

Business Succession: The Buy-Sell Agreement

If you hold an interest in a business that's closely held or family owned, a buy-sell agreement should be a component of your estate plan. The agreement provides for the orderly disposition of each owner's interest after a "triggering event," such as death, disability, divorce or withdrawal from the business. It accomplishes this by permitting or requiring the company or the remaining owners to purchase the departing owner's interest. 
