## 耀中幼教學院歡迎自資專上教育委員會來訪 展示幼兒教育卓越成就 YCCECE Hosts CSPE Delegation and Showcases Excellence in Early Childhood Education



耀中幼教學院於4月2日歡迎自資專上教育委員會（CSPE）代表團到訪，此次會面彰顯了學院在創新幼兒教育領域的領導地位，以及對推動香港自資專上教育發展的堅定承諾。

是次訪問為耀中幼教學院提供了重要平台，向委員會展示其獨特特色的課程體系。學院課程注重理論與實踐相結合，並融入前沿研究成果，致力培養能配合幼兒教育發展需求的專業人才。院方代表重點介紹了以學生為本的教育理念、與業界的緊密合作關係，以及培養高素質幼教專業人員的辦學宗旨。

會談期間，耀中幼教學院就課程優化、畢業生就業競爭力，以及自資院校在豐富香港高等教育多元發展中的關鍵角色等議題分享見解。學院同時強調可持續發展和政策支持對提升自資教育質素的重要性。

After returning from further study overseas, Cathy was appointed as the Founding Chinese Principal of Harrow Haikou International School in Hainan Province in 2019, and has also been serving as a Founding Advisory Board Member and Vice-President of the non-profit Network for Enriching Students and Schools in China (NESSIC). She holds dual MBAs from the Hult International Business School in San Francisco, USA, and Beijing University of Aeronautics and Astronautics in China. Additionally, she earned her Bachelor's degree in English from the Dalian University of Foreign Languages in Dalian, Liaoning Province, her hometown.

## 03. 訪問台灣國立政治大學教育學院 visit Taiwan National Chengchi University - College of Education

Professor Eric Cheng Chi Keung, Vice President (Academic) of the College, led over 20 faculty and students to visit the National Chengchi University College of Education in Taipei on 2 June. This marked the first exchange between the two parties in Taipei, aimed at exchanging insights on the development and current situation of early childhood education in Hong Kong and Taiwan.

Attendees included Professor Yu Min-Ning, Dean of the College of Education and other faculty members from the College of Education and Early Childhood Education Graduate Institute at National Chengchi University: Dean Yu Minning, Institute Director Guo Zhaoyou, and Professor Ni Mingxiang. YCCECE faculty representatives include Assistant Professor Carly Ng, and lecturers Zhang Dandan and Pan Ruifeng. The visiting delegation also toured the affiliated kindergarten of National Chengchi University, gaining insights into the curriculum practices and development of the outdoor classroom.

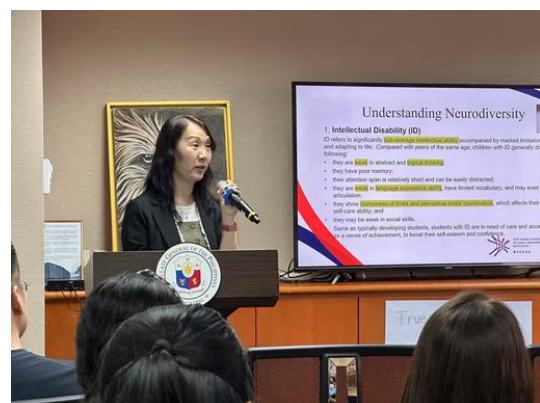
## 04. 賦能菲律賓照顧者 Empowering Filipino Caregivers

學院與菲律賓駐港總領事館攜手舉辦了名為「PCG Talks – 跨境關愛」的研討會，旨在支持和提升香港菲律賓籍照顧者社群，活動於6月22日舉行，吸引了眾多充滿活力的照顧者參與，共度一日的學習、分享與賦能。

研討會由耀中幼教學院職業治療師兼助理教授張鳳儀博士主講，題目為「賦能照顧神經多樣性兒童的照顧者」，內容既具啟發性，為照顧神經多樣性兒童的照顧者提供了實用技巧與情緒上支持，幫助他們更有信心地應對照顧工作中的挑戰。

In a meaningful collaboration to support and uplift the Filipino caregiver community in Hong Kong, the College partnered with the Philippine Consulate General to host "PCG Talks – Caring Across Borders" on 22 June.

Led by Dr. Phoebe Cheung, an Occupational Therapist and Assistant Professor at YCCECE, the seminar focused on empowering caregivers of neurodiverse children, offering practical strategies and emotional support in an engaging and informative session that fostered learning, connection, and empowerment.







## 第四屆親子探索式 學習嘉年華 - 光影派對

### HKJC "CoolPlay" Project 4th "Parent-Child Exploratory Learning Carnival – Light & Shadow Party"

由香港賽馬會慈善信託基金捐助，學院聯同香港基督教服務處合辦的賽馬會「智·幼·趣」計劃，自2023年第二階段展開以來，一直秉持「兒童為本」理念，為幼教同業及家長提供創新教學資源、培訓及支援，引導幼兒從校內以至日常生活中實踐「探索式學習」，培養創意、溝通及合作等21世紀關鍵技能。

計劃中的年度盛事「親子探索式學習嘉年華」於3月29至30日在觀塘海濱道發現號03場地再度舉行，今年以「光影派對」為題，設置11個充滿樂趣與教育意義的攤位遊戲，包括首屆「幼稚園角落設置比賽」的一眾獲獎學校參展。讓幼兒能夠透過遊戲，主動認識、觀察及學習，並勇於提出問題並嘗試解難，藉此培養探索精神。一連兩日的免費活動，吸引逾2,000名幼兒與家長參與。

Supported by The Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust and co-organized the College and Hong Kong Christian Service, the Jockey Club "CoolPlay" Project has upheld a child-centred philosophy since its 2nd phase launched in 2023. The project provides innovative teaching resources, training, and support to early childhood educators and parents, guiding children to adopt exploratory learning—both in school and daily life—to develop essential 21st-century skills such as creativity, communication, and collaboration.

The 4th edition of the Jockey Club "CoolPlay" Project's "Parent-Child Exploratory Learning Carnival – Light & Shadow Party" took place on 29-30 March in Kwun Tong, featuring 11 interactive game booths designed to encourage young children to actively explore, observe, and learn through play. This year's event fostered problem-solving skills and a spirit of inquiry by motivating children to ask questions and seek solutions. Additionally, the inaugural "Kindergarten Learning Corner Design Competition" winning schools showcased their innovative setups. The two-day free event attracted over 2,000 children and parents.





“ Dr. Brad Chan from YCCECE said: "This year's carnival takes light and shadow as its theme, with the creative approach of transforming an abstract concept into a form that young children can experience firsthand. Unlike traditional activities, our design allows children to independently explore, discover questions, and seek answers, nurturing their curiosity about the world. The theme of light and shadow not only sparks multisensory interest but also naturally guides children to explore everyday phenomena—this is the essence of inquiry-based learning."

耀中幼教學院陳裕榮博士表示：  
「今年嘉年華以光影為主題，別具創意之處在於把抽象概念轉化為幼兒能親身體驗的形式，不同於傳統活動，我們的設計讓孩子能自主探索，發現問題並尋找答案，培養他們對世界的好奇心。光影主題既能引起多感官興趣，又能自然引導孩子探索日常生活現象，正是探索式學習的精髓所在。」

### 關於計劃 *About Project*

第二階段計劃將涵蓋全港約八成為初生至3歲嬰幼兒提供服務的幼兒中心，惠及包括15間參與計劃的幼兒中心、其他幼稚園暨幼兒中心、各大社會服務單位、相關家長及社區人士。本計劃旨在透過跨專業領域協作，為參與計劃的幼兒中心提供教顧實踐的專業啟導，致力提升幼兒教師專業能力，並進一步推動家長教育及社區參與的支援，促進幼兒服務的持續優化與發展。

Phase Two of the programme will cover approximately 80% of child care centres across Hong Kong that serve infants and toddlers under 3 years old. This includes 15 participating child care centres, other kindergartens-cum-child care centers, major social service organizations, relevant parents, and community members. The programme aims to enhance professional practice in participating centres through cross-disciplinary collaboration. It is committed to strengthening the professional capacity of early childhood educators, promoting parent education, and encouraging community engagement, thereby supporting the continuous improvement and development of early childhood services.

### 啟動禮 *Launching Ceremony*

賽馬會幼兒「喜步」計劃第二階段啟動禮於5月10日假學院市區分校禮堂舉行。典禮很榮幸邀請到社會福利署助理署長（家庭及兒童福利）鄧鳳梅女士、香港賽馬會慈善事務總經理（人才及業界發展）曾芷詩女士以及學院校長暨兒童發展講座教授李敬廉教授蒞臨主禮。當日出席嘉賓匯聚了不同幼兒教育及社會服務的業界同工，如幼兒中心、幼兒學校、鄰里支援幼兒照顧計劃服務隊、社區客廳試行計劃服務隊及家長等，共同見證計劃的重要里程碑。

The Launch Ceremony for Phase Two of the Jockey Club “Step Up” Programme for Early Childhood was held on 10 May, at the auditorium of the College’s City Campus.

The ceremony was honored by the presence of Ms. Chow Fung-mei, Assistant Director (Family and Child Welfare) of the Social Welfare Department; Ms. Tsang Tsz-sze, Executive Manager (Talent and Sector Development) of The Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust; and Professor Kerry Lee, President and Chair Professor of Child Development of the College.

The event brought together guests from various sectors of early childhood education and social services, including representatives from child care centers, kindergartens, neighborhood support child care service teams, community living room pilot project teams, and parents. # 賽馬會「點亮·亮點」計劃 SPARK & SPOT PROJECT



## Fostering Connection and Innovation: Jockey Club Spark & Spot (Spark & Spot) 賽馬會「點亮·亮點」：促進連結與創新

賽馬會「點亮·亮點」第二期計劃於學院舉行了一場充滿活力的啟動禮及茶聚活動。活動在6月4日於田灣校園舉行，現場氣氛熱烈，充分展現出合作與交流的精神，為這項具深遠影響力的計劃揭開新一章。

此計劃是一個三期的專業發展計劃，第二期共涵蓋31間學校，包括15間經公開招募參與計劃學校，其餘亦有來自本港四個重要慈善機構包括：香港明愛、香港基督教服務處、香港基督教女青年會及救世軍香港分會。這次計劃的擴展反映出賽馬會「點亮·亮點」計劃在推動幼兒教育包容性與創新實踐方面的日益影響力，正滲透社會更多角落。

茶聚活動邀請了第二期參與學校的校長與主任，同時亦迎來香港賽馬會慈善信託基金及四個慈善機構的代表。此外，大會亦邀請了服務供應商及專業教練，到場分享及促進與會者之間的深入交流與連繫。



The Jockey Club Spark & Spot Project officially launched its Cohort 2 with a vibrant Tea Reception held at the College. The event, which took place at the College's Tin Wan Campus, creating a lively and collaborative atmosphere to kickstart the next phase of this impactful initiative.

Structured as a three-cohort programme, Cohort 2 includes 31 participating schools, with 15 independent schools joining from outside the four partnering school sponsoring bodies—Caritas Hong Kong, Hong Kong Christian Service, Hong Kong Young Women's Christian Association, and The Salvation Army Hong Kong. This expansion reflects the growing reach and influence of the Jockey Club Spark & Spot Project in promoting inclusive and innovative practices in early childhood education.

The reception brought together school principals and head teachers from Cohort 2 schools, alongside representatives from the Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust and the four sponsoring bodies. Also in attendance were service vendors and part-time coaches, who played a key role in facilitating meaningful exchanges and fostering connections among participants.

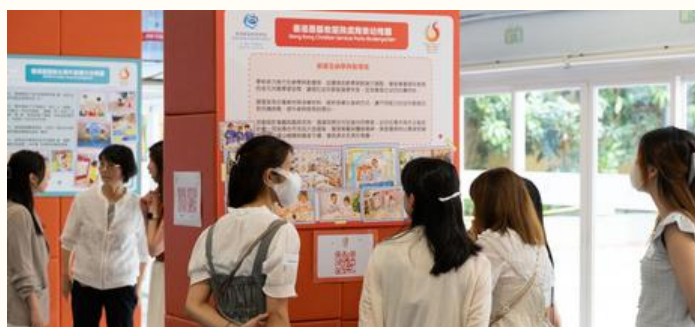
## 第一期學校專業發展課程圓滿舉行 Project Concludes Cohort 1 Final Professional Development

這次活動不僅是為期十節專業發展課程的總結，更象徵著21間參與學校的「畢業典禮」，標誌著他們在提升幼兒教育環境方面邁出了重要一步。

6月2日，學院20多位師生出發往台北，訪問台灣國立政治大學教育學院、學校及體驗各種文化交流活動。他們參觀了大學附設幼兒園，深入了解戶外教室的課程實踐及發展歷程。

學生們更參與了幼兒肢體運動課程與實踐培訓工作坊，親身體驗多種形式的運動遊戲，感受動感遊戲的樂趣，並增加了對幼兒運動教育的理解。此次交流活動對於促進兩地的幼兒教育合作具有重要意義，為未來的合作奠定了良好的基礎。

Twenty faculty and students traveled to Taipei on 2 June. They visited the National Chengchi University College, schools, and experienced various cultural enrichment activities. Students have toured the affiliated kindergarten of National Chengchi University, gaining insights into the curriculum practices and development of the outdoor classroom. What's more? They also joined a physical exercise class and practical training workshop, experiencing various forms of physical games. They enjoyed the fun of these activities and enhanced their understanding of physical education for young children. This exchange activity is significant for promoting cooperation in early childhood education between the two regions and lays a solid foundation for future collaboration.



## 學生研學：上海探索之旅

### A DISCOVERY TOUR IN SHANGHAI



逾20名師生前往上海展開為期六天（6月1日至6日）的探索研學之旅。此行由學生發展處策劃，結合學術學習、文化探索、社區服務及課外活動，推動全人發展。

研學期間，師生參觀耀中耀華教育網絡旗下的幼稚園，這些學校同時也是「明師計劃」的合作夥伴。參與者將觀察多元的幼兒教育實踐與課程，將理論與實踐結合。

學生亦通過「希望種子」(Seeds of Hope) 計劃，與當地非政府組織合作，參與社區服務，培養社會責任感與同理心，支持上海社區。行程更包括參觀上海重要文化地標，深化對上海文化遺產及其對教育和社會影響的認識。



Over 20 students and faculty members went to Shanghai for a discovery tour from 1 to 6 June 2025. Organized by the Student Development Office, this programme promotes whole-person development by combining academic learning, cultural exploration, community service, and co-curricular activities.

During the tour, participants visited kindergartens within the Yew Chung Yew Wah Education Network (YCYW), our partner schools for the Yew Chung Yew Wah Teachers of Tomorrow program. They observed diverse early childhood education practices and curricula, connecting theory with real-world experience. Students also engaged in a community service project with a local non-government organisation (NGO) through the YCYW Seeds of Hope programme, fostering social responsibility and compassion while supporting Shanghai communities.





## 耀中幼教學院2024/25屆 專題研究專案展示會： 以兒童之聲重構教育實踐

### YCCECE Capstone Project Presentation Conference: The Class of 2024/25

5月26日，學院成功舉辦2024/25屆專題研究專案展示會，來自幼兒教育榮譽學士課程的應屆畢業生通過創新研究與實踐，展現了扎實的专业素養與教育熱忱。活動吸引了師生及行業專家等參與，現場反響熱烈。活動當天，耀中幼教學院校董會成員陳麗生博士及梁廣灝工程師作為嘉賓，並為獲獎學生頒獎。

本屆專題研究以「應對幼兒教育課堂內外的挑戰：傾聽兒童的聲音」為主題，學生聚焦特殊教育需求、遊戲化學習、STEM教育、語言發展、社會情感發展及身體發展六大領域，深入實習學校/教育中心開展獨立研究。值得一提的是，所有專案均將「兒童聲音」作為研究設計核心，讓幼兒真正成為教育研究的「共同建構者」。在學院導師指導下，學生們精準定位教育場景中的實際問題，有系統地收集分析數據。在展示會上，他們通過學術報告、成果展示等形式，生動呈現了研究成果，充分體現耀中幼教學院「理論結合實踐」的教學理念。



On 26 May, the College concluded the 2024/25 Capstone Project Presentation Conference. Our Bachelor of Education (Honours) in Early Childhood Education (BEdeCE) programme final year students showcased their robust professional expertise and educational passion through innovative research and practice. The event attracted faculty, students, industry experts, and guests, generating enthusiastic exchange and responses on-site. During the event, Dr Lydia Chan and Ir Edmund Leung, SBS, OBE, JP, members of Board of Governors, attended and presented awards to the winning students.



This year's Capstone Projects centred on the theme "Addressing Issues in ECE Classrooms and Beyond: Integrating Children's Voices." Students' work focused on six key themes: Special Educational Needs, Play-based Learning, STEM, Language Development, Social Emotional Development, and Physical Development. Notably, all projects placed "children's voices" at the core of their design, positioning young learners as "co-constructors" of educational research.

Under the guidance of YCCECE's Capstone Project Supervisors, these students have identified real-world challenges in educational settings and systematically collected and analyzed data. At the conference, they presented their findings through academic reports, visual displays, and interactive demonstrations, vividly embodying the college's pedagogical philosophy of "integrating theory with practice."

是次展覽是學院首次在公開展覽中推廣新研究生課程包括學位教師教育深造文憑和教育學碩士學位課程。家長及學生對於幼兒教育文憑、高級文憑及學士課程感興趣之外，對於學院提供研究生課程的全學段發展課程，全面照顧畢業後的進修階梯升讀更感到興奮。期間學院教師亦有駐場為學生解答升學問題及就業前景，亦有學生分享學習生活點滴。



YCCECE joined the Information Expo on Multiple Pathways 2025 (Info Expo) organised by the Education Bureau (EDB) from 23 to 24 May. The show was held at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre. With the participation of around 30 post-secondary institutions and organisations, the latest information on multiple pathways is provided to senior secondary school students, parents and teachers with a view to better preparing students for further studies and career paths.

It is the first time YCCECE showcased its latest Postgraduate programmes at an expo, including the PGDE (ECE) and Master of Education programmes. Parents and students are interested in the Diploma, Higher Diploma and Bachelor's Degree programmes in Early Childhood Education, and are also excited that the College offers full-stage development programmes for postgraduate programmes to take care of the progression pathway after graduation. During the Expo, teachers from the College were also there to answer students' questions about further studies and career prospects, and students shared their learning and life experiences.





## “Empower through Education: Discover YCCECE” Reception

On the evening of 16 June, YCCECE welcomed prospective supporters and community partners to its reception, “Empower through Education: Discover YCCECE,” held at Club Lusitano.
