Whether you're traveling solo, with family, friends, or colleagues, you'll discover the exciting regional assets that each *Medina County* community offers. From quaint local shops and restaurants to exciting outdoor activities and cultural events, you'll be sure to see why our visitors keep coming back for **great road trips and getaways!** Each region welcomes visitors to their unique attractions with surrounding amenities designed to make your trip extraordinary. From *Wadsworth* to Historic *Medina* to *Brunswick* and all our surrounding villages and towns, we're positive you'll enjoy turning the pages to plan your next getaway and *Picture Yourself in Medina County!*

Easily accessible! Travelers arriving by car can reach the county via major Interstate highways, including *I-71*, which runs north-south through the region, and the *Ohio Turnpike (I-80/90)*, providing convenient east-west access across northern Ohio. These routes connect *Medina County* to *Cleveland*, *Columbus*, and surrounding states, with well-marked state highways leading directly into the county's communities. For air travel, visitors can use *Cleveland Hopkins International Airport (CLE)*, about 15 miles north, or *Akron-Canton Airport (CAK)*, roughly 25 miles southeast. Both airports offer rental cars and ground transportation options, making it easy to reach Medina County from either location.

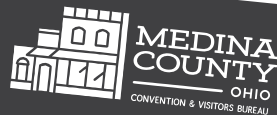

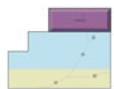

Northwest: Travel southeast on I-75 or I-90/I-80 toward Cleveland, then follow I-71 south. Exit onto OH-303.



Southeast: Head northwest on I-77 or I-79 into Ohio, find a connection to I-71 north or I-76 west (Exit onto I-71). Off I-71 exit onto OH-303.



Southwest: Drive northeast on I-75 or I-71 into Ohio, toward Cleveland. Exit onto OH-303.

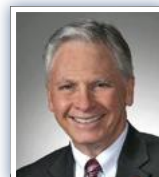


In the early 1960s, the Tri-County (Summit, Medina and Portage) Regional Planning Commission predicted that the Brunswick, Hinckley and Liverpool area of Medina County would grow so fast and large that only the City of Akron would be larger in population. Predicting a total population of 117,500 for northern Medina County, Brunswick City would be exceeded by Brunswick Hills and Hinckley Townships. It didn't happen that way.

Anticipating the influence of nearby Cuyahoga County, planners didn't realize that the communities would decide

to grow in a way that maintained a balance of nature, farms, commerce, industry and homesteads. Sixty years later, Brunswick, Hinckley and Liverpool boasts the vibrancy of choices for suburban living, rural atmosphere, thriving industrial parks, celebrated agritourism, family farms and proximity to some of the largest public parks in Medina County.

WHAT WAS YOUR VISION FOR MAPLESIDE?

Mapleside has been a family farm for over 200 years. In the early 1800s, the Tillotson family built Brunswick's first house on the property and it was a rustic log cabin made from trees they cut down on the surrounding land. Our vision continues to be to preserve the authenticity of one of the most incredible and historic places in Ohio. When we purchased the farm in 2010, we sensed the world was shifting toward family experiences over consumption of things. People wanted authenticity. They wanted to experience life with the people they love and spend time doing things to create memories. In 2011, Mapleside was voted America's Most Beautiful Farm and we have spent every year since finding new ways to share it with residents and visitors alike. One of our most loved traditions is live music under the stars for our summer concert series. This event brings in hundreds of families on Friday nights to experience high quality music set to the backdrop of a 50 mile view, which is one of the most amazing views in Northeast Ohio. During the late summer and fall months, we have festivals that bring families back season after season. During the winter, we have concerts in our barn



and help families to ward off the winter blues with more great music and opportunities to gather with friends. Mapleside hosts weddings in the orchards that are true storybook moments. This season we will open a new picturesque winery that will give people one more reason to slow down and stay at the farm for a while longer.



WHY DID YOU CHOOSE THIS LOCATION?

We didn't choose this location, it chose us. We grew up in Brunswick and our families have been coming to this farm since we were little kids. The opportunity to be creative and bring new things to life and offer new family traditions, while preserving what makes this place special has been a dream come true. Being located in northern Medina County gives our visitors easy access to not only travel here, but stay in beautiful hotels and utilize the amenities in our surrounding area.

HOW DO YOU WANT PEOPLE TO FEEL WHEN THEY'RE AT MAPLESIDE?

We desire for people to feel connected. Connected to the earth. Connected to nature. Connected to each other. In a world that pulls us in a thousand directions, Mapleside



is a place where families slow down and remember what matters. Whether you're at Mapleside for a concert, wedding or festival, the buzz of connectedness that you feel spreads in all of those enjoying their time here.

Seeing children have fun with their families and experiencing firsts of riding a giant 311 foot slide or laughing while they bounce super high on the jumping pillows brings smiles and engagement. Family themed weekends encourage imagination and whimsy for events like Pirates and Princess weekend or getting lost in the story that leads you through a corn maze built for little ones. It's an honor to create opportunities to make everyone feel like a kid again.

One of our most notorious festivals happens multiple

weekends during fall. Families can visit our Pumpkin village to pick apples, take photos in front of the giant pumpkin wall, ride the cow and pig train and even choose their own pumpkin. Watching the billy goats frolic and play while sipping on cider is enough to make anyone smile. We also host events for adults only like Vino the Way which offers a chance for people to meander into special spots set up in the cornmazes to find drink stations with wines and beer to sample while they walk.

If you love to have fun with your family and friends, experiencing Mapleside in the fall is a must. You feel the history in the land, the seasons in the air, and the presence of the people beside you.

WHAT IS YOUR FAVORITE THING ABOUT MAPLESIDE BEING IN MEDINA COUNTY?

Medina County is the perfect place to live and raise a family. It serves as home for so many and because of that, we feel passionate about keeping that spirit of family alive. This region draws people from all over Northeast Ohio and beyond because it feels a little slower here. A little more authentic. That's exactly the kind of place Mapleside belongs—and the kind of place worth building traditions around.

Whether you're gathering, celebrating, or simply taking it all in, Mapleside is where memories are made — year after year.

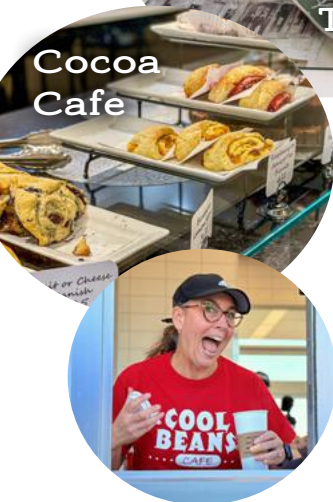

Market 42 is an innovative food hall and market that provides a unique opportunity to meet the growing demand for artisanal retail and culinary experiences in the region. It is ideally situated to become the go-to destination for carefully curated local artisan brands and restaurant concepts. Our focus is on sourcing farm fresh foods and sundry retail

offerings from all corners of Ohio, creating an unparalleled experience for both visitors and locals.

The sitting area surrounding the bar can accommodate 120 people and there are 46 stools at the wine cellar and bar. In addition, our outdoor covered patio will be able to accommodate seating for an additional 60 visitors when the weather permits.

Semiprivate event space is available for business, and personal events. Starting in May of 2026 and through end of September, an open air outside Farmers Market will take place on Weekends 9a-1p.

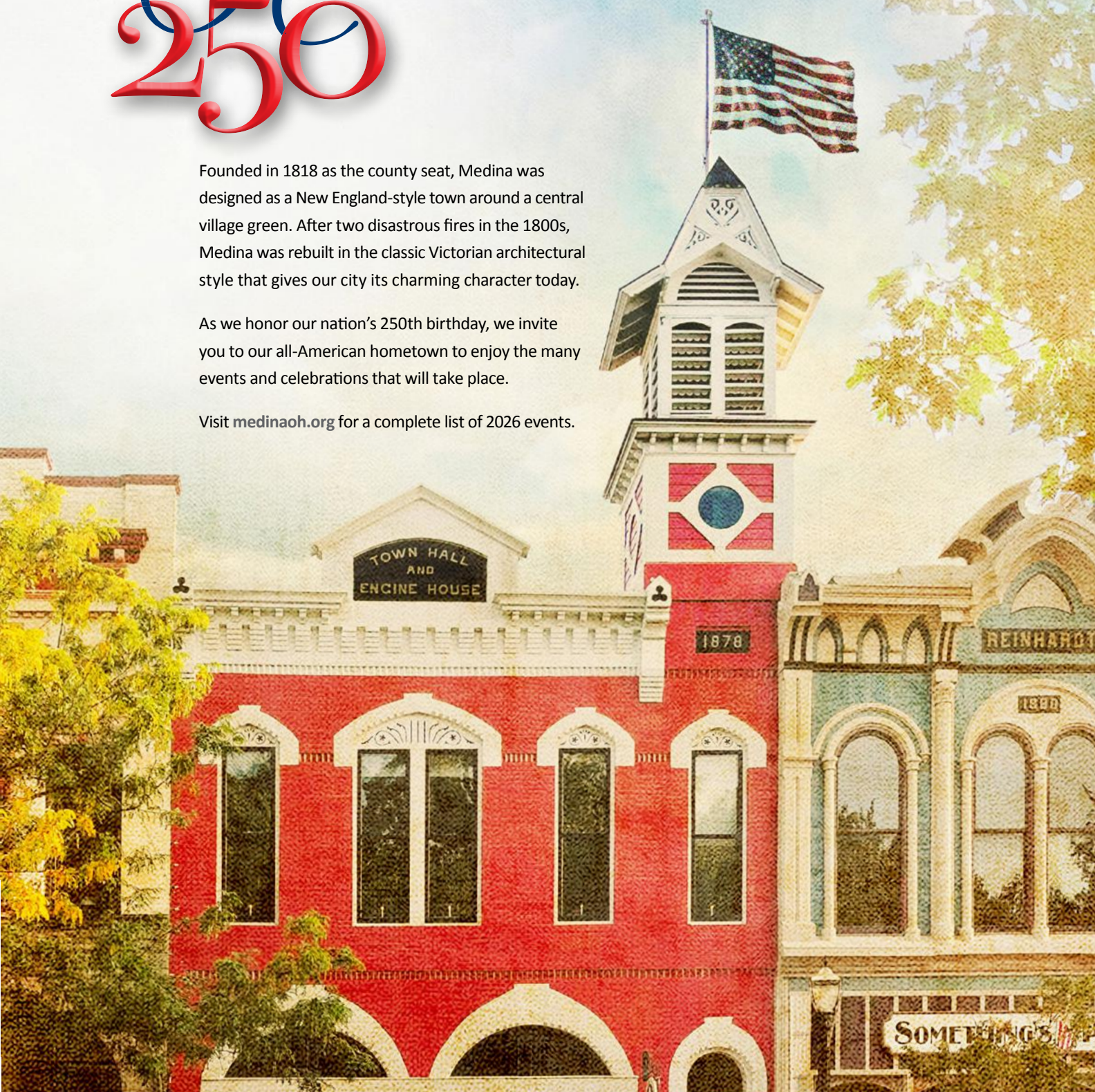

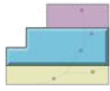
CELEBRATING *America* 250

As we honor our nation's 250th birthday, we invite you to our all-American hometown to enjoy the many events and celebrations that will take place.

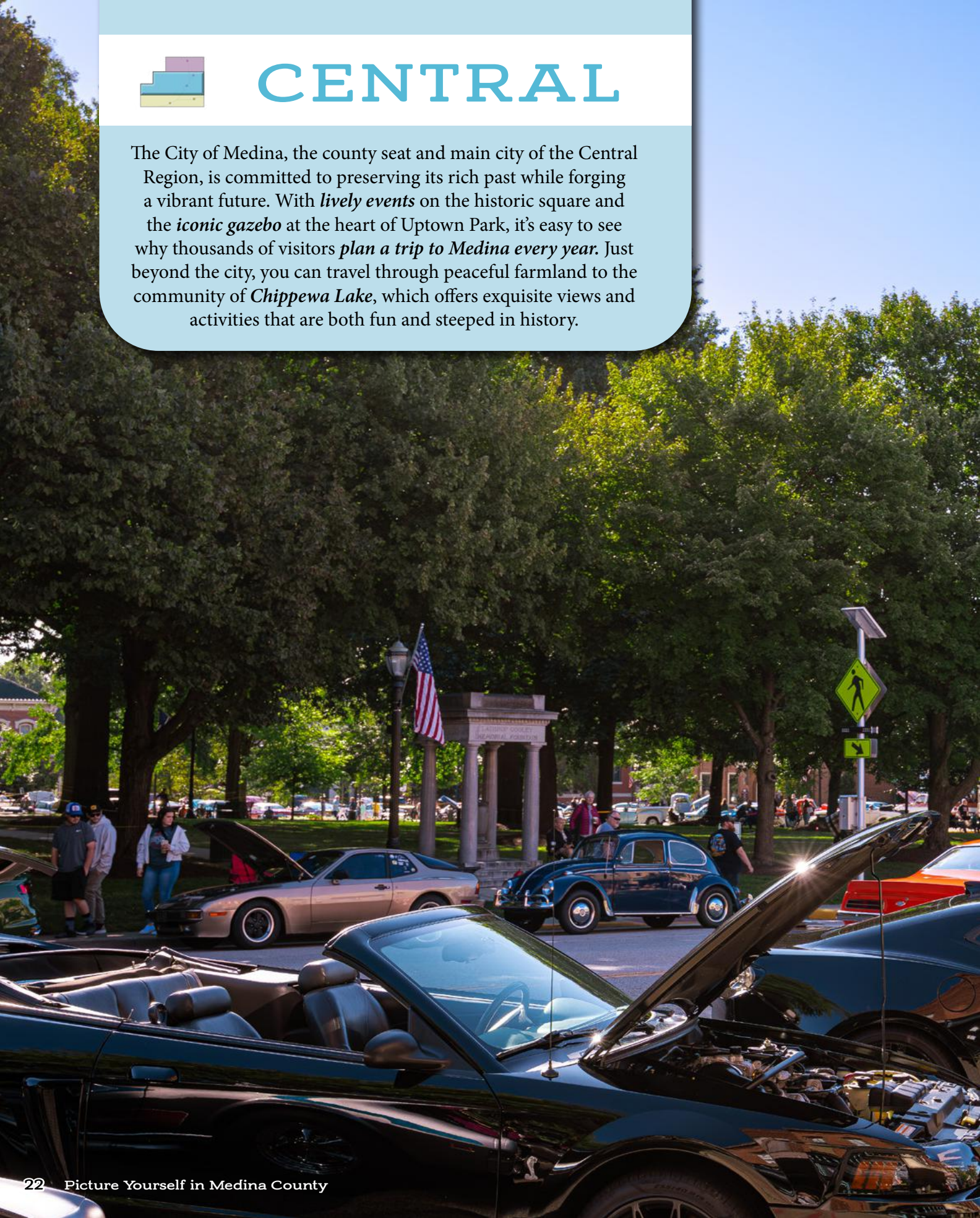

A Century-Old Stage For Concerts, Plays & Community Gatherings

What Was Your Vision for Celestia?

I clearly had a vision that wasn't much of decor and paint colors, but to offer a "traditional theater" with music, comedy and dance. I knew if we could transform this theater into an inviting concert venue, with a certain openness and vibe, we could keep visitors coming back. There is a regional base of concert goers and event attendees that are tired of the same old concert experiences of over-priced parking, overpriced tickets, venues in unsafe areas and the need to travel to other cities.

We also had to make a connection to those who came in this space before, yet reach out into the county and region as a whole and transform the place from a "School Auditorium" into a state-of-the-Art Concert Venue. It's not often that the plan you put on paper turns out BETTER than what you planned, but that's what has happened here.

Can You Tell Me a Little More About the Wadsworth Square Foundation?

We knew that the renovation, operations and ongoing overhead was going to be more costly than ticket sales could support. Successful theaters are run by focused

non-profit leaders that can help raise money through member engagement, private sector partnerships and grants from various sources. This is how WSF was born. We were not reinventing the wheel. We examined how other groups in our region were thriving and scaled that plan to fit this place.

The support so far has been amazing and we could not be happier with our current position.

Why Did You Choose the School to Bring this Vision to Life?



Really, this place chose us, I truly believe that. My parents moved our family to Wadsworth in the mid 1980's and my first real experience in the City of Wadsworth was at that school. My 2 brothers and 2 sisters attended school there. That auditorium was the first real place I performed in the middle school band, then in high school, then again on the technical theater side. After High school, I worked theater jobs in lighting and many shows were in that theater. It has always had a special connection, even as recent as the last couple years watching our daughter play her



first band concerts there.

When I saw the school building and campus were going to be for sale, I thought, “boy I hope whoever takes that building over keeps the theater standing and makes it into something special so all those old memories and connections remain and more can be created”.

It has been an honor and a privilege to see this through. And so many people have thanked our team for re-imagining the place into something accessible and fantastic and more importantly, saving this historic theater.

How Do You Want People to Feel When They are at Celestia?

The Celestia itself is beautiful inside and has a very “Cool” vibe. People love a very intimate performance space, unique bar, great volunteers who welcome them every night and a staff that goes above and beyond to make sure the EXPERIENCE is not like anywhere else in the region. The City of Wadsworth is probably the best place this opportunity could arise. There is plenty of free downtown parking, a small town downtown corridor, retail and restaurant districts for pre-show dining, and shopping- all set in an outstanding, low crime area with an amazing police and safety forces. How people would feel was one of the toughest concepts to bring together be-

cause we knew there were so many facets to it. We wanted to honor and respect the folks who had history here, but we knew we had to tie it up in a huge bow so when people came here on NIGHT ONE, we could check all the boxes.

What is Your Favorite Thing About Your Attraction Being in Medina County?

For decades I have been an ambassador to Ohio and Medina County. I have traveled the country in my youth as a musician for almost a decade and every time I was glad to come home to Wadsworth. In my opinion there is not one place better in this state than Medina County. I love the small town charm of our cities, the unique things our villages and townships offer and the PRIDE everyone takes in their little piece of this country. In the Celestia Theater, we have a special place to gather, a place close to home to enjoy a concert or the ballet or catch up on the best local musicians in NE Ohio. No one is doing what we do or making the commitment we are making to local artists and businesses. The Celestia Theater is here for everyone in the country to enjoy, and our goal is to do our best to provide an affordable night out, and we want people to leave at the end of the night with an experience they will talk about for weeks after.
