## **8 DAY “BEST OF NEWFOUNDLAND” TOUR - DAILY ITINERARY**

### **Day One**

Our coach transfer to Toronto airport is followed by our afternoon flight to St. John’s. Upon arrival in St. John’s, we meet our “local” tour guide who will provide a warm welcome, baggage service as well as an expert and entertaining interpretation on the short drive to our downtown hotel. Tonight, we will enjoy a get-together to learn more about the adventure ahead.

### **Day Two**

An historic tour of St. John’s will provide a brilliant interpretation of North America’s oldest city. Visit Cabot Tower and Signal Hill to view the “Narrows” and admire the architecture of old St. John’s, including the famous “Jellybean Houses”. Natural wonders abound on this afternoon’s boat trip to the Witless Bay Ecological Reserve to view Atlantic Puffins, Murres and the millions of seabirds that nest on these coastal islands. This is a favourite feeding ground for Humpback, Minke, and Fin whales where multiple sightings are a definite possibility. Visit Cape Spear National Historic Park, the most easterly point of land in North America. We will end the day with a visit to Quidi Vidi Brewery for a tasting.

### **Day Three**

This morning we’ll head out on a journey around the bay where our guide will regale us with tales of the region’s exciting history. This was the home of pirate Peter Easton, where WW2 German U-boats sank 3 iron ore boats at their moorings and where “Flying Boats” refueled on their first transatlantic crossings. These are fascinating, resilient, coastal communities offering natural beauty and wonderful photographic opportunities

### **Day Four**

This morning we travel to the historic village of Trinity, one of the oldest communities in North America. We’ll have an opportunity to hike the Skerwink Trail. This legendary landscape consists of many uniquely u-shaped sea stacks and other amazing geological features. Next, we are off to Bonavista, the landfall of John Cabot in 1497. Here we visit the Ryan Premises to learn about inshore fishing techniques that have allowed this town to thrive for hundreds of years. This afternoon we visit Cape Bonavista for a chance to walk the cliffs and enjoy the spectacular coastal scenery. We will also visit Elliston where we can view puffins from land.

### **Day Five**

This morning we wind our way around the beautiful coastline of Terra Nova National Park with stops at the Marine Interpretation Center as well as the historic fishing village of Salvage. Following a delightful seaside lunch, we continue our journey to visit the town of Gander, where locals kindly welcomed the “Come From Away” 9/11 guests into their homes and communities

### **Day Six**

Today we are off on the “Road to the Isles” travelling across “Tickles and Runs” to spend time on beautiful Twillingate Island. This is one of Newfoundland’s oldest and most interesting fishing communities. We visit the lighthouse at Crow Head, the Auk Island Winery for a sample of their wares, and the Beothuck Center in Boyd’s Cove where we learn about the native groups that once occupied Newfoundland.

### **Day Seven**

This morning we take a leisurely trip to the central Newfoundland logging town of Grand Falls-Windsor. Here we visit the Exploits River to watch the Atlantic Salmon make their way up one of the fishways on this massive river system. We continue to the town of King’s Point for a lovely seaside lunch before we head to Gros Morne National Park for our last night together.

This evening we share our farewell dinner.

### **Day Eight**

This morning we enjoy a boat tour across beautiful Bonne Bay to Woody Point. The trip offers spectacular views of the park’s vistas as well as the Tableland Mountains. This golden mountain range made up of rocks formed from the Earth’s mantle earned the park it’s nickname of the “Galapagos of Plate Tectonics”. Once in Woody Point, we have some time to explore the town, visit the park’s Discovery Centre and have a little stroll in one of the Tableland’s valleys.

All good things must come to an end, and so we bid a fond farewell to our newest yet oldest province. We transfer to Deer Lake airport for our early evening flight home, replete with many delightful memories of an authentic Newfound experience that will be recalled for years to come!
