WHAT'S COVERED

RESIDENTIAL ONE (10 – 12 June 2025 at Ashridge House, Berkhamsted)

Start with an immersive in-person three days, where you will connect with your peer group and dedicated coach. You'll dive deep into conscious leadership through interactive workshops and talks from experts and retailers. Plus, you'll begin exploring the four key lenses—**People**, **Planet**, **Profit**, and **Purpose**.

DIGITAL LEARNING BRIDGE (9 June - 18 July 2025)

Join weekly live sessions with industry experts. You'll also work through a mix of modules at your own pace on our Thrive platform, covering everything from leading through ambiguity to digital transformation. Whilst putting into practice what you are learning through a competitive business simulation project.

RESIDENTIAL TWO (23 – 24 July 2025 at Ashridge House, Berkhamsted)

Regroup in person to condense and share your new found knowledge with your peers. You'll participate in a live coaching seminar and hear from a keynote speaker before closing with a celebration and final reflection on how you can put your learns into conscious, meaningful practice.

The programme runs for 6 weeks, blending two residentials with online learning to give you flexibility while still gaining hands-on experience.

Without giving too much away for those considering Summer School in the future, all I can say is that it will change your life and get you thinking about leadership and your own purpose in ways you never have before.


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WHO IS THE BRC LEADERS SUMMER SCHOOL PERFECT FOR?


