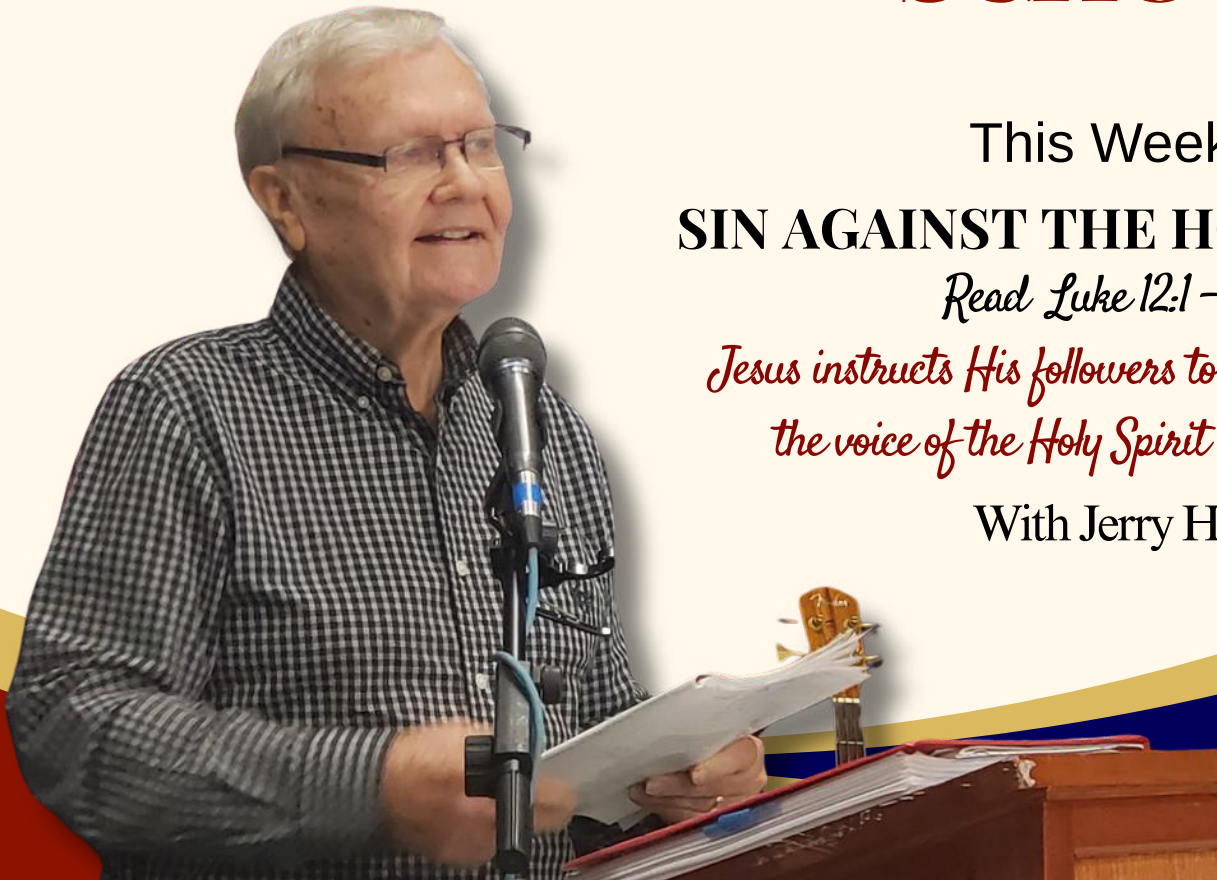

The Book of 1st Corinthians was written around 55 AD, during Paul's stay in Ephesus to address issues relevant to the Corinthian Church. It includes themes around Unity in the Church, Moral and Spiritual Integrity as well as Resurrection and hope in Christ.

*"And now these three remain; faith, hope and love.
But the greatest of these is love." 1 Cor. 13:13*



SYMBOLISM & IMAGERY

The Body of Christ

Paul employs the metaphor of the body to illustrate the church, highlighting that all believers represent different parts working harmoniously under Christ. This imagery underscores the significance of unity and interdependence.



Leaven (Yeast) - Leaven serves as a symbol of sin and corruption, encouraging believers to eliminate sin from their lives and strive for spiritual purity, similar to how a small amount of yeast can influence an entire batch of dough.



The Race and Prize - Paul compares the Christian life to a race, motivating believers to strive for holiness and the everlasting prize of salvation with perseverance. This analogy illustrates the necessity of discipline and focus throughout one's faith journey.

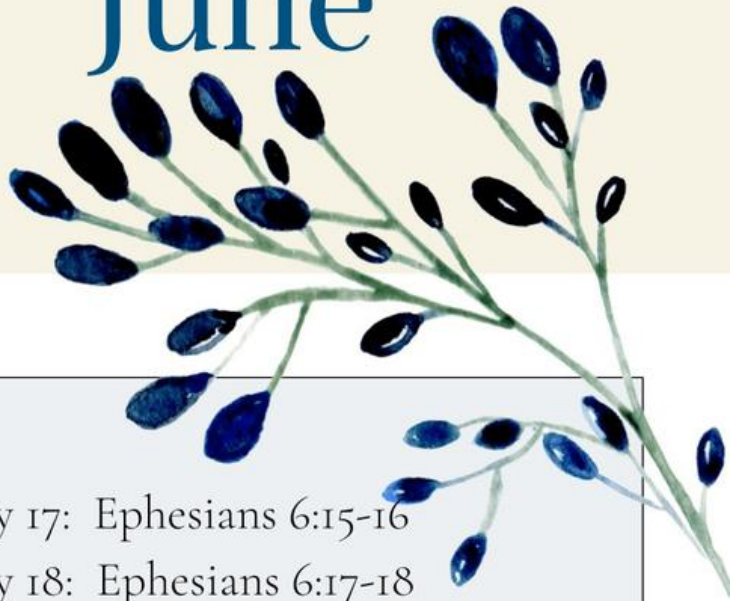

On behalf of our neighbors we serve, thank you from the bottom of our hearts for continuing to support your ministry of providing food to our neighbors who are experiencing food insecurity in our local community.

As of 6/2/2026, 3644 individuals representing 1222 families have visited our food bank

(1/27 and 2/3 closed due to the ice storm, and closed early on 4/28 due to the thunderstorm).

Ninety-eight percent of our neighbors live right here in Bellevue!
