They had all packed their favourite summer clothes and selected a toy to each take with them so that they could all play together.




The day arrived for them all to leave.

"We do!" said Dog and Duck.




"Well," said Cat, "I was out with Dad the next day and it was really sunny."



playing around the caravans and Prickles, (Ducks baby adopted sister,) was sat in the paddling pool under close supervision of their Mom.




His Mom got up from where she was sitting next to Prickles and went over to make sure her little Duck was ok...




Whilst Mom was on her way over to Duck, Prickles tried to get up so she could see what was going on.

She could hear her brother Duck crying but could not see over the top of the paddling pool as she was so short.




Prickles could not walk properly yet, but she could pull herself up. She managed to stand up but she slipped over and landed on her front.

This was because she had landed on her front and because the bottom of the pool was too slippery for her to get up again. Prickles was in big trouble!






All the Moms and Dads had gone over to see if Duck was ok. He had hurt his beak a little bit, but he would be fine.

Meanwhile Cat looked over at the paddling pool and noticed that she could not see Prickles. She went to have a look.












"Quick!" shouted

paddling pool.




... said Duck and Prickles' Mom.
