Monasteries & Wachau Wines

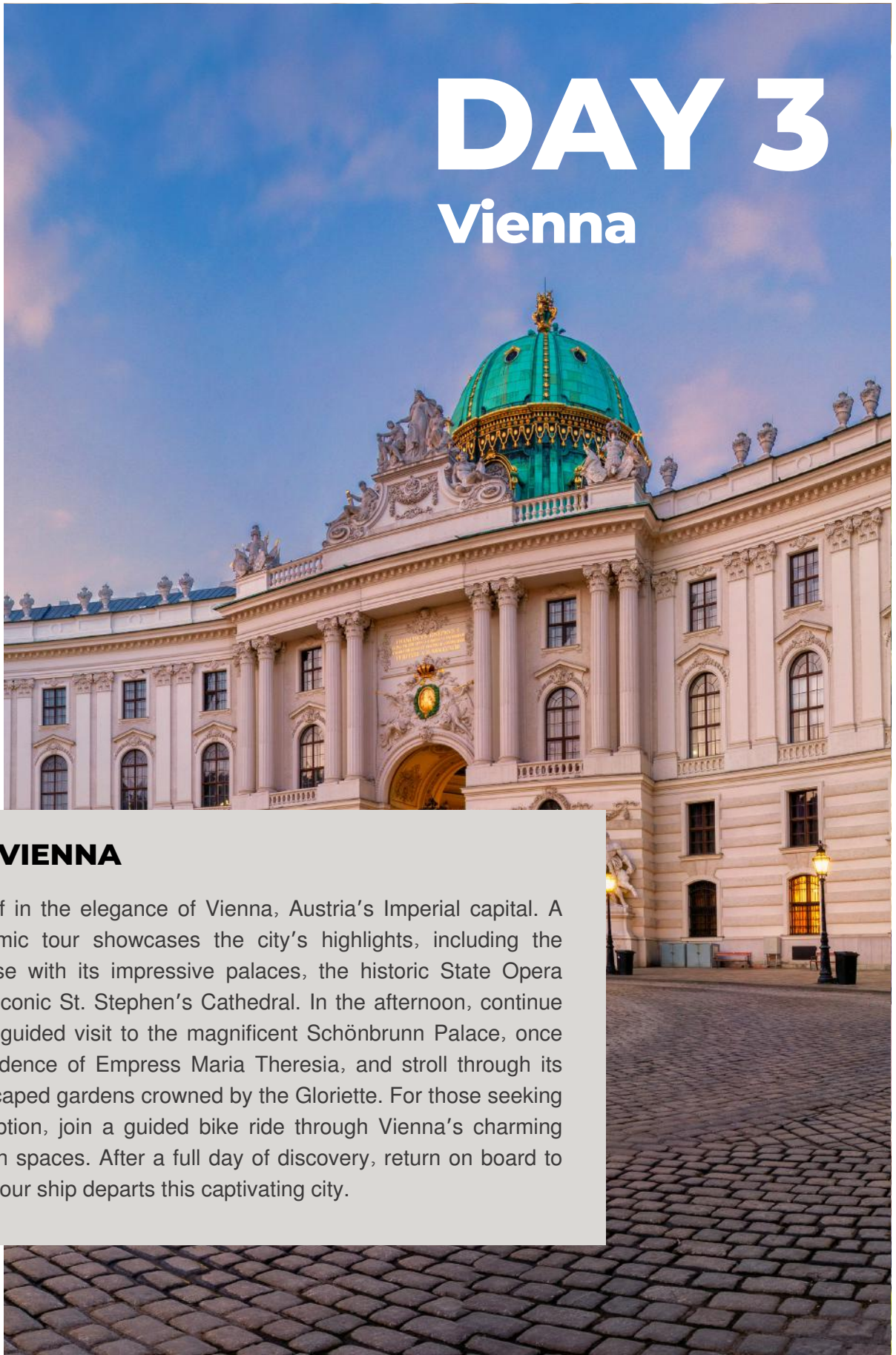

Vienna



IMPERIAL VIENNA

For those seeking a more active option, join a guided bike ride through Vienna's charming streets and green spaces. 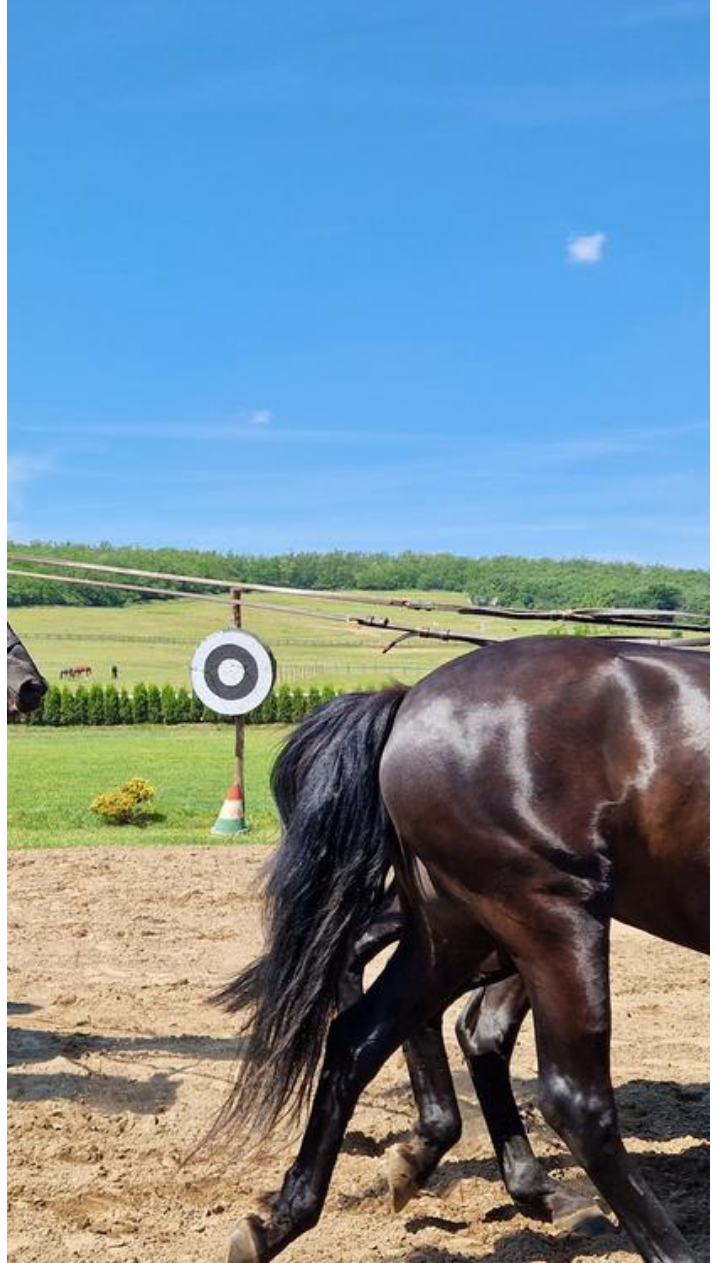
DAY 4
