October 6, 1967 | Sold to Findlay Theaters Inc—which is part of the Jack Armstrong Circuit.

The theater was eventually sold to Stern Associated Theaters/Cinemette. In

1987 | Cinemette was sold to Cinema World. It finally closed in.

1990 | CLOSED and the drive-in was demolished. A Lowe's Distribution Warehouse was built on the site.

Evel Turning Tranquil Pasture To Grandstand

TWIN FALLS, Idaho (AP) — A small patch of rocky pasture, populated by grazing sheep, cows and horses won't be so tranquil for the next week and a half. Evel's coming.

The pasture is the starting point for Evel Knievel's celebrated motorcycle jump over the Snake River Canyon on Sunday, Sept. 8. It all goes on promoters' legs. The spectacle could be watched by a live audience of 50,000. A closed-circuit television show and, eventually, nationwide television could bring the event to millions of viewers.

The quiet pasture on the south side of the Snake River Canyon is being transformed to include big crowds for up to a week. Also to be squeezed in are a track for motorcycle races, television towers and even a grandstand to hold an expected 250 newsmen.

Basically, the stunt is this: Knievel, a motorcycle stuntman from Butte, Mont., is to mount his Sky Cycle and blast across the quarter-mile wide canyon. He hopes to parachute to safety on the north side of the canyon as the Sky Cycle floats down attached to another parachute.

The Sky Cycle is labeled as a rocket-powered motorcycle but is basically a rocket. The launch will be up a steel ramp set a few hundred feet from the canyon, pointing skyward at 56 degrees. The cycle is to cover 4,781 feet, giving Knievel a 1,000-foot margin for error on the landing side. Promoters say the rocket likely will travel farther than Knievel himself.

It sounds simple. But a steady stream of tourists and curiosity-seekers has been parading to the launch site, peering down into the 500-foot deep canyon and muttering: "No way."

The basic problem is the rugged canyon itself. It's an area of spectacular scenery, sheer cliffs dropping abruptly hundreds of feet to the boulderstrewn Snake River below.

The view can't be seen even a few yards from the edge. It isn't until you step to the very edge of the cliff that the canyon itself can be seen.

Then there's the problem of where the stuntman can land. The north side of the canyon, the landing area, is filled with jagged lava rock outcroppings, sagebrush and dry grass and little else. Local residents have used the area for years for target practice, and about the only signs of civilization are empty shotgun and rifle shells. There are few flat spots.

The northside land is state and federal owned, and authorities plan to close it on jump day.

"Our local people, who know the canyon, sometimes fall over so what are you going to do with strangers?" asks Twin Falls County Sheriff Paul Cordeur.

After a successful test run, Knievel's support group is to be staying behind the project. A local attorney, James May, has been handling legal arrangements, and the promoters have picked Idaho residents wherever possible to live out other problems.

Prices charged for permits have become a sore point.

The state first announced it would grant Knievel a permit for \$500 to land on the north side. Trip Bank, Inc., the permitting agency, has been covering private land on the south or launch side.

Then the state land board decided it wanted to up the fee to \$2,000. State officials also offered exclusive radio and television broadcasting rights from the landing area for \$50,000, but there were no takers.

The Federal Bureau of Land Management controls much of the land in the impact area. That agency has decided to charge Knievel \$2,000 for a permit, plus 1.25 per cent of the gate receipts.

The federal agreement also calls for the BLM to get .375 per cent of the state and television money.

Donnie Branker, in charge of arrangements for the network, which has exclusive rights, says he thinks the state hasn't been acting in good faith, announcing one fee, then jacking it up.

"It would cost us \$50,000 for the permit and more to set up the equipment. So we're going to charter two helicopters for \$15,000 and shoot the whole landing from the air," he said.

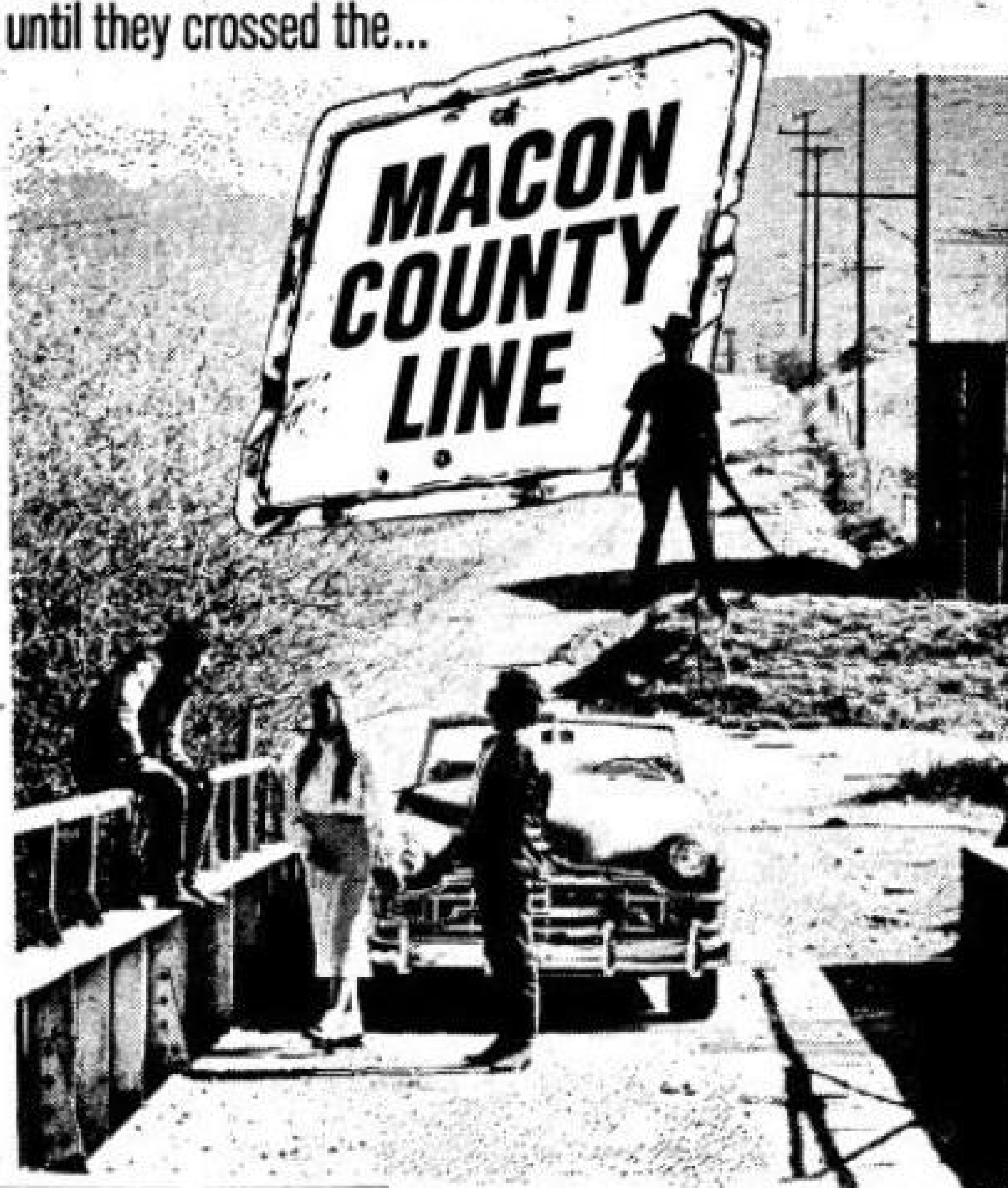

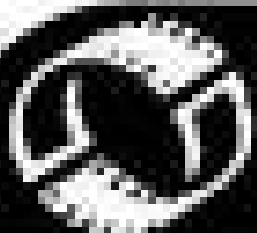
Steinman To Head Findlay Theaters
