Hand Stencilled Fabric

Tutor: Gina Pierce

Saturday 29 July | 10am - 12. 30pm | £20

Gina Pierce will introduce participants to the process of hand stencilling a tea towel. Using the stencils and dyes provided, participants will create their own designs on a tea towel to take home.

Slow Stitch on Linen

Tutor: Linda O'Kane

Friday 4 August | 10.30am - 12. 30pm | £20

An Introduction to the concept of a stitch journal, and how to develop a daily stitching practice. Using vintage linen and embroidery threads you sew a little each day with stitches that are easy to do. You finish with a tactile and beautiful piece of embroidery that is personal to you.



Glass Fused Landscapes

At this introduction to art glass, designed for beginners, you will learn how to design and craft two small glass landscapes. Your creations will be wave shaped which means that they can sit on a window sill to catch the sun and reflect dazzling colour around. Choose your colours, learn to cut and handle glass safely and with confidence, and watch demonstrations on techniques and designs.

Pottery

Tutor: Andrea McCullough Alderdice Tuesdays 8, 15 & 22 August | 7 - 9pm | £68

Experience the thrill of the potter's wheel and the pleasure of pinch pots in this short series of beginner's classes. We'll experiment with slip decoration techniques and our full range of glaze colours.

Handprint a Linen Scarf

Tutor: Rene Mullin

Friday 11 August | 10am - 1pm | £50

An introduction to traditional block printing on linen. Printmaker, Rene Mullin, works with Irish linen approved by the Irish Linen Guild, her art and functional accessories use screen, linocut, or mono printing techniques. Participants will be guided through the process of hand carving a lino cut stencil, and experimenting with colours and patterns. Then comes the designing and decorating, using their hand cut lino stencil to block print colours and shapes on their own Irish linen scarf.





Screen Print a Tote & a T-Shirt

Tutor: Rene Mullin Friday 11 August | 2 - 4.30pm | £45

An introduction to the principles of creating paper cut stencils for use in the delicate process of silk screen printmaking.

Participants will hand cut a paper stencil and learn how to prepare a screen for print. Design inspiration can come from any source, a garden, a print, Rene will help, and then guide in how to transform a plain tote bag and a t-shirt into something unique, to take home.



Ceramics Masterclass


Stitches and Stories

Kantha Quilting

Explore Indian Kantha stitching and find out how it can be used to decorate items for the home. Linda will demonstrate how to make a thin summer quilt reusing old house linens, then you will be guided in stitching your own elephant design pouch.

Paper bird making

Wildlife artist and keen birdwatcher Adele Pound will demonstrate how she creates her eye-catching paper birds. Then participants will be guided in the creation of their own bird decoration of choice, made using simple paper cutting techniques. Choose from a range of designs that includes the beautiful blackbird, sweet little robin and handsome kingfisher.

Candle-making

Tutor: Juliana Germinio Saturday 19 August | 1.30am - 3.30pm | £32

Making your own candles is a fun and healthy way to enjoy scent and a little glow. There's no nasties included when you know exactly what goes into your own hand prepared candles. Juliana will guide you through the process of creating your own bespoke, hand-poured soy candle. All tools and materials needed to assemble and pour your container candle are provided, and you can choose scent and colour from a specially curated library.



Wood Carving

Tutor: Geoff Tulip Saturday 26 August | 10am - 4pm | £52

An introduction to the traditional craft of woodcarving. The tutor, Geoff will guide participants throughout the day, explaining and demonstrating simple techniques in relief carving. Each attendee will learn how to create their own hand-carved piece to take home.

All tools and wood are provided for the duration of the workshop, and the day is suitable for absolute beginners.
