INTRODUCTION

The surviving Protestation Returns for Westmorland, which comprise those for the whole of both East and West Wards, are preserved in the House of Lords Record Office and are published here by permission of the Clerk of the Records. The returns are briefly listed in the Fifth Report of the Historical Manuscripts Commission.

The form of the protestation was as follows:

"I, A. B., do in the presence of Almighty God promise vow and protest to maintain and defend as far as lawfully I may with my life, Power and Estate the true Reformed Protestant Religion expressed in the Doctrine of the Church of England against all Popery and Popish Innovations within this Realm contrary to the same Doctrine and according to the Duty of my Allegiance His Majesty's Royal Person, Honour and Estate as also the Power and Privileges of Parliaments, the lawful Rights and Liberties of the Subjects and every Person that maketh this Protestation in whatsoever he shall do in the lawful Pursuance of the same; and to my power and as far as lawfully I may I will oppose and by all good Ways and Means endeavour to bring to condign Punishment all such as shall either by Force, Practice, Counsels, Plots, Conspiracies or otherwise do any Thing to the contrary of any Thing in this present Protestation contained; and further that I shall in all just and honourable Ways endeavour to preserve the Union and Peace betwixt the Three Kingdoms of England, Scotland and Ireland: and neither for Hope Fear or other Respect shall relinquish this Promise Vow and Protestation."

The background to the general taking of the Protestation Oath was the organised attack on Charles I's ministers and advisers. There was also a widespread suspicion that the forces being raised for Ireland posed a threat both to English Protestantism and to the Parliamentary opposition. The outbreak of the Irish revolt also had its effect on the atmosphere of hysteria which was developing in England. The taking of the Protestation was the result of a number of petitions against popery in high places

which were received by Parliament. Petitions from the counties were a means of exerting pressure on the authorities and, to the extent that they opposed official policy even by implication, they reflected a certain loss of control and initiative by the central government in the localities. There is no reason to suppose that they were spontaneous expressions of public opinion; in the twentieth century we have seen in some countries similar petitions as the precursors of political purges, the initiative for which remains within a fairly small group of influential persons. In 1641 such methods achieved some success; the anti-papist Protestation became general.

General oaths were common in the seventeenth century as means to massing political support and isolating opponents. For their success they depended to a great extent upon the strength of conscience in both supporters and opponents who in general would have regarded oath-taking as too grave a matter to allow perjury or even casuistry. Opponents were thus relied upon to condemn themselves. When the Protestation Oath was taken the taking of such general oaths had not yet become too frequent and so devalued.

The text of the Protestation eloquently expresses its timing in the development of the pre-Civil War crisis. It was Parliamentary in origin but by no means anti-monarchical. Indeed, superficially it was a very conservative document aimed only at defending existing institutions and removing, not the King, but those papists who were in positions of influence and power. The latter included those bishops whose practices were considered papistical. The text itself was such that only a small minority would have felt conscientious objections to taking the oath. Nevertheless such a comprehensive oath would have helped both to capture the middle ground and to polarise opinion, since the otherwise uncommitted would thus have lent their strength to the promoters of the Protestation.

The Protestation Oath was taken first by members of the House of Commons on 3 May 1641. Two days later its printing was ordered for distribution by the members to the counties and boroughs. Those who refused to take it were declared unfit to hold any civil or ecclesiastical office. Papists were thus to be isolated before a purge. A further spate of petitions urged the application of the Protestation to all men and this was ordered by the Commons on 30 July 1641. The return for Morland suggests

that the oath was taken in August 1641 but most returns were made in March 1641/2. They were referred to a Parliamentary committee to consider what was to be done with recusants. At this point the matter was overtaken by greater events; already military dispositions were in train which led within a few months to the Civil War.

The Protestation was apparently promulgated to the parish officers by the Justices of the Peace at Appleby on 3 March 1641/2 if the preamble to the return for Marton can be taken as a guide to general practice. The orders were mostly read to the respective congregations after Evening Prayer on 6 March, although in some places it happened on other dates. The men present then took the oath. This at least is how the returns usually represent it, but, since most are explicit that all the men of the parish were asked, it seems likely that a general call went out by word of mouth that non-attendance at church on this occasion would be regarded as proof of recusancy.

A purpose of the Protestation was to isolate committed papists and intimidate those in high places. The return for St Michael's, Appleby, suggests that there was some distrust of the real motives behind it. The postscript to this return contains a plea referring to the poverty of the parish and the age of its men, the implication being either that the return was regarded as a preliminary to a tax-assessment or, more probably, as a muster of the able-bodied for military service in the wars. Some support is given this by the fact that Bolton and Patterdale actually took the oaths from men aged between 18 and 60, an upper age-restriction which had no relevance to a listing of political supporters but which was the usual limit adopted for military musters of the civilian population.

Any listing of inhabitants before the official censuses of the nineteenth century should be examined for the light it might throw on population questions. Listings usually have limited usefulness because it is not always known how comprehensive they are in relation to the classes of persons they include. The Protestation returns, on the other hand, are apparently both complete and comprehensive. Whatever their limitations they are the best contemporary records which can be used to estimate the total population for a wide area. In the case of Westmorland they cover the whole of East and West Wards, sometimes called the Barony of Appleby, comprising more than half the county.

The returns are themselves usually quite explicit in declaring that the men of the entire parish or chapelry have been covered; in many cases it is stated that all men over eighteen have been included.

There is some debate as to the proportion of the population which fell into each age-group. In the absence of a better or an agreed figure, Gregory King's estimate of 55% being over eighteen could be adopted. In 1801 the proportion of males in the population of the same part of Westmorland was 48%. In estimating the total population this may be used since it is unlikely that conditions responsible for this would have changed much between 1642 and 1801. For Bolton and Patterdale, where only men between eighteen and sixty were included, Gregory King's figure of 10% being over sixty may be used. Adopting these factors we can estimate a total population of about four times the number of subscriptions in the returns.

A very rough check on this figure can be made by using the Hearth Tax returns for 1671, which are in the P.R.O. under E.179/195/73; these are very full and show both assessments and exemptions. If the entries are assumed to include all households, the assessed to include an average of 5.5 persons each and the exempted to include an average of 2.5 persons, a figure of total population for both East and West Wards can be constructed, differing little from that here constructed for 1641/2. These factors are of course both crucial and no more than guesses; it is suggested that the former is within usually accepted limits for the average household size at the time, here slightly weighted for the greater wealth of the class; it is also suggested that 2.5 is a reasonable estimate for the size of exempted households, many of which would consist of widowed persons and those where poverty meant no servants and a lower expectation of life.

The 1641 figure also accords quite well with Professor G. P. Jones's estimates given in *The Lake Counties 1500-1830* by C. M. L. Bouch and G. P. Jones.

The comparison between the estimates for 1641/2 and 1671 must be seen less as an attempt at accuracy than as an approximation or a relative figure. A parish by parish comparison between 1641/2 and 1671 is much less reliable. The multipliers are much less likely to represent the facts in individual parishes. Moreover the Protestation returns are based on ecclesiastical districts, whereas the Hearth Tax returns are based on townships. The respective boundaries were not always coincident, particularly where Orton, Shap and Crosby Ravensworth meet. In this comparison, however,

the townships have been grouped to give the nearest approximation. It may also be that in the thirty years between the two counts there could have been short-term fluctuations in individual parishes against the general trend for the period 1641/2 to 1801.

General conclusions which may tentatively be reached are that in 1641/2 the total population of the two wards was about 13,000 and that it increased by about 40% by 1801. Certain parts of the county did not participate in the general increase, losing people to the industrialising towns of neighbouring counties.

Only seventeen men are listed as actually having refused or deliberately omitted to take the oath. The name of Cyprian Hilton, of Ormeshead, is prefixed with a "D". This probably means "delinquent", as he was assessed as a recusant in the Lay Subsidy for 1628 (P.R.O. E.179/195/69). To these might be added one person from Crosby Garrett. In this parish return the preamble declares that the word "pro" precedes the names of the subscribers. By implication those not so prefixed were recusants; but as there is a signatory mark against one of the unprefixed names this conclusion cannot be drawn for more than three of the names if even that.

There are also named as recusants twenty-four women, three of whom were married to men whose names appear neither among the recusants nor among the protesters. It is therefore possible that these husbands could also be added to the numbers of recusants to make a total of forty-six. Most of those named were either gentry or their servants. How many Catholics there were among the yeomen and labourers, who, lacking the independence enjoyed by the gentry, thought it safer to sign, cannot be ascertained.

The returns are inconclusive as guides to the standard of literacy. The ability to write one's name is a very low level of attainment, but this is all the lists can provide. That many of the apparent signatures in the lists are scarcely legible, some not at all, supports this. Moreover many names written against marks are no more legible than some of the worst signatures. Most of the lists look as if they were completed at the time the oaths were taken; they are in very many different hands. Other lists are in the same hand and look to be fair copies of an original. Not all the lists include signatory marks, but, of those which do in any abundance, this is the proportion of marks to names: St Lawrance, Appleby 73%; St Michael, Appleby 81%; Crosby Garrett 89%; Musgrave 68%; Orton 57%; Ormeshead 61%; Patterdale 90%; Clifton 74%. There is a wide variation from one

parish to another which may be explained by the omission of many signatory marks. This would not be very surprising since the Protestation was properly sworn not subscribed. The overall impression is that fewer than 30% of adult males could pass even the lowest test of literacy.

In preparing this transcript the original order of the names has been preserved throughout. An index of all the names has been added in which each name is followed by an alphabetical symbol to denote the parish, chapelry or township list in which it can be found. In some parishes significant numbers of names are followed by a mark, often crude attempts at distinctive monograms. It has unfortunately not been possible to render these marks in a representation of the original; they are here shown as "X". If any name or part of a name cannot be rendered with any confidence the word or letters have been put into italics. Where even this is not possible for the present editor a blank has been left. Any words or letters appearing within brackets are this editor's own. Some of the original lists preface the names with the word "pro". Where there is any indication that this distinguished some names from others or that it added any significance otherwise absent the word has been included throughout the list.

Both the general Editor of the Society's Transactions and the editor of this particular volume wish to acknowledge with gratitude their indebtedness to the Trustees of the Curwen Trust, without whose generosity this edition could not have been published.
