Practical and emotional help before the move

Here are just a few examples of how we can help you prepare for your home move. Preparation and planning are key to ensuring things go smoothly and will save you time, stress, and money in the long run.



Furniture floor planning

This can really help you decide on what to take with you and what could be surplus

Decluttering your home

Sometimes clients get to a point in the sale & purchase when they



Help after move day


Move day itself can be lengthy and tiring – we often return at a later date to continue with support including any further unpacking and orientating you to the new area.
