





Remembering the Queen

On Sunday 11th September at St Thomas' Winchelsea, we remembered the Queen.

We used her very words in worship, from across the years.

She said in 2000: 'For me, the teachings of Christ and my personal accountability before God provide a framework in which I try to live my life.'

We remembered that, and thought about our own accountability, and were challenged by it.

Of recent days the media has been full of examples of Queen Elizabeth's love, hope and steadfast perseverance for us all to see.

On her twenty-first birthday, in 1947, she pledged that her whole life, whether long or short, would be devoted to service of

her people. She asked that others join her in this, and that God would help her to make good her vow. Seventy-five years later looking a little frail, but still bright-eyed, she performed her last act as Queen, installing the latest UK Prime Minister. She had given the whole of herself, as she herself had said, 'with unwavering faith, a high courage, and a quiet heart.'

It was not without difficulty. On Sunday, again we quoted her own words, this time from 2011: 'Forgiveness lies at the heart of the Christian faith. It can heal broken families, it can restore friendships and it can reconcile divided communities. It is in forgiveness that we feel the power of God's love.' She added: 'God sent a Saviour with the power to forgive.'

I tried to discover if she had ever come

to Winchelsea, or passed through it, but my oldest informant, who as a young woman had gone to Melbourne to see the Queen, did not think so. The Geelong Advertiser on Saturday told us that the Queen and the Duke of Edinburgh had twice visited Geelong, in 1954 and 1988, but I could find no mention of Winchelsea. I guess plenty of local residents went off to see her.

There have been many reports of how people were touched by her kindness and care for so many individuals and organisations, not only here but across the world.

She said in 2013, 'God's love... is for everyone. No-one is beyond its reach.' We can see how she sought to demonstrated this throughout her life.

Our calling is the same, no different from that of a Queen!


