Professor Kerry Lee Welcomes the Academic Year 2025/26 李敬廉教授喜迎2025/26學年



Professor Kerry Lee, President of Yew Chung College of Early Childhood Education (YCCECE), has welcomed the 2025/26 academic year with optimism and gratitude, highlighting a year of growth and innovation.

In his message to the College community, Professor Lee celebrated the launch of the PGDE-ECE and MEd programmes, noting the PGDE-ECE remains the only one in Hong Kong to award four professional licences, including for Special Child Care Workers. He also announced expanded accessibility through Chinese-stream courses and upcoming doctoral and undergraduate programmes in child development and psychology.

YCCECE's global reach continues to grow, with nearly 300 students from 13 countries joining last year. New scholarships for ASEAN and Belt & Road students, along with a major endowment fund, underscore the College's commitment to inclusive excellence.

Leadership updates include the appointment of Ms. Cathy Li as Vice President (Administration) and Professor Kaye Chon to the Board of Governors. Professor Lee also thanked Dr. Frank Lam for his donation of exercise equipment, enhancing campus wellness.

With a renewed focus on innovation and impact, YCCECE enters the new academic year poised to lead in early childhood education across Hong Kong and beyond.

耀中幼教學院 (YCCECE) 校長兼兒童發展講座教授李敬廉教授，於新學年開始之際向學院友好發表歡迎辭，回顧過去一年的重要發展，並展望未來的教育藍圖。

李教授表示，學院於去年成功推出學位教師教育深造文憑（幼兒教育）及教育學碩士課程，進一步鞏固其在幼兒教育領域的領導地位。其中學位教師教育深造文憑（幼兒教育）課程更是本港唯一可頒授四項專業資格的課程，包括特殊幼兒工作者的認證。

為促進教育普及與多元化，學院新增中文授課課程，並於本年度擴展碩士課程至中英文雙語教學，讓更多學員受惠。展望未來，學院正積極籌備博士課程及新增本科課程，涵蓋兒童發展、心理學等範疇，以回應社會對幼兒教育及心理健康專才日益殷切的需求。

國際招生方面亦持續擴展，去年迎來近300名來自13個國家及地區的學生，促進多元文化交流。學生亦參與中國內地、泰國等地的學術交流活動，拓展全球視野。

此外，學院推出面向東盟及「一帶一路」地區學生的全額獎學金，涵蓋學費、住宿及生活費，並成功設立首個大型捐贈基金及多項長期獎學金資助，為未來教育發展奠定穩固基礎。

新學年於8月1日展開，李教授歡迎新任副校長（行政）李岩女士及新加入的校董會成員田桂成教授，並感謝前副校長林文全博士捐贈健身器材，促進校園身心健康。

李教授強調，YCCECE將繼續在幼兒教育領域創新、啟發及領航，培育人才，推動知識發展，為香港及世界帶來深遠影響。

The College is proud to announce that our President and Chair Professor of Child Development, Professor Kerry Lee, and our Vice President (Academic), Professor Eric Cheng, have been recognised in the 2025 rankings published by Stanford University as part of the World's Top 2% Most-Cited Scientists. This esteemed acknowledgment highlights their remarkable global impact and academic excellence in research.

Professor Kerry Lee is honoured for both his career-long citation impact and single-year citation impact, while Professor Eric Cheng is recognised for his exceptional single-year citation impact.

This recognition not only reflects their individual achievements but also underscores the College's commitment to prioritise children's development through our unique educational approach.

Early Childhood Education Takes Centre Stage at Global Health Symposium

YCCECE contributed key insights to the Healthy Living Symposium 2025, held from 17 to 19 September in Budapest, Hungary. The international event, co-hosted by the HUN-REN Hungarian Research Network and the National University of Singapore, brought together leading experts to explore the future of health and human potential.

YCCECE's presentation focused on the transformative impact of early childhood education on lifelong health and cognitive development. Drawing from a large-scale intervention study conducted in Hong Kong, the College shared evidence-based strategies for mitigating the effects of poverty on young children.

The symposium also featured the "Yew Chung Approach" to teacher training, which integrates progressive pedagogy with cultural values to nurture a lifelong love of learning. This distinctive model reflects YCCECE's commitment to holistic development and educational equity.

YCCECE's participation underscored its leadership in global education research and its dedication to advancing early childhood education as a foundation for healthier, more resilient communities.

Future Makers Forum Tackles Educational Equity in the Age of AI

The “Future Makers, Thrive Together Forum,” hosted by The Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust on 22 and 23 August, brought together educators, community leaders, and policymakers to examine the widening learning divide in an era shaped by artificial intelligence.

A key plenary session titled “Learning Divide in the Age of AI – Is It Widening or Narrowing?” addressed the urgent issue of educational equity. Speakers explored how families, schools, and institutions can work collaboratively to ensure all learners have access to quality education, regardless of socioeconomic background.

The session featured insights on inclusive practices, community engagement, and institutional support, with a focus on practical strategies to bridge gaps in access and opportunity. Moderated by Patrick Sir, the discussion highlighted the importance of cross-sector collaboration in responding to the challenges posed by emerging technologies.

As AI continues to transform the learning landscape, the forum underscored the need for sustained efforts to create a more equitable and inclusive education system—one that empowers every student to thrive.

YCCECE to prepare the launch of the Bachelor of Social Sciences (Honours) in Child Development and Psychology Programme for 2026/27 intake

We are pleased to announce the successful accreditation of the Bachelor of Social Sciences (Honours) in Child Development and Psychology by the HKCAAVQ. The Programme has been formally approved to launch in September 2026, having met the stated objectives and QF standards at Level 5. This achievement marks a historic milestone for the College, representing our first Bachelor's Degree Programme to extend beyond ECE teacher training.

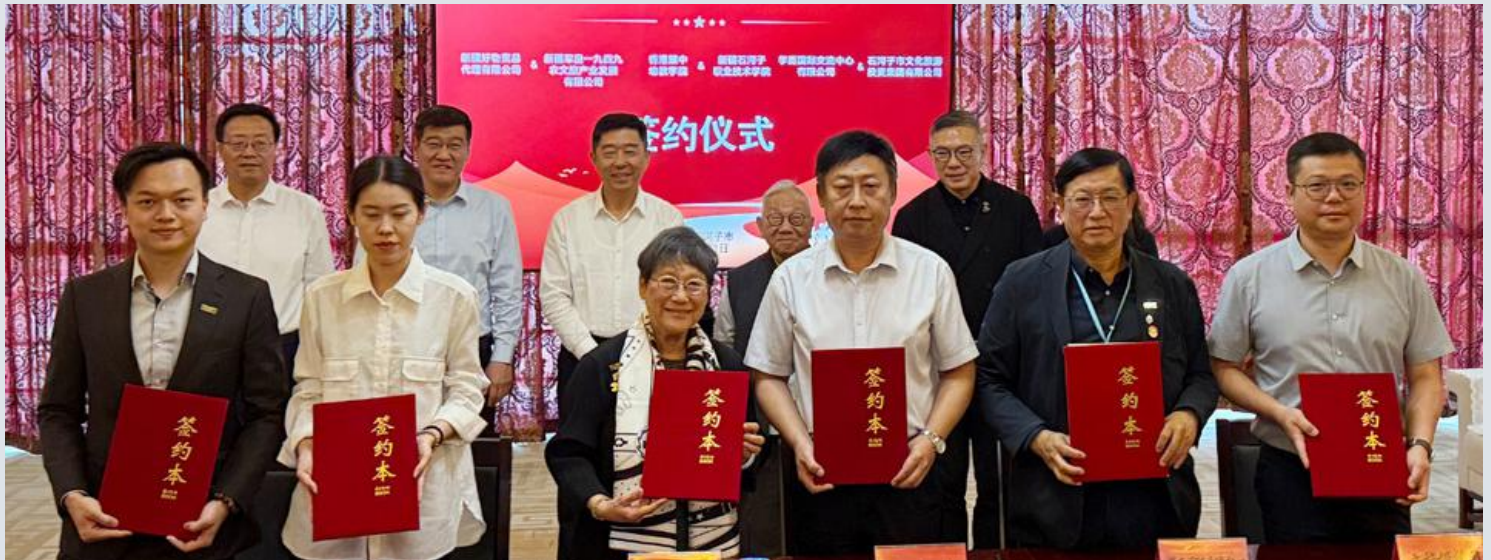

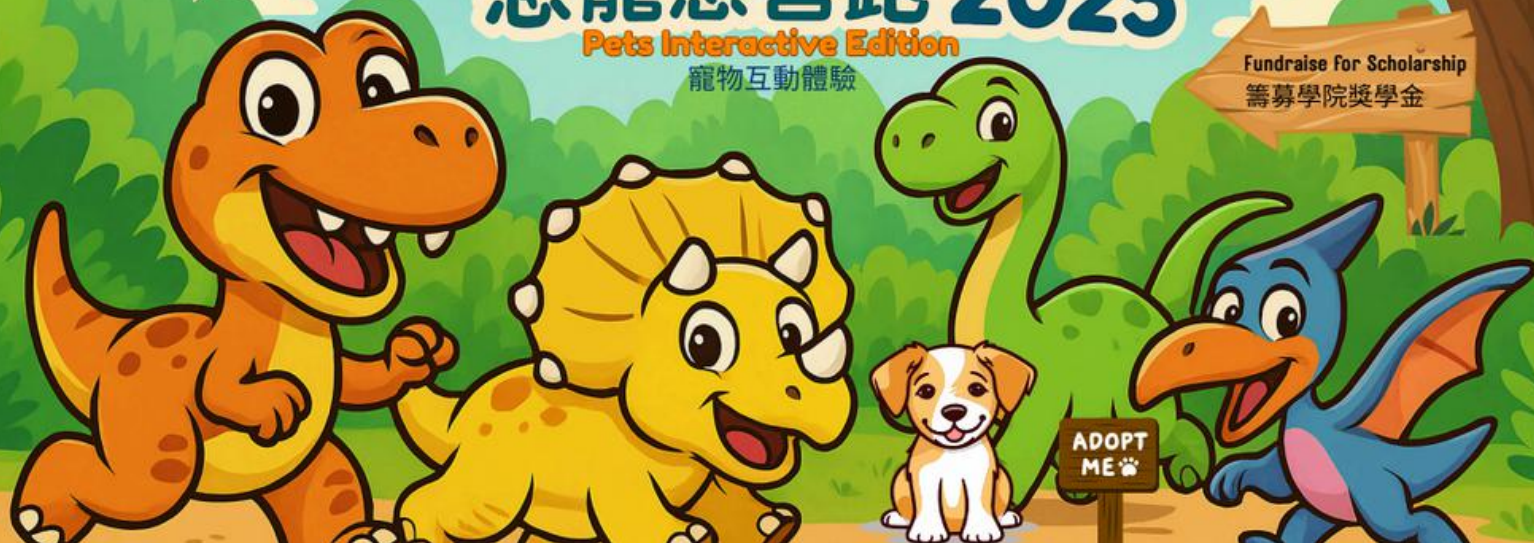
