

Empowering Women, Transforming Society

Sewa's Journey in Jharkhand

Women are the backbone of any prosperous society, and their empowerment is key to driving lasting progress. Without their active involvement and leadership, a thriving community is merely a dream. Recognising their potential, for the past eight months, Sewa SHE team has been tirelessly working in the Gumla district of Jharkhand, dedicated towards empowering women and girls, thus transforming lives and fostering hope amongst the community. To ensure a great impact, the team strategically chose 15 village clusters to implement interventions focused on health, hygiene, education, and skill development. Working closely with volunteers, school management, village panchayats, and the Block Education Officer, we set our sights on making meaningful changes.

Our journey began with addressing the most basic needs: sanitation. In the first phase, we identified and collaborated with eight schools within these clusters, constructing 32 new toilets that directly benefited 3,477 children. This simple yet vital step not only improved hygiene but also contributed to a safer and more inclusive learning environment. Beyond infrastructure, we recognized the importance of menstrual health and hygiene education.

Our team organised menstrual awareness camps and distributed reusable sanitary napkin kits to more than 500 adolescent girls.

These efforts helped break the stigma surrounding menstruation and empowered young women to take control of their health and well-being.

To promote mental wellness and physical confidence, we also hosted 14-day yoga and self-defence workshops in the schools. This unique approach fostered resilience and provided the tools needed for holistic development. But our commitment to empowerment didn't stop there. We understood that sustainable livelihoods play a key role in empowering women. Therefore, we offered skill development training in tailoring, bamboo weaving, and art, reaching over 80 women in these villages. Through close collaboration with village panchayats and local retailers, we established market linkages, enabling these women to earn a sustainable income from their newly acquired skills.

Together, we are making a lasting impact, transforming not just individual lives but entire communities.

" My father works as a milkman in cattle farming and my mother works as a maid, while suffering from severe back pain. My elder sister is pursuing B.Com with support from neighbours and grandparents."

Despite these challenges, Ananya has excelled academically, securing 96% in her SSLC exams and 94% in PUC (Science PCMB). She is also preparing for competitive exams like CET and NEET from home, as her family financial constraints prevent her from joining extra classes.

However, she doesn't let these hurdles stop her, rather she receives guidance from friends who attend such classes, demonstrating her resourcefulness and dedication.

Ananya expresses gratitude for the support provided by Sewa International, which has eventually lightened her family's financial burden. By understanding the impact that the program has had on her future, she dreams of giving back to her community by opening a hospital in her village to offer free medical treatment to the elderly. She also wishes to support other children's education in future, ensuring they have the same opportunities that she had. Her family is immensely proud of her achievements, and they share in her gratitude for Sewa International's assistance.

Empowering Minds to Shape the Future


