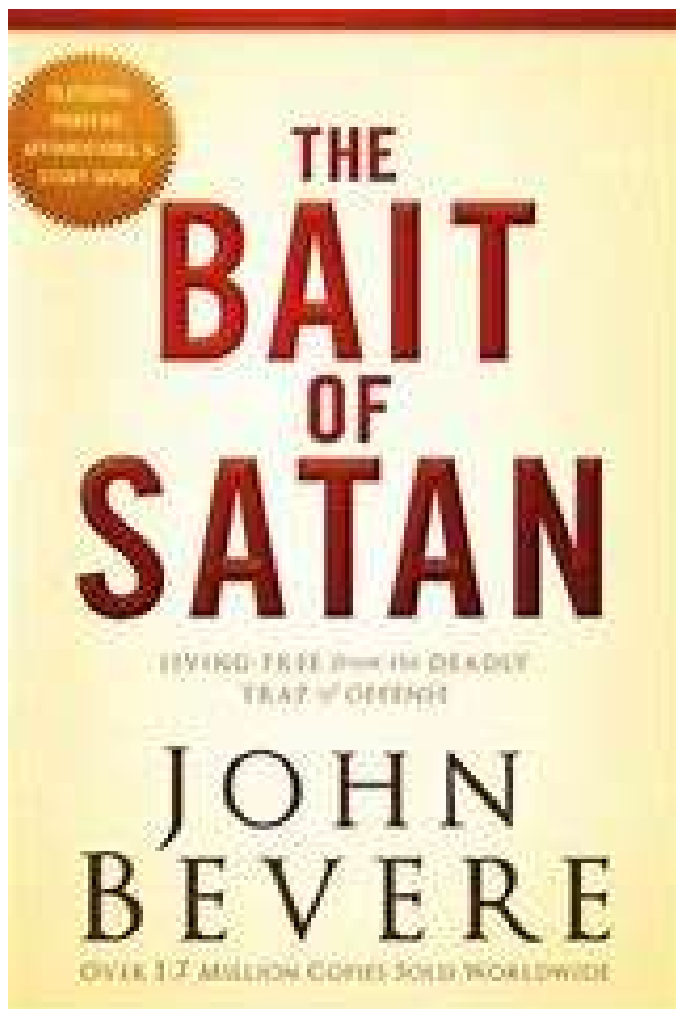

5. Daily clothe yourself in your spiritual armor.
6. If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men. *Romans 12:18*
7. FORGIVE! Yourself as well as others. Do not walk in unforgiveness.. Our Heavenly Father has forgiven us... shouldn't we forgive as well.

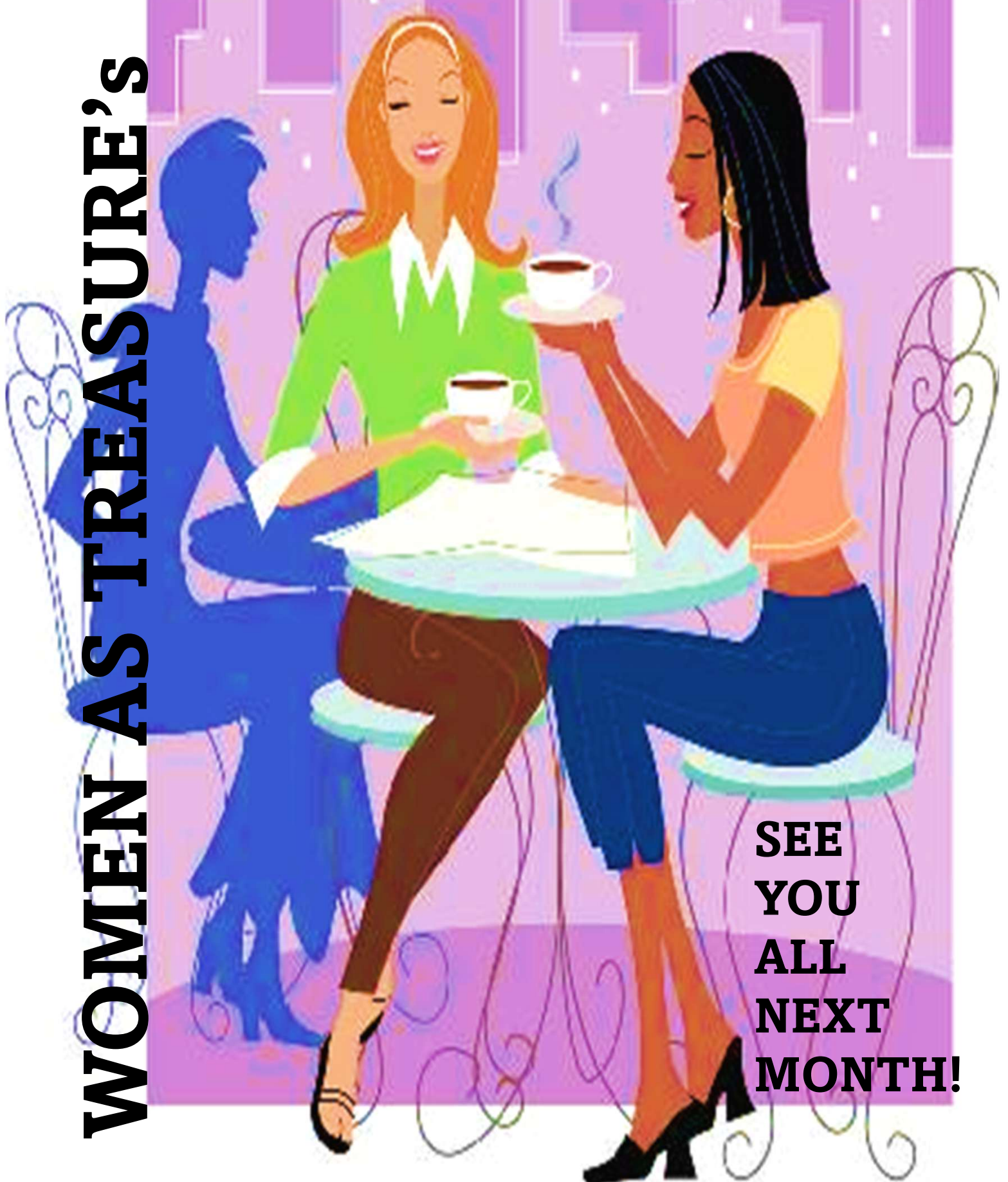
