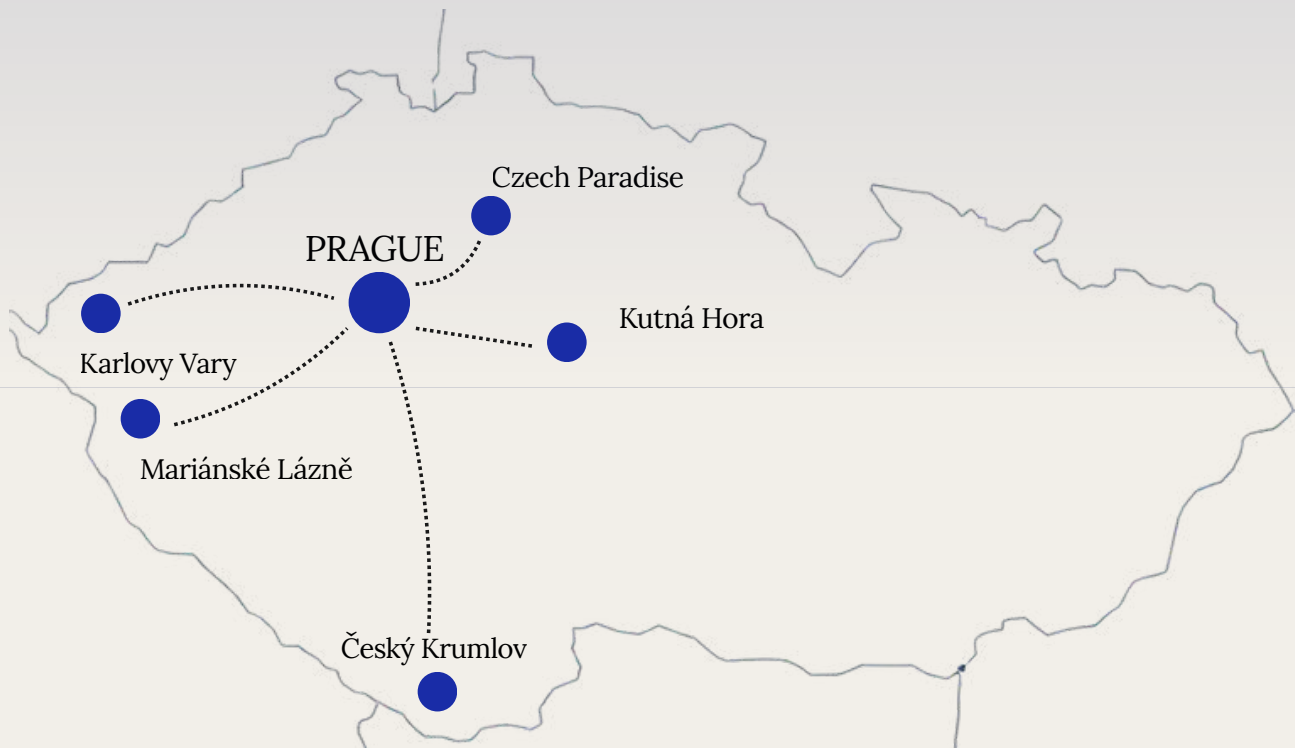

Choice between a historic Gothic town or an elegant spa destination.

Day 6 – Bohemian Paradise or Leisure

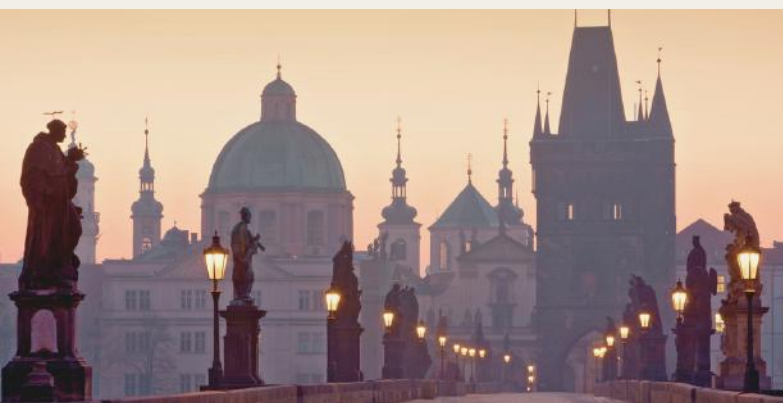
Optional nature excursion or a relaxed day in Prague focused on local life.

DAY 1

The City of a Hundred Spires

Prague feels timeless – a city where every street holds a story and every tower watches over centuries of change. The Vltava River winds through the heart of the city, beneath the graceful arches of the Charles Bridge, connecting Gothic cathedrals, Baroque palaces, and lively squares.

From the majesty of Prague Castle to the charm of Old Town Square, the city invites you to wander at your own pace. Stroll through narrow lanes, pause in hidden courtyards, and enjoy a quiet moment in a local café as the sound of trams passes by.

Beyond the famous landmarks, Prague reveals a creative soul – art galleries, music, and a culinary scene that bridges Czech tradition and modern inspiration. It's a city that welcomes you warmly and stays in your memory long after you've gone.

Day 1 Arriving in PRAGUE

Private airport pickup and transfer to your boutique hotel in the heart of Prague.

In the early evening, an orientation drive through illuminated Prague, passing Wenceslas Square, the Dancing House, the National Theatre, and the Vltava riverbanks, offering a first glimpse of the city's atmosphere.

Optional dinner at a carefully selected local restaurant serving traditional Czech cuisine such as goulash, roast duck, or Svíčková.

Overnight in Prague.

DAY 2 Old Town & Literary Prague

Walking tour through Prague's Old Town, exploring Old Town Square and the Astronomical Clock, Old Town Hall, hidden courtyards and medieval passages, Franz Kafka's birthplace and memorial near the Jewish Quarter.

The medieval charm of Charles Bridge with views of Prague Castle, including stories of legends, saints, and daily life along the river.

Local stops to try Trdelník (chimney cake) and artisanal coffee in a historic café associated with Prague's writers and intellectuals.

Optional visit to:

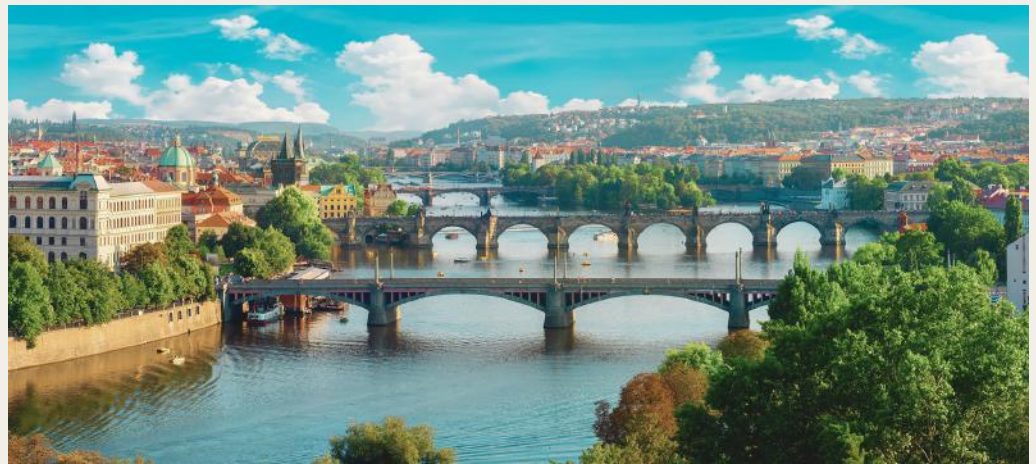
- Maisel and Pinkas Synagogues
- the Old Jewish Cemetery, one of the oldest active Jewish cemeteries in Europe

Afternoon at leisure. Evening free with optional classical music concert.

Overnight in Prague.

PRAGUE, CZECH REPUBLIC

The Heart of Bohemia

Prague, the heart of Bohemia, is a city of timeless beauty and quiet stories. Overlooking the Vltava River, Prague Castle crowns the skyline, while the Charles Bridge connects centuries of history with every step. In the Old Town Square, the Astronomical Clock still measures time as trams and street musicians bring the city to life.

Wander through Lesser Town and the Jewish Quarter, where history, faith, and daily life meet in peaceful balance. Between cobblestones, cafés, and riverside views, Prague invites you to slow down, look closer, and feel part of something truly enduring.

DAY 3 CASTLE & LESSER TOWN

Discover the majestic Prague Castle complex, including St. Vitus Cathedral, admired for its striking stained-glass windows designed by Alfons Mucha. Continue to the Golden Lane, once home to craftsmen and writers, including Franz Kafka.

Enjoy a panoramic walk descending into Malá Strana, with stops at the John Lennon Wall and Kampa Island, known for its modern art and relaxed riverside atmosphere.

Afternoon coffee at Café Savoy, a beloved local institution. Optional visit to Vyšehrad for sunset views over Prague's rooftops.

Overnight in Prague.

DAY 4



ČESKÝ KRUMLOV

A Storybook Town by the River

Český Krumlov is a beautifully preserved medieval town set along a gentle bend of the Vltava River. Cobblestone streets, Renaissance and Baroque architecture, and the castle rising above the old town create a timeless atmosphere. Beyond its iconic views, Český Krumlov invites slower discovery – quiet corners, artisan shops, and riverside cafés that reveal the town's charm away from the main routes.

DAY 4 Day trip to Český Krumlov

Morning departure through the South Bohemian countryside toward the UNESCO-listed town of Český Krumlov.

Guided walk through the historic center, exploring the Český Krumlov Castle complex with panoramic views over the town, the Old Town Square and Renaissance façades, winding medieval streets following the curve of the Vltava River.

Free time for lunch by the river, artisan shops, or quiet viewpoints away from the busiest routes. Late afternoon return to Prague.

Evening at leisure.

Overnight in Prague.





DAY 5 Kutná Hora or Karlovy Vary

Option 1 Kutná Hora: Mysticism and Medieval Power

Journey to the former silver-mining town of Kutná Hora. You can see exceptional St. Barbara's Cathedral, a masterpiece of Gothic architecture, the historic town center shaped by royal wealth, the symbolic ossuary at Sedlec, one of Europe's most striking spiritual sites

Option 2 Karlovy Vary: Spa Elegance

Travel west to Karlovy Vary, exploring the Mill and Market Colonnades, tasting of mineral springs, elegant spa architecture along the Teplá River.

Free time to enjoy the refined spa atmosphere before returning to Prague in the evening.

- Czech beer tasting with an introduction to brewing traditions and regional styles

Overnight in Prague.

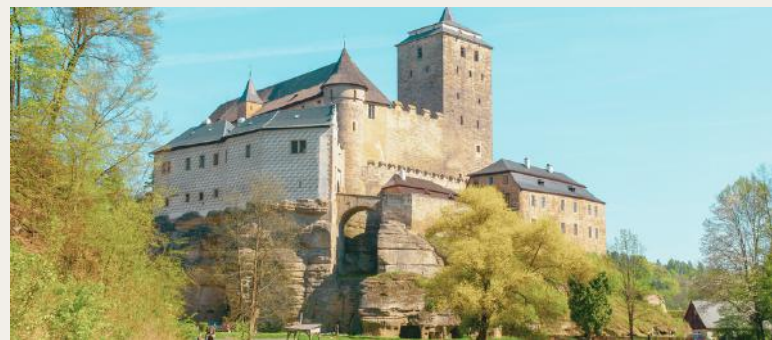
