of work, it was refreshing to unwind in such a vibrant environment.

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

Dear Char,

"I am constantly arguing with my best friend and I'm not sure what to do, is it time to let go, or is there hope for salvaging our relationship?"

Dear Arguing in Aurora,

What creates a friendship? It usually is built around common interests. I am sure that sometimes you think, "Maybe I should just let this argument go and just start over". You may feel selfish or self-centered for thinking mean thoughts or placing all the blame for the disagreement on your friend. Other arguments have you feeling, "This is enough! I am not going through this again, it is over!" If the friendship has value, then anxiety hits as you realize that memories of fun times may be all you will have and future fun times are at risk.

What to do? First look at what causes the "fights" and how do they end?

Is it just normal relationship friction or are there big issues, like character or ethics concerns that have been discovered?

Second, look at what a toxic friendship looks like. If you are answering yes to these questions, maybe this relationship has run its course:

Are you feeling like you are putting more into the relationship than he/she is?



Is there a change in loyalty?

When he/she asks to go out, do you feel a sense of dread?

Are you making excuses to leave early or to not spend time with them even when you aren't arguing?

Do you just generally hate how you feel when you are with him/her?

Does this person make you feel bad about being you?

Does each disagreement contain foul language, accusations, gossiping behind your back or even threats?

Real friends have real conflicts. It is inevitable. But what the conflicts look like, how long they last and what the next meet-up looks like and feels like should be taken into consideration. If you answered yes to the toxic relationship questions, you are at risk and an ending may be in order. If bickering is about opinions and current events and is aggravating, but stimulating conversation, maybe there are some actual life lessons being learned and new ways of hearing each other may be all that is needed.





The customizable nature of sexbots offers an opportunity for exploration without judgment or societal pressures, which could be empowering. However, it's critical to approach this with an awareness of the potential for over-reliance on artificial interactions at the expense of human connection and the complex realities of human sexuality.

Societal attitudes towards sexbots vary widely, reflecting diverse cultural, ethical, and religious perspectives. While some view these technologies as progressive tools for exploring human desires and relationships, others, especially in conservative cultures.



Why wouldn't some cultures see them as a threat to their traditional values?

Religious perspectives play a pivotal role in shaping these attitudes. Especially with monotheistic traditions, particularly within Judeo-Christian contexts, often link sex to procreation and marriage. The concept of sexbots challenges these traditional views, as they can neither procreate nor fulfill the relational and spiritual aspects of human partnerships emphasized in these religions.

In more permissive religious or secular cultures, sexbots may be seen as a means of exploring sexuality without moral judgment.

However, even in these contexts, there's an ongoing debate about the ethical implications of such interactions, particularly regarding objectification and the nature of consent with non-sentient beings.

There's a potential dichotomy in the desire for both control over robots and authentic relationships.

As technology continues to evolve, so too will the discourse around sexbots, requiring ongoing examination and thoughtful consideration of its multifaceted impacts.

The integration of sexbots into society poses moral and ethical questions, particularly around the themes of consent, objectification, and the humanization of Al. These issues are at the core of a moral landscape that is still being mapped.

A central ethical challenge is the issue of consent with machines incapable of exercising autonomy. A robot, programmed to comply, cannot truly consent in the human sense. This raises concerns about the normalization of harmful behaviors and attitudes in human interactions (as previously mentioned). If interactions with

sex robots bypass the need for mutual consent, what implications might this have for human-to-human relationships? Could this lead to societal desensitization to the importance of consent, potentially altering how we view autonomy and freedom in our relationships? Or, as mentioned above, and as we are seeing in newer sexbots that have consent programmed into them (they shut down when consent is not respected), can sexbots be used, on the other hand, to teach and develop "consent" muscles in humans?

Sex robots, created specifically for human emotional and sexual fulfillment, spotlight the ethical dilemma of objectification. They exist at the intersection of technology and companionship, where emotional needs are met by programmed machines. This purpose-driven creation leads to questions about the ethics of manufacturing entities that mimic human partners. Are we merely using technology to fulfill personal desires, or are we reducing complex emotional interactions to transactions with artificial entities? The ethical implications of creating beings solely for our use and pleasure challenge our understanding of objectification and the value we place on reciprocal relationships.

The presence of sexbots could catalyze shifts in societal norms and perceptions of relationships (again, as mentioned above). While they might promote a greater acceptance of diverse sexual preferences and needs, they could also perpetuate harmful stereotypes and set unrealistic expectations about human relationships. The ethical quandary lies in balancing the potential benefits of these technologies against the risk of reinforcing negative societal patterns.



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
