



VOLUNTEER Give Back to the Community!

VOLUNTEERS ARE THE HEART OF CARLE HEALTH PEKIN HOSPITAL



Whether transporting patients to their cars after recovering from surgery, helping people find their way in the hospital or keeping waiting rooms stocked with essential supplies, volunteers at Carle Health Pekin Hospital put their hearts into everything they do.

There are plenty of opportunities to share your time and talents at Carle Health Pekin, and more volunteers are needed who want to serve in active roles.

Clyde Laier, a retired Tazewell County engineer, is just one member of the volunteer team who shares his time every week. He spends his time escorting patients in wheelchairs and also makes various deliveries to the lab.

"I work with a bunch of great people. It's very rewarding. You meet all types of people. They are asking for help and I am there to help," Clyde said. "I always start out the day and ask the Lord to let me be an encouragement to someone else today."

In addition to patient escorts, like Clyde, volunteers help at the hospital front entrance and waiting areas in surgery and radiology. There are also certified pet therapy teams who bring smiles to patients and care teams. Others help with special projects and in hospitality roles.

A new hospitality volunteer opportunity being launched at Carle Health Pekin is Patient Comfort Rounds. Comfort Rounds involves volunteers visiting hospital inpatients with items aimed at improving the patient experience. Suggested items for the cart came directly from caregivers and patients on the frontlines, including activities, lip balm, cheer cards, magazines, books and more. Patients are never charged for items on the comfort rounds cart, and the visits are even more special with smiles and friendly conversation from caring volunteers who have the gift of unhurried time.

Vivacious volunteer, Wendy Barnes, retired after 30 years of being a high school science and health teacher. She is a dedicated comfort rounds volunteer at another Carle Health location where the program has existed for a couple of years. Wendy says she looks forward to meeting patients and sharing something from the Comfort Cart when she volunteers every other week.

"Maybe I can bring comfort and a smile to someone," she said.

Volunteering isn't only in the form of patient service roles at Carle Health Pekin. The Pekin Hospital League operates completely by volunteers and supports projects for Carle Health in the Pekin and greater Peoria communities through their gift boutique inside the hospital and the Nearly Nu thrift shop on Derby Street in Pekin, as well as various fundraisers. Most recently their proceeds benefited Trillium Place Young Minds in West Peoria, which offers a safe, supportive place for adolescents to receive help for behavioral health concerns.
