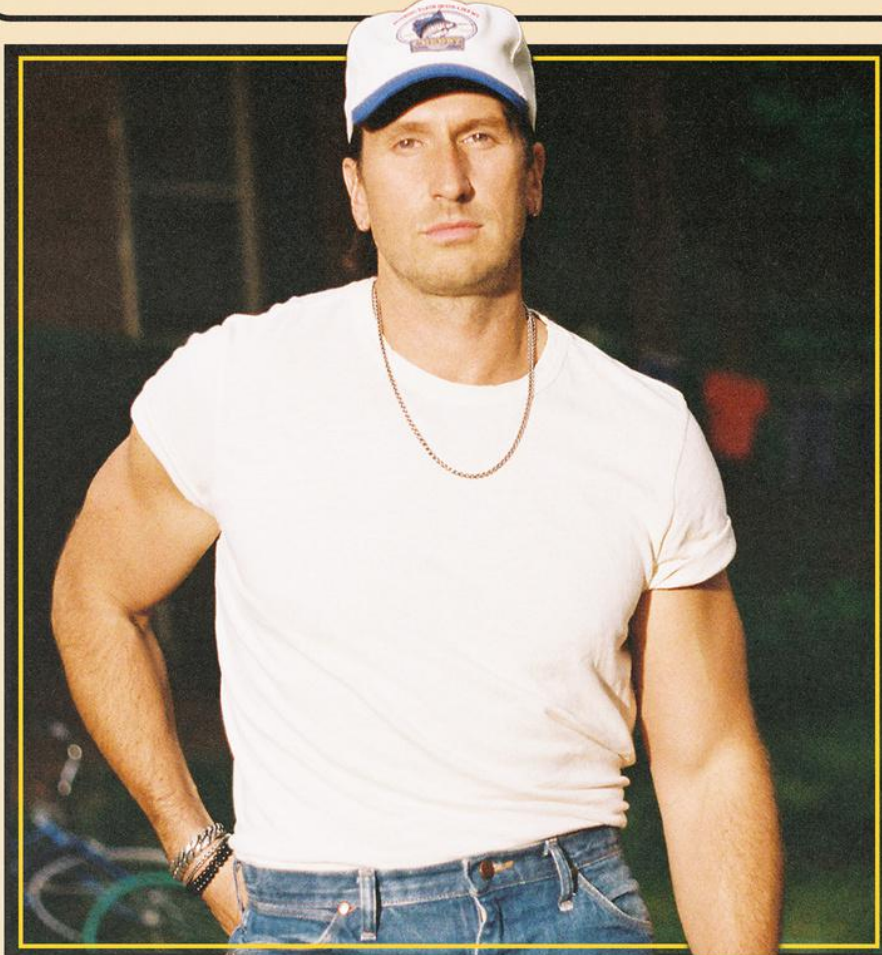

Adopt a Storm Drain

The City of Rexburg has over 1,000 storm drains. Maintenance on these proves to be a massive undertaking and lack of maintenance creates issues such as flooding, pollution of our waterways, and damage to our roads. The City makes an effort to maintain all of those drains, but due to limited resources, the City is unable to attend to each drain before and after each weather event.

How you can help:

Volunteering to adopt a storm drain is a simple and easy way to help keep our city clean and sustainable! Here's what we need volunteers to do:

1. Check your adopted drain regularly for debris (especially after storms)
2. Clear regular debris from the drain.
3. Notify the City if other issues arise.

Rexburg Police Station Bond

Over recent months, community feedback through surveys highlighted key concerns such as property taxes, costs, project scope, and affordability. In response, the Rexburg City Council has revised its proposal to better align with residents' priorities and ensure fiscal responsibility. The City is committed to transparency, providing straightforward information on its website, including updated details and key documents. Thank you for your participation and for holding local government accountable; the City will continue to listen and communicate clearly.

BOND PURPOSE:

To pay the cost of construction of a police station facility, together with related improvements and costs.

DISCLOSURE:

BOND: The interest rate anticipated on the proposed bond issue, based upon current market rates, is three and twenty-two hundredths percent (3.22%) per annum. The total amount estimated to be repaid over the life of the bonds, based on the anticipated interest rate, is \$19,304,500, consisting of \$14,995,000 in principal and \$4,309,500 of interest. The term of the bonds will not exceed fifteen (15) years from the date of issuance.

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer under the proposed bond levy is a tax of \$53.48 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, based on current conditions.

As of November 4, 2025, the water system will have debt in the amount of \$6,746,137 that is paid solely by water utility revenues and not by property taxes. The City currently has no other general obligation debt.

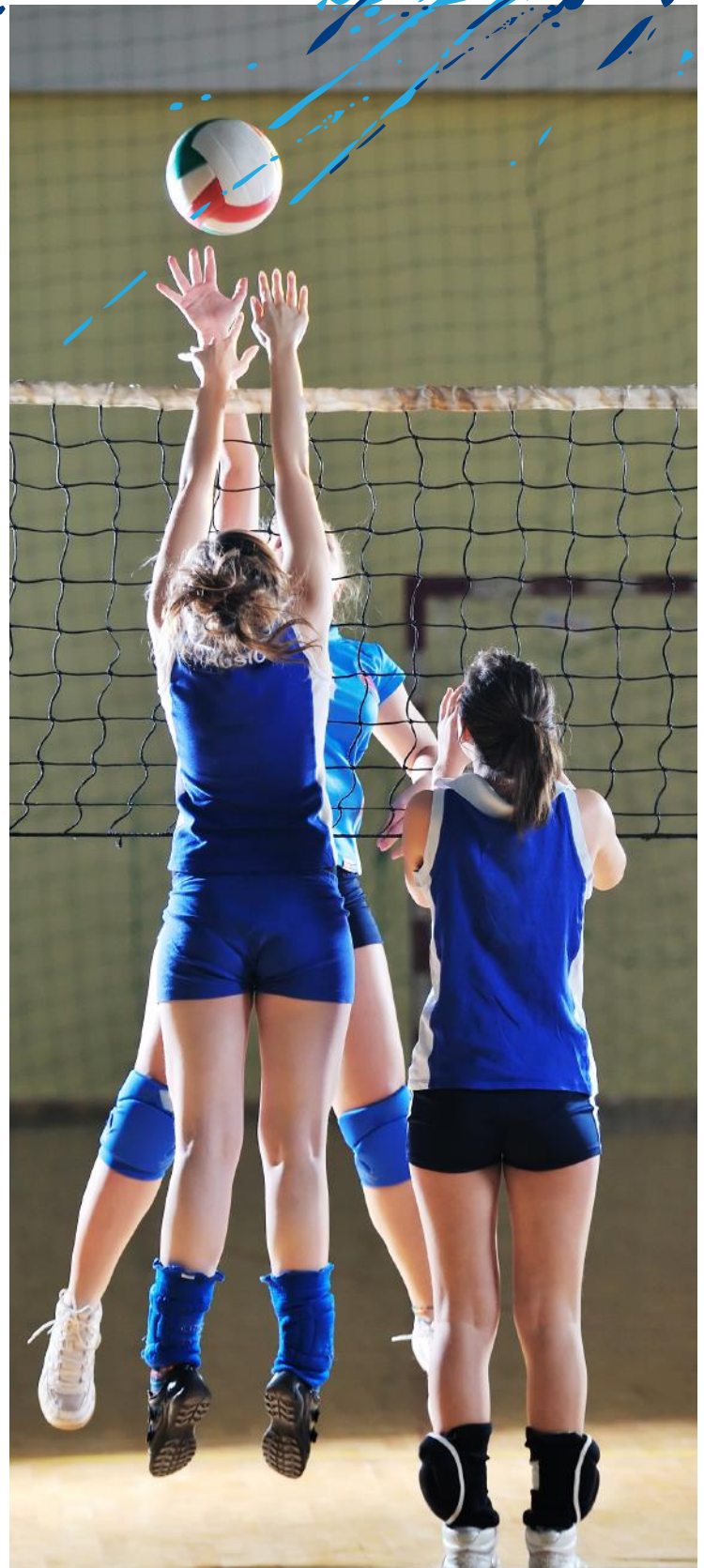

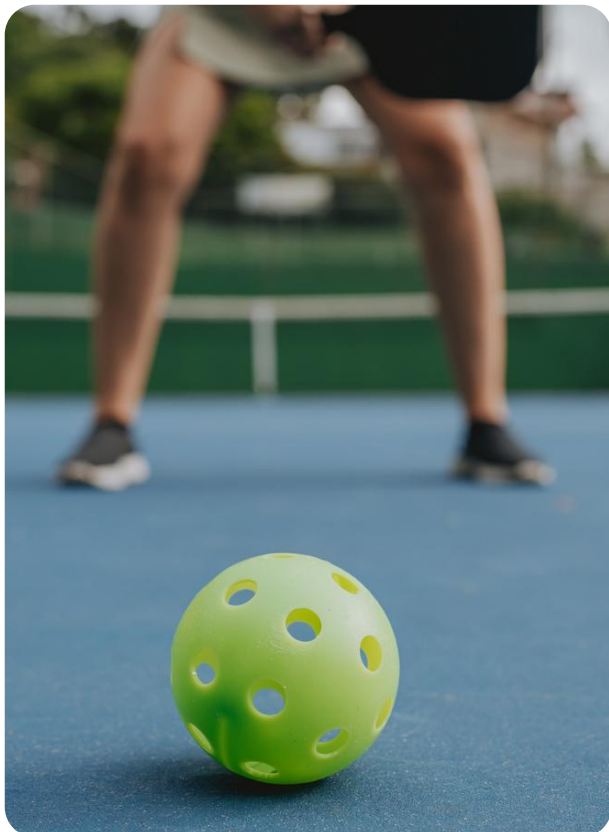

Idaho Centennial Carousel

The Idaho Centennial Carousel is Idaho's only antique wooden carousel. This beautiful antique wooden carousel was built by Spillman Engineering Company of New York in 1926. The carousel was purchased and brought to Rexburg in 1952. In 1976, the Teton Dam flood

damaged it severely; several horses were lost. From 1988-1993, skilled craftsmen restored it in time to commemorate Idaho's 100th birthday. This Rexburg Porter Park attraction delights people of all ages every summer.

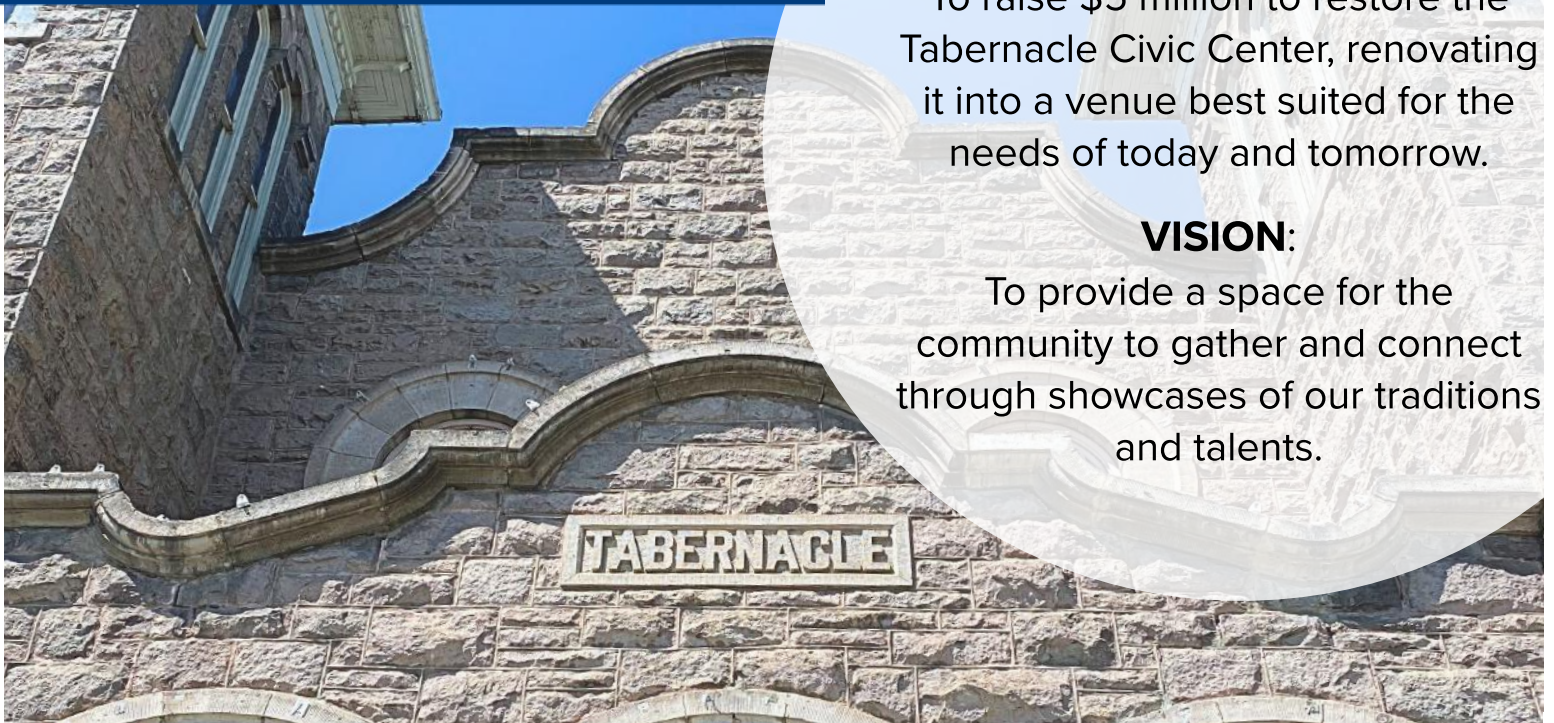
Tabernacle Civic Center

51 North Center Street

The Tabernacle is Rexburg's iconic symbol of community. Built in 1911 by the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, it was purchased by the City of Rexburg following the Teton Dam Flood in 1976. The community has rallied multiple times to restore this structure and time has come once again to retain that legacy.

MISSION:

To raise \$5 million to restore the Tabernacle Civic Center, renovating it into a venue best suited for the needs of today and tomorrow.

VISION:

To provide a space for the community to gather and connect through showcases of our traditions and talents.



Tabernacle Legacy Campaign

Rexburg's historic Tabernacle Civic Center was built in 1911 as a community effort to establish a space to gather. The City of Rexburg purchased the building after the flood and made critical repairs to preserve the space and ensure the safety of the structure. Now, another half century later, the Tabernacle is showing signs of significant wear. The City is seeking financial support to restore the building and renovate it into a venue best suited for the needs of today and tomorrow.

WHAT'S BEING DONE:

In 2024, the Tabernacle exterior saw a repointing of the stone and mortar. In 2025, fundraising efforts continued for future improvements including this year's benefit concert featuring Jon Schmidt of the Piano Guys and several grant opportunities.

This Spring, work will begin on a new HVAC system for the building, ensuring a comfortable environment all year for patrons and artists alike.

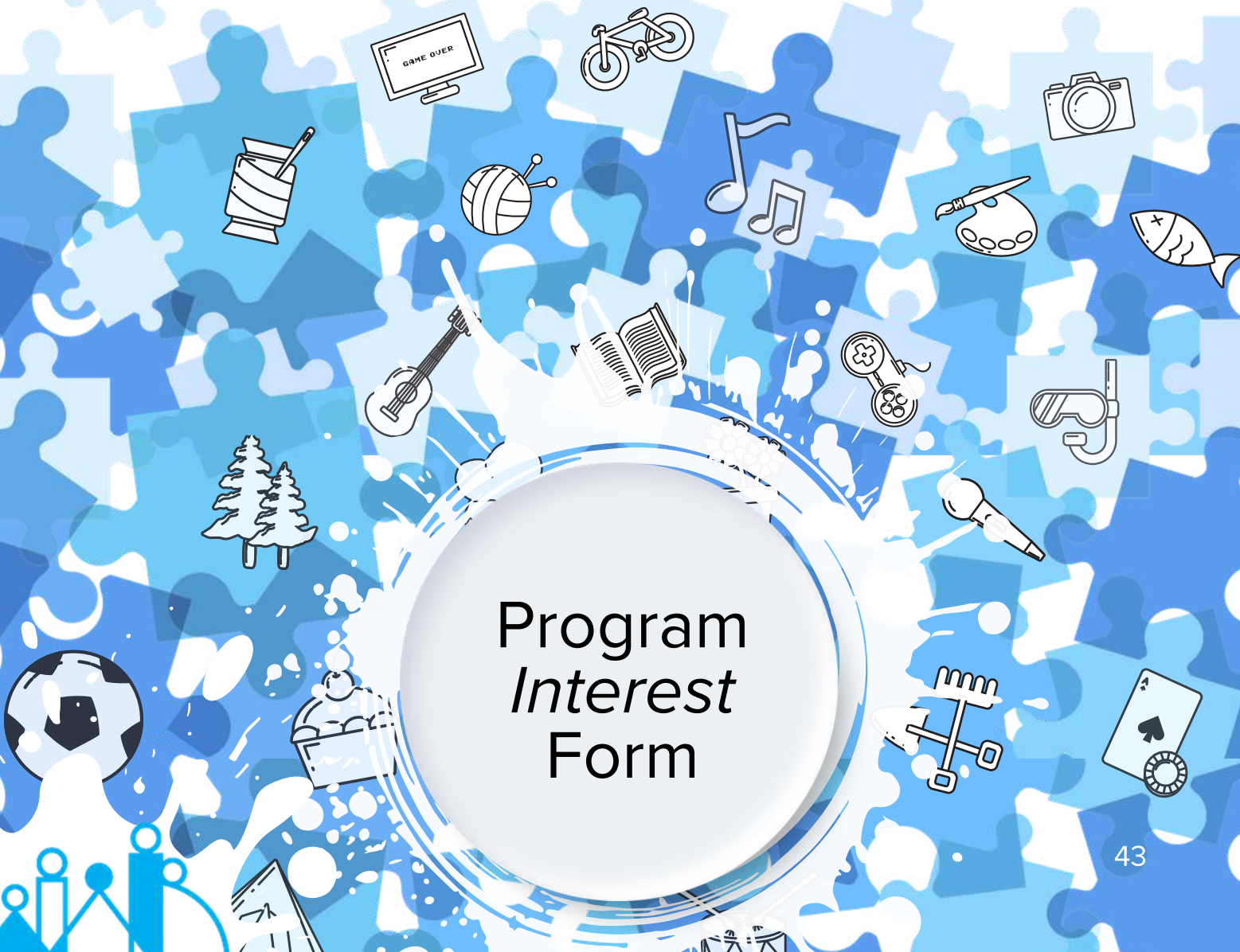
