IPSWICH WANDERERS CLUB HISTORY

- 1980 ▶ The Club started as an under 14's boys team in 1980. Two yrs later they entered the lowest division of the Ipswich Sunday League.
- 1987 ▶ Joined the newly formed Eastern Counties Division One sponsored by Jewsons in 1987 as founder members.
- 1994 ▶ Home games were played at our present ground at Humber Doucy Lane, under the name of Loadwell Ipswich. Jimmy Barker became a very influential chairman and he negotiated a name change to Lancaster Ipswich FC before we eventually became Ipswich Wanderers. Jimmy died in November 1994 and his presence is sadly missed. Thankfully after all his work he saw the floodlights switched on in September 1994 in a match against Ipswich Town.
- ▶ Great ground improvements were made in the early years under the direction of Development Officer Roger Woshalo and ground Manager Tim Davey.
- 1996-97 ▶ A losing Suffolk Senior Cup appearance in 1996/97 lead to the following season becoming Champions of Division One, under the Chairmanship of Alan Haste, nine points clear of Maldon Town and losing only three league matches all season. Reaping the rewards of a successful youth policy which saw numerous trophies filling the clubhouse cabinet, a well organised side with a good balance between youth and experience saw us establish ourselves as a Premier Division side for a number of seasons until we suffered relegation on the last day of the 2002/3 season at Wisbech.
- 2005-06 ▶ The following season saw Jason Dozzell join the Club as Manager and after a midtable finish in his first campaign, the second season saw the Club sweep to the 1st Division title and with the assistance of Kevin Cunningham and Glynn Hague, the team finished 7th in the Premier Division in 2005/6, with the League's second best defence with home crowds on average exceeding 100.
- 2006-07 ▶ At the end of the 2005/6 Jason Dozzell and Chairman David Bugg left. Local businessman Ed Nicholls became Chairman and John Clark was appointed Manager having arrived with a reputation from the West Country. During the season he guided the club to the final of the Rudgeons League Cup, the 5th round of the FA Vase and a Suffolk Premier Cup Semi Final against Ipswich Town.
- 2007-08 ▶ At the end of the campaign John left the Club and with an exodus of players, the Club appointed ex player Louis Newman to the role. Louis built a young, inexperienced squad and after a poor start to the campaign which included some record defeats, was replaced by another former player Steve Buckle who was brought in to rebuild the squad and hopefully retain the Clubs' premier status. Unfortunately Steve was unable to prevent relegation and the only positive from the season was the Reserves capture of the Chell Trophy defeating Wroxham.
- 2011-12 ▶ Despite Steve's best efforts over the following few seasons the Club failed to build a promotion push throughout the campaigns and after a poor start to the 2011/12 season, Steve and Assistant Paul Grainger parted company with the Club. New chairman Terry Fenwick appointed Glenn Read and he brought in his own players and former Stowmarket Town boss Steve Jay as his assistant. He quickly revamped the squad and had the Club climbing the table before the end of the season.
- 2012-13 ▶ The 2012/3 season saw the Club just fail to clinch promotion to the Premier Division and lose on penalties in the semi final in the First Division Cup. The season did finish on a high as the Club clinched its first ever Suffolk Senior Cup trophy defeating local rivals Whitton United in the final. It was a remarkable victory coming from a goal down in normal time and then from 3-0 down in the penalty shoot out.
- 2013-14 ▶ 2013/14 saw promotion achieved with two long unbeaten runs ensuring a return to the Premier Division, we also lost a tight Senior Cup final against Whitton United and set a new club record with a 12-1 win over Downham Town.
- 2014-15 ▶ The 2014/15 was mixed as we adapted to Premier Division and finished 9th and enjoyed a good run in the FA Vase but off field the club lost one of its driving forces Roger Woshalo mid-season.
- 2015-16 ▶ In 2015-16 we defeated Canvey Island in the FA Cup and enjoy our best ever FA Vase run but with a heavy fixture backlog, relegation fears were only ended just before the season end. Glenn stepped down at the end of the season and for 2016-17 the Club appointed Shane Wardley as Player/Manager.
- 2017-18 ▶ Shane's first season saw us almost emulate our highest ever position, however, after a poor start to the 2017-18 season Shane resigned and following a disastrous spell under Mark Benterman, club legend Mark Goldfinch took over the side ably assisted by James Buckle and Daniel Thrower. Unfortunately, relegation could not be avoided and in 2018-19 we consolidated and lost in the Senior Cup Semi Final to Cornard.
- 2019-20 ▶ In 2019-20 with Stephen Boyle taking over as Chairman, we rebuilt and after a sticky spell in October we were closing in on the promotion pack and reached a Semi Final of the Suffolk Senior Cup before the season came to an abrupt end. With further additions on field and some good improvements off field under Stephen's leadership, we then looked to gain the vital promotion required for us to take the next steps forward with a good squad. The start to the next season was positive and a second Senior Cup trophy was clinched in the delayed final with a single strike from Connor Field clinching the trophy.
- 2021-22 ▶ After a couple of Covid-19 disrupted and curtailed seasons, for the 2021/22 season Wanderers went into action in the Thurlow Nunn First Division South. With what became a tight run affair and particular rivalry with Buckhurst Hill also aiming for the title, it went almost to the wire, Wanderers finally having the upper hand, and lifting the trophy with a goal 10 seconds from time in the final home game. With the final of the Suffolk Senior Cup to follow, we finished the season with 26 straight wins, and a well deserved double of league and cup was won!
- 2022-23 ▶ The following season started with four cup fixtures in the opening 7 games, and a haul of just 3 points from the first 5 league games meant Wanderers were already playing catch up when our league campaign really got going. A run of 6 wins in an 8 game unbeaten run helped to move us up the table before another rare defeat. More wins followed until in January, we visited top of the table Thetford, which ended in a 1-2 defeat. After this, Wanderers embarked on another 17-game winning run to the end of the season, including coming from behind to avenge the result against Thetford, going above them and ultimately become Thurlow Nunn Premier winners - back to back champions - and into Step 4 football for the first time in the club's history.
- 2023-24 ▶ The 2023/24 season, the first for the club in the Isthmian League North came with added pressure - both on and off the pitch. A poor start to the season on the pitch brought a change in September, with the departure of Mark Goldfinch & James Buckle. Glen Driver came in as manager, with the task of keeping the club clear of relegation. Off the pitch was a mammoth job with a huge amount of work needed to pass the ground grading requirements to stay at this level. The inspection in April brought a great deal of relief, and along with the efforts of Glen and his team on the pitch, meant the aims for the season were achieved.
- 2024-25 ▶ Last season will go down as a disappointment but with green shoots of recovery at the end. We began the season under Glen Driver's management but unfortunately results were not positive and Glen stepped down before Christmas and we welcomed Michael Brothers into the helm, performances picked up but the damage had been done before his appointment. Michael and his management team are rebuilding well and we look forward to seeing how this develops this season as we look for a quick return to step 4.

TODAY'S VISITORS TO THE DOUCY

We welcome the players, management, officials and supporters of Walsham le Willows FC.

CLUB HISTORY

The Meadow has been the home of the village football and cricket clubs going back to the late 1800s and the old pavilion still survives on the far side of the ground, originally this had a thatched roof and water was carried across to it by bucket and then a two wheeled hand water cart was pulled across by the players. With no electricity in the original building changing could be somewhat hazardous after the game on a cold December Saturday. Football and cricket were both played at the present ground in Summer Road until the outbreak of war when the field was ploughed up to provide land suitable to grow food on. There is some confusion regarding the road that the ground stands on to this day because the signs erected by the highways authority show different names at each end of the road, Sumner Road at the main road and Summer Road at the village end.

Football started up again after the war and was played at Grove Road in the village from 1947 and the club competed in the Bury & District league Division 2. A new pitch was developed on Gallents Meadow in Ixworth Road and used from 1948 to 1951 (the reserve side was formed in 1949 to compete in the Bury Village league) when the club moved back to its present site after the generosity of the Martineau family provided the grass seed to reseed the field. Originally the pitch was across the field but upon the resumption of football at the meadow the direction of the pitch was changed to allow a new cricket square to be laid in the centre of the field. The thatched pavilion was still in use and the additions of calor gas for lighting and a calor gas boiler for tea making improved the facilities for everyone.

The amalgamation of the cricket and football clubs in 1952 then formed Walsham le Willows Sports Club. The original football stand was built in the 1950s with the new pavilion in 1973, mains electricity was added at this time and the addition of a bar and lounge area followed soon after with the snooker room, kitchen and car park added the following year.

The clubs teams have participated in the Bury & District league, Bury Village league, Stowmarket league, Suffolk & Ipswich league and now the Eastern Counties league. As a junior side the club won the Suffolk Junior cup three years running in 87-88, 88-89, and 89-90 after being beaten finalists in 73-74.

Numerous Bury and district titles and cups were won before entering the Suffolk & Ipswich league in 89-90, promotion to the senior league was achieved in that season and was quickly followed by relegation before we established ourselves as a senior side in 97-98 by finishing in 4th position. League positions then went 3rd and 4th with the league knock out cup being won in both seasons. Current manager Paul Smith was

appointed for the following campaign and the league record then went 4th, 1st, 1st and 2nd with one league knock out cup victory.

Season 2004-05 was our first in the Eastern Counties league and we finished 4th with our first ever Suffolk Senior cup final appearance at Portman Road. The following season cup success was achieved at Portman Road by winning the Suffolk Senior cup in a thrilling extra time 4-3 victory over Capel Plough. A creditable 5th position was achieved in the league and our first ever appearance in the F A Cup.

The installation of floodlights, new changing rooms and the 100 seat stand give us a facility to be proud of and in season 06-07 we became champions of Division One after exiting all cup competitions early.

This is our tenth season in the Eastern Counties Premier. During 2011 the club achieved the FA Charter Standard Community Club Award, the main pitch has been drained to improve the playing surface. The recent development over the road of 3 new pitches, car park, tennis court and artificial grass pitch 50m x 30m was completed in 2012 and provides us with some of the best facilities in the area. Season 2012 - 13 was our best ever in the Eastern Counties League Premier division with a position of 6th place and we followed this up with 8th position the following season. During 2013/14 the reserves completed a cup double in winning the league Chell trophy and the Suffolk Senior Reserve Cup to cap a fine season. A new "B" team was also entered in the Bury League. In 2014/15 all teams bar our A side struggled mainly due to the departure of several first teamers to other clubs making the other teams weaker as several Reserve team players stepped up to first team level.

The first team did reach their first ever Eastern counties Challenge cup final losing out to League Champions Norwich United in the final. Six seasons ago Mike Powles handed over the Chairmans role to Keith Mills after 16 glorious years so another chapter ended and a new one began. This season will be our fifth in the new changing rooms which were officially opened at the end of June 2016. 2018-19 saw several under 18's used at first team level on a regular basis and they more than did themselves justice, A tradition we hope to carry on with in the future. That season we finished a very creditable 9th in the League . The Reserves won the Suffolk Senior Reserves Cup. The under 18's won the Central Division of the Thurlow Nunn Premier Youth League in 2018-19 and will be playing in the Cambridge Division for the second successive season. The A and B teams are both now playing in the SIL this season following a successful season in the now disbanded Bury and District League in 2018-19. Our Veterans team will be playing in the Norfolk and Suffolk Veterans League Division one having achieved 3 successive promotions.

Sadly the Ladies team have disbanded due to a lack of playing staff but we can look forward in some confidence to the season ahead. September 2020 has seen Alan Marshall replace Keith Mills as Chairman after Keith had spent 5 years in charge.

Alan took charge at a very difficult time for football and Sport in general and he has done an excellent job. The pitches on both sides are the road are expertly prepared by Parkers Pitches and looked after by our ground staff led by Sports Club Chairman Mike Powles and Neil Hurrell and Roy Wood as well as former Chairman Keith Mills who spent some considerable time and effort which is worthwhile when you see the quality of them.

In 21-22 the First team finished 7th in the Thurlow Nunn Premier Division. The Reserves won the Suffolk Senior Reserves Cup for the third time in 8 seasons. The under 18s reached the semi final of the Suffolk Midweek Youth Cup before losing out by the odd goal in 3 to Ipswich Town. The A Team reached the Semi finals of the SIL Divisional Cup and the Veterans were runners up in the Suffolk And Norfolk Over 40s Cup and were semi finalists in the Suffolk Veterans Cup so all in all a very good season.

In 22-23 Trevor Collins resigned as first Team Manager at the start of October with Chay Budd and Ian Hubbard being installed as joint managers. Mark Cook took over from Chay as manager of the Reserves and they won the Reserves Division losing just 1 league game all season. The A team just missed out on promotion and Glen Flame has taken over as manager from Nathan Brown. 23/24 saw the Reserves become the under 23s and the A Team becomes the Reserves while Mark Dolman replaced Dan Warrington as manager of the Vets.

23/24 was a glorious one for our first team who were bottom of the league in September but improved dramatically to finish 8th and we're unbeaten in their last 11 games. In the FA Vase they reached the fourth Round proper before losing to Tilbury. The under 23s ended up finishing 6th in their first season in the new Thurlow Nunn under 23s league. The under 23s had a new manager with Justin Hunt replacing Mark Cook as manager. The under 18s had a good finish to the season and reached the semi final of the Suffolk midweek under 18s cup. Sadly the A team folded due to lack of players. The vets managed to retain their

status in Division 2 south of their league.

Last season was another exciting one in the history of Walsham Le Willows FC. The first team had the best season ever finishing fifth and reaching the play offs where they lost in the final 2-1 at Downham having beaten Fakenham in the semi final. In the Vase they again reached the fourth round proper before losing on penalties to Whitstable Town who went onto win the trophy. The under 23s had a respectable season under Justin Hunt and the under 18s finished 2nd in the Cambridge Division to Bury Town. The Vets finished second and won promotion to Division one South. This season we look forward to more success. Simon Mills has replaced Justin as under 23s manager and Chris Pollard takes over from Alan Harris as under 18s manager
