



Chief Christoper Mannino (retired)

With 25 years of law enforcement experience in the greater Chicago area, including nearly a decade in a senior executive role, Christopher retired as chief of police in March 2022. Leveraging his extensive expertise in public communication through media relations and social media, and drawing on years of experience as an instructor and guest speaker, he became Julie Parker Communications' first full-time employee. Now serving as Vice President, he maintains strong connections to the law enforcement community, including roles as an Executive Fellow for the National Policing Institute, a committee member with the International Association of Chiefs of Police, and a long-standing member of the FBI National Academy Associates. Residing in central Florida, he is also active in regional law enforcement organizations. Christopher has authored articles for the International Association of Chiefs of Police "Police Chief" magazine and the Illinois Association of Chiefs of Police "Command" magazine, and has been featured on numerous podcasts.

Deputy Chief Mark Anderko (retired)

Mark Anderko serves as a Strategic Partnership Manager for Lexipol. Mark works cross-functionally to implement strategic market development initiatives/programs through partnerships and alliances. Mark's law enforcement career includes more than 28 years of experience in New Jersey policing. He served as the Deputy Chief of Police with the Edison Police Department, a large suburban/urban department. During his career, Mark served as an Adjunct Professor with John Jay College (NYC) and Middlesex County College, instructing undergraduate and graduate-level courses in Police Science. He also served as an adjunct instructor for Metropolitan College of New York, instructing graduate-level Emergency and Disaster Management courses. Mark also instructed the New Jersey State Association of Chiefs of Police on Command and Leadership. He served eight years as an accreditation assessor for the New Jersey State Association of Chiefs of Police Law Enforcement Accreditation Program (LEAP) and as a staff instructor for the First-line Supervision Program.





Detective Ian Mallory

Detective Mallory joined the University of Iowa Police Department in 2016 after a career in land mobile communications. Ian enjoys coming to work every day and putting his technical knowledge and tenacity to use in unraveling complex investigations, seeking out the truth, and being a voice for victims of crime. Ian's case load includes sexual abuse, death, and high value fraud/forgery investigations.

Detective Ian D. Mallory unraveled a 30-year identity theft scheme originating at a hot dog cart in New Mexico and ending at the University of Iowa with a computer network engineer with the highest level of security clearance and access taken into custody. Ink fingerprint cards, booking photos, forged documents, lost relatives, and DNA led to the capture of "Hot Dog Bill" while simultaneously vacating the sentence or a wrongfully imprisoned man.

Dr. Jennifer Prohaska is the founder of Tactical Longevity and a licensed clinical psychologist specializing in neuro-rehabilitation psychology, trauma, and critical incident response. She earned her Ph.D. from the University of Kansas in 2013 and completed her residency at the University of Kansas Medical Center, where she focused on treating traumatic brain and spinal cord injuries with life-altering consequences. Dr. Prohaska's expertise extends to use-of-force encounters, and she holds a Force Science Certification, making her one of the few psychologists with advanced knowledge in this area.

As the driving force behind Tactical Longevity, Dr. Prohaska is dedicated to preparing agencies in high-pressure industries for critical incidents. Her scientifically backed methods are designed to help both individuals and departments excel, no matter their limitations. Since establishing her practice, she has expanded her reach to support over 54 entities across three states, providing clear and effective programs that develop top performers ready for high-risk, high-stakes situations.

Dr. Prohaska is also a nationally sought-after speaker, known for her work with agencies on topics such as PTSD, chronic stress, and leadership mental health. Her deep experience in both clinical settings and public safety has made her a trusted resource for agencies looking to enhance their psychological readiness and operational effectiveness.




