Y. BHG. PROF. EMER. TAN SRI DATO' DZULKIFLI ABDUL RAZAK

Tan Sri Dzulkifli Abdul Razak, known as Dzul, is an emeritus professor, educationist and scientist who has served as the 6th Rector of the International Islamic University Malaysia (IIUM) from 1 August 2018 to 31 August 2024, and former Vice-Chancellor of Universiti Sains Malaysia (2000–2011). He previously served as President of the International Association of Universities (IAU), a UNESCO-affiliated organization, and was the Convenor of the RCE on Education for Sustainable Development. He is a Fellow of the Academy of Sciences Malaysia (FASc), the World Academy of Art and Science (FWAAS), and the World Academy of Islamic Management (FWAIM). He is also an adjunct professor at UNIMAS. In 2017, he became the first Asian recipient of the prestigious Gilbert Medal and also received the Asia HRD Contribution to Society Award. Actively involved in multiple charity organizations, Dzul chairs LeapEd Services Sdn Bhd, a social enterprise focused on education. His scholarly contributions include books on leadership and education, such as *Nurturing a Balanced Person* and *Fourth Industrial Revolution – The Leadership Dilemma*.

1. All accepted papers will be submitted for proceeding publication, with final decisions resting with the publishers.
2. It's important to note that the proceeding indexing is at the discretion of the indexing body, beyond the control of DIFCON2025 or MMU.
3. Nevertheless, the committee collaborates with reputable publishers with proven track records.
4. High quality papers will be invited to be extended and submitted to collaborating journals. The papers will go for normal review process by the journals & the final decision rests with the respective journals. Details of the submission will be provided together with the invitation email.
5. All MMU authors receiving MMU sponsorship for DIFCON2025 participation must report publication outcomes to the RMC.
