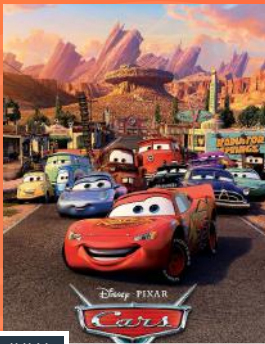

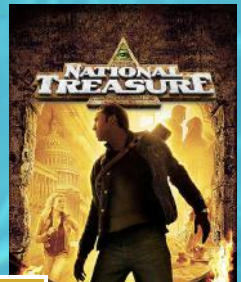

# PARK DEVELOPMENT UPDATE



## MEADOW RUN PARK COMING SOON!

An exciting new park is coming to northern Schertz in the Parklands subdivision! Meadow Run Park is an 8.8-acre neighborhood park designed to bring recreation, play, and community together in one vibrant space. The park will feature four designated pickleball courts, a multi-use sport court, and practice fields for both baseball and soccer. Families can enjoy a playground and swing set, while visitors looking to relax can gather under the park pavilion. Convenient amenities such as restrooms and a parking lot will also be available to support park users throughout the day. Stay tuned for the official Grand Opening Celebration as well as additional information on how to reserve pickleball courts and practice fields.



## WEST DIETZ CREEK TRAIL

Trails continue to be a popular request in community surveys and plans are underway to develop a 10-foot wide, approximately 1.73-mile-long trail along West Dietz Creek from Wiederstein Road to the Schertz Parkway/Live Oak intersection. This new trail will have pedestrian crossing signals at the street crossings at Savannah Drive as well as Maske Road, and will include rest stations with benches, trash cans, water fountains, and trail signage. The total project cost is estimated at \$1,603,069 and the project is funded with \$1,000,000 in federal dollars allocated through the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (AAMPO) and TxDOT, leveraging the city's match of \$603,609. The project is currently in the design phase, and construction is anticipated to start in the Fall of 2026 with an estimated completion date in Summer of 2027.



## DRY COMAL CREEK NATURE PARK

In May of 2024, the City of Schertz worked with the Great Springs Project to acquire a 10.5-acre property located generally at FM 482 and Bunker Street for the new Dry Comal Creek Trail that connects to the City of New Braunfels' Dry Comal Creek Trail, and correlates with the Great Springs Project's trail network from the Alamo to the Capitol. The site is also along the El Camino Real de los Tejas National Historic Trail and is adjacent to the historic Comal Town area. The city was awarded a \$300,000 Trails Grant from the Texas Parks & Wildlife Department to fund the development of the park and city staff is currently working to secure a design consultant to get started on the park design process. Stay tuned for more information on the community input meeting regarding the park design and be a part of shaping the future of Schertz parks and trails!

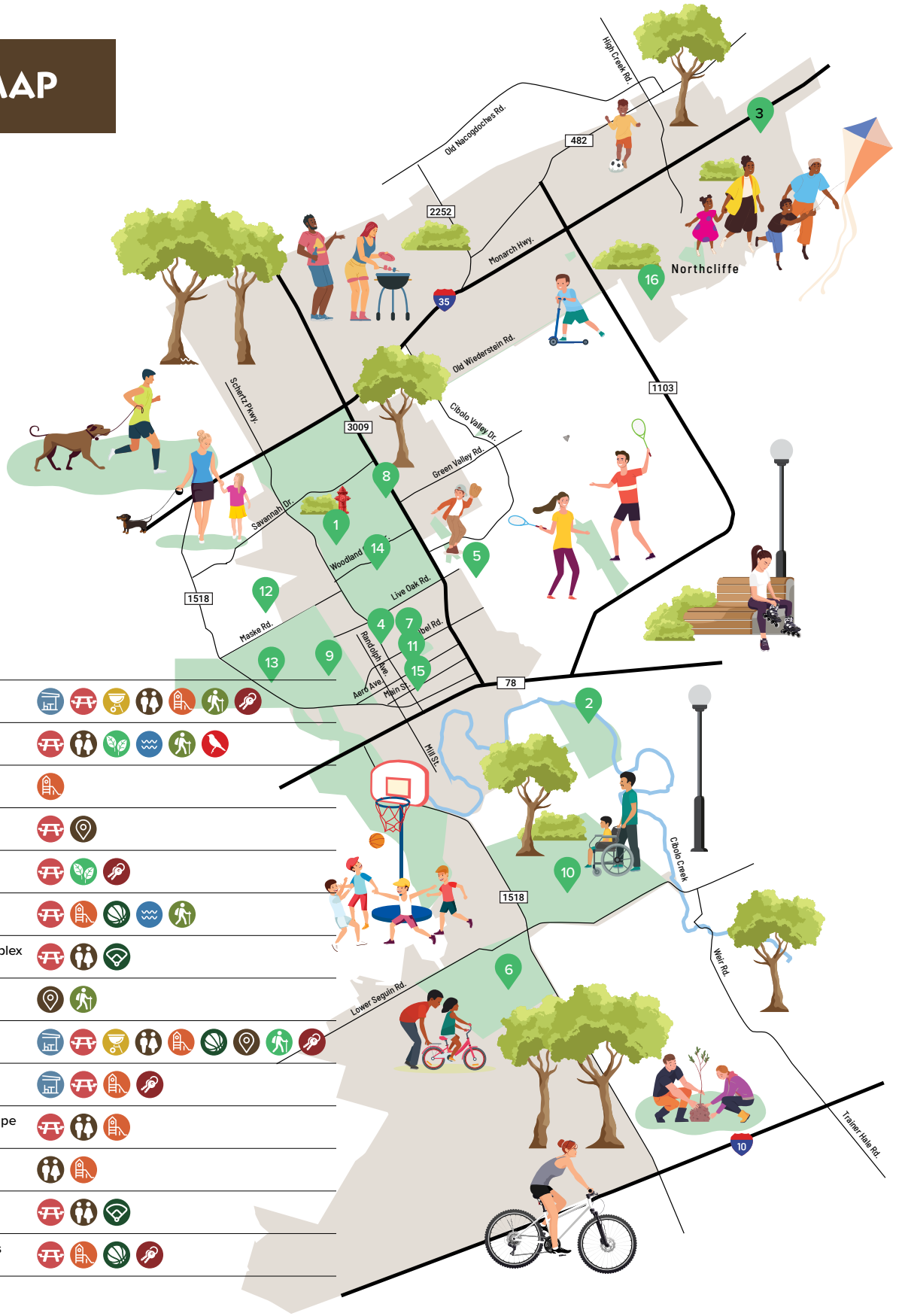
