### Notes on Water Content of Aquaroids

Water content of human body: 60% +/- 15

#### Water content of aquaroid body:

- Greater than humans
- 90-99% (numbers stated in Coral Assault lore)
- Storm Dominator, Thavas's lore has a part where the troops are split between the sea and the shore with aquaroids that are >90% water assigned to the former group, and "low" water content aquaroids in the latter group. Implies the existence of aquaroids with <90% water content.
- Starting Ripple, Alecs's water content is known to be >98.5%. This is implied to be on the higher end, and confers some defensive advantages.

#### Remaining questions:

- Coral Assault's lore and Storm Dominator Thavas's appear to contradict. Possible explanation: lower water content aquaroids were only produced after a certain point in time? Simply overlooked detail? Typo?
- What's the lower end? Similar to humans? Bit higher; ~80%? How does it affect abilities?
- Concentration of water where? Intracellular? Organs? Homogenous composition body?
- Water pressure tolerance at depths? Organism with less air, more water fare better?
