

June 10th 1967 | The Millstream Drive-In opened

The opening feature was "The Professionals" starring Burt Lancaster, Lee Marvin, Robert Ryan, Jack Palance, Ralph Bellamy and Claudia Cardinale The second feature of the evening was "Born Free" with Virginia McKenna and Bill Travers.

The 600 car capacity drive-in was built by Millstream Amusement's Inc. which was a partnership of James R. Wiswasser, D. Neil Clark and Charles J. Hendricks.

October 6, 1967 | Sold to Findlay Theaters Inc—which is part of the Jack Armstrong Circuit.

The theater was eventually sold to Stern Associated Theaters/Cinemette. In

1987 | Cinemette was sold to Cinema World. It finally closed in.

1990 | CLOSED and the drive-in was demolished. A Lowe's Distribution Warehouse was built on the site.

Men Arrested In Chase Charged With Larceny





The quiet pasture on the week side of the Stake Street Conyon is being tranalteranced the hearding long consents that out the acweek. Also to be squeezed in are a track for motorcycle races, television towers and even a grandstand to hold an expected 250 newsmen.

Basically, the stunt is this:

Knievel, a motorcycle stuntman from

Butte, Mont., is to mount his Sky Cycle and blast across the quarter-mile wide canyon. He hopes to parachute to safety

on the north side of the canyon as the Sky Cycle floats down attached to another parachute. The Sky Cycle is labeled as a rocketpowered motorcycle but is basically a

rocket. The launch will be up a steel ramp set a few hundred feet from the canyon, pointing skyward at 56 degrees. The cycle is to cover 4,781 feet, giving Knievel a 1,000-foot margin for error on the landing side. Promotors say the

rocket likely will travel farther than

Knievel himself. It sounds simple. But a steady stream of tourists and curiosity-seekers has been parading to the launch site, peering down into the 506-foot deep canyon and mut-

tering: "No way." The basic problem is the rugged canyon itself. It's an area of spectacular scenery, sheer cliffs dropping abruptly hundreds of feet to the boulderstrewn Snake River below.

The view can't be seen even a few yards from the edge. It isn't until you step to the very edge of the cliff that the canyon itself can be seen.


Then there's the problem of where the stuntman can land. The north side of the canyon, the landing area, is filled with jagged lava rock outcroppings, sagebrush and dry grass and little else. Local residents have used the area for years for larget practice, and about the only signs of civilization are empty shotgun and rifle shells. There are few flat spots.

The northside land is state and federal owned, and authorities plan to close it on jump day.

"Our local people, who know the canyon, sometimes fall over so what are you going to do with strangers?" asks Twin Falls County Sheriff Paul Corder.




