Downtown Elgin Hotel

Plans to convert an historic downtown building into a 26-room, \$4.3 million boutique hotel will be partially funded with Elgin TIF funds. The Elgin House would include a small café on the ground floor at its 53-63 Douglas Ave. location, according to plans submitted by Chicago



Realty Ventures Inc., which purchased the McBride Building in October 2024 from Cuming Holdings.

The company is working with Atira Hotels, which will be a co-owner, to transform the top two floors into hotel rooms. Construction is expected to take about 14 months. Once completed, The Elgin House's nightly rates would be \$132 in the first year of operations. The hotel will have 15 employees, with the second floor having 12 rooms and the third floor with 14 rooms. Read More





Heading Into the Holiday Season: Holding Space for Grief

Join Kane County Health Department on Friday, December 12th from 9 am to 11 am for Heading Into the Holiday Season: Holding Space for Grief with Alison Stoll. Alison is a graduate from The Chicago School for Professional Psychology with a Master of Arts in Forensic Psychology. Currently, she works in private practice treating child, adolescent, and adult survivors of childhood trauma.

The holidays are often seen as a time of joy and connection, yet they can also bring feelings of grief, loneliness, and emotional exhaustion—especially for those healing from trauma or loss. This presentation offers a trauma-informed look at how to navigate the holiday season with compassion and resilience. We'll explore emotional exhaustion, the impact of collective stress, and practical ways to hold space for yourself and others during times of overwhelm. Participants will gain tools to recognize

stress responses, set boundaries, and cultivate new, meaningful traditions. This training is free, provides two CEUs, and Spanish language interpretation.


