CHURCH THATCH ROOF AND GLAMOUROUS GUTTERING!

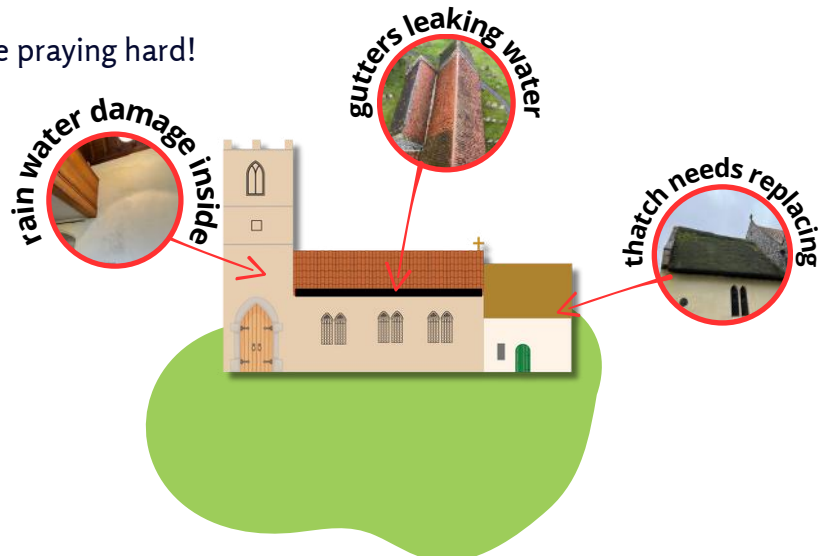
Revd Margaret met A T Cornfield on the 8 July, the contractors who are replacing the complex guttering in the V section of the church roof.

The work will be taking place in July and be completed by August. Revd Margaret will post updates on the church Facebook page and hopefully be able to have pictures of it finished for the next Horsford News.

Following a survey by Natural England, the thatch work has to take place between 15 September and 31 October 2024.

If we have raised the remaining funds needed (around £35,000) then we will be able to complete the work this year otherwise it will be next year. Three grants applications have been made for the urgent repair work on the thatch.
