## Harbor to Build Complete UK Post Production Studio at Turnmills in London, EC1

Harbor has broken ground on building a complete post-production studio spread across three floors in the Turnmill building in London's Farringdon.

The studio will offer end-to-end post production – dailies, offline editorial, picture finishing, sound post, ADR, and screening theaters. At the same time, Harbor will continue to offer dailies and screening services from its Windsor locations to support clients based at the studios west of London.

Until recently, Harbor's UK presence has offered dailies to a slew of productions including "The Midnight Sky," "Venom 2: Let There Be Carnage," "The Great Season 2," "The Northman," and "Invasion."

Commercial Director for Harbor, James Corless, stated: "We are so excited to announce our continued expansion into the UK post-production market. When we started our dailies services in the UK, we already had a roadmap to reach this point and despite the many challenges presented in the last two years our commitment as a business to the UK creative industries has never wavered. We have always believed that Harbor could bring something unique to London's post-production offerings, and I can't wait for the clients to see what we have planned at Turnmills."

Founder and CEO of Harbor, Zak Tucker, commented on this expansion:

"Our expansion into London has always been a part of our mission to serve filmmakers through artistry and innovation. We have always wanted to offer artists and filmmakers the opportunity to collaborate across disciplines under one roof – and now that roof spans geographies. We've seen it already with our current footprint – dailies in London, color finishing in North America – where we offered our clients a streamlined workflow for color grading and sound post from set to screen."

The original building was a warehouse that became the iconic Turnmills nightclub venue during the 1990s and early 2000s, which gained a reputation as a hub for modern dance music culture.

The location's history at the heart of the creative arts will help set the tone for the next phase of Harbor's expansion in the UK as it nurtures the next generation of filmmaking talent.

Harbor's new studio stands at the junction of the upgraded Farringdon station where the new east-west Crossrail will meet the upgraded north-south Thameslink and London Underground.


Commenting on the arrival of Niles and Vale's new role, Harbor's founder and CEO Zak Tucker said:

## JULIEN ALARY





#### SENIOR COLORIST

## VINCENT TAYLOR






#### AFTER YANG

An Alexander Weinstein short story adapted by Sundance alumnus Kogonada (Columbus), *After Yang* premiered at this year's Cannes Film Festival.

When Yang — a lifelike, artificially intelligent android that Jake and Kyra buy as a companion for their adopted daughter — abruptly stops functioning, Jake just wants him repaired quickly and cheaply. But having purchased

Yang "certified refurbished" from a now-defunct store, he's led first to a conspiracy theorist technician and then a technology museum curator, who discovers that Yang was actually recording memories. Jake's quest eventually becomes one of existential introspection and contemplating his own life, as it passes him by.

An aesthete at heart, Kogonada only vaguely hints at the futuristic science

fiction setting (and accompanying climate catastrophe), instead crafting a serene, meditative, compassionate story that inverts the trusted theme of robots exploring what it means to be human, by showing a human trying to understand this artificial being who was part of his family. Punctuated with humor and joyousness, After Yang's quiet power lies in its timely contemplation of how we create meaning and experience loss.



#### JEEN-YUHS: A KANYE TRILOGY

One fateful night at Jermaine Dupri's birthday party in 1998, Coodie, a Chicago public access TV host, first interviewed 21-year-old up-andcoming hip-hop producer Kanye West. Inspired by the film *Hoop* Dreams, Coodie started to document West's life to see how far his dreams would take him. When West moved to New York City to land a record deal, Coodie followed with camera in hand. He recorded West for years, from the hustle of his budding producer days through his rise to global icon. You think you know Kanye West, but you really don't.

You can't manufacture a project like Jeen-yuhs: A Kanye Trilogy; it takes decades of vision, commitment, prayers, and perspective to produce. It seems providential that Coodie &

Chike should be the ones to make the definitive film about West's career thus far, as they were the filmmakers who introduced him to the masses with their documentary music video for "Through the Wire." This epic three-film documentary features hours of fly-on-the-wall footage and paints a sweeping portrait of one of pop culture's most controversial figures.

It's the waning days of summer for four friends Dina, Lola, Daisy, and Mari, who will soon be going their separate ways when they all start middle school. While planning how to spend their last weekend together, they stumble across a mystery that takes them on a life-changing adventure. The friends make a series of discoveries that are as much about solving the mystery as they are about learning the hard truths of growing up.

Director James Ponsoldt (The End of the Tour, 2015, and The Spectacular Now, 2013) returns to the Sundance Film Festival with a film for every generation. Anchored by engaging performances from its youthful cast and a strong script from Ponsoldt and co-writer
Benjamin Percy, Summering is a
refreshing rarity when compared to the
familiar animated and special effects driven movies usually directed toward multi-generational audiences today.

#### MASTER

SUNDANCE/ SXSW

At an elite New England university built on the site of a Salem-era gallows hill, three women strive to find their place. Gail Bishop (Regina Hall), just instated as *Master*, a dean of students, discovers what lies behind the school's immaculate facade; first-year student Jasmine Moore (Zoe Renee) confronts a new home that is cold and unwelcoming; and literature professor Liv Beckman (Amber Gray) collides with

colleagues who question her right to belong. Navigating politics and privilege, they encounter increasingly terrifying manifestations of the school's haunted past... and present.

Writer-director Mariama Diallo's first feature is an ingenious blend of horror, drama, psychological thriller, and social critique. Through a deeply unnerving aesthetic, *Master* demonstrates the

expressive power of genre storytelling, delivering a visceral and emotional reflection on racism and white supremacy. What begins as a search for belonging becomes a chilling struggle for survival, and Diallo shrewdly reframes a basic horror trope — escaping an evil force — asking what escape is possible for communities of color confronting a racial terror that is everywhere.

BLOOD

Widow Chloe (Carla Juri) travels to Japan for work where she is welcomed by an old friend, Toshi (Takashi Ueno).

Sliding between the melancholy of loss and the awe of perspectives changed, Chloe wanders an unfamiliar landscape where love has carved all the guiding grooves. *Blood* explores the site where fragile love can emerge from immovable pain. With quiet restraint, fresh rhythm, and unforgettably rich

performances, this subtle study of togetherness and apartness captures the vibrancy of internal life.

Writer-director-producer Bradley Rust Gray observes the resilience of life and love, the surprise of desire, the barriers of language, and the staggering impact of relationship.

In this tacitly potent piece, Gray proves the gentle power of his directorial hand. Blood marks the return of partners and longtime collaborators Gray and So Yong Kim to the Sundance Film Festival after the world premiere of Lovesong (cowritten by the duo and directed by Kim) in 2016.

Their deft understanding of romance and finely tuned meditative style is displayed gorgeously by this new work.

#### WHEN YOU FINISH SAVING THE WORLD

From his bedroom home studio, high school student Ziggy performs original folk-rock songs for an adoring online fan base. This concept mystifies his formal and uptight mother, Evelyn, who runs a shelter for survivors of domestic abuse. While Ziggy is busy trying to impress his socially engaged classmate Lila by making his music less bubblegum and more political,

Evelyn meets Angie and her teen son, Kyle, when they seek refuge at her facility. She observes a bond between the two that she's missing with her own son, and decides to take Kyle under her wing against her better instincts.

In his carefully observed, aesthetically pleasing directorial debut, Jesse Eisenberg adapts his audio project of the same name to tell the story of a mother and son who fail to understand each other's values. With gentle humor and pitchperfect dialogue, When You Finish Saving the World reflects a moment of internet fame and youth activism, but it also recounts the timeless tale of parents and children struggling to connect across the generational chasm that separates them.
