

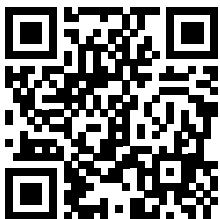

Safety is our #1 Priority

NEVER...

- Stand on the road
- Stand below the level of the road
- Sit close to the road
- Stand in front of fences or objects preventing you from moving quickly
- Stand in front of signs or arrows
- Remove rally signs or arrows
- Be distracted

- Stay ALERT and expect the unexpected
- Stand in a safe location
- Listen for approaching cars
- Remain alert
- Leave yourself room to move quickly
- Keep children under supervision
- Obey rally officials
- Help the officials to run a safe stage

STAGE CLOSURE AND OPENING

Tarmac West has permission from the local government authority and the Commissioner of Police to close the roads for competition. All roads, gates and driveways leading onto the rally stage need to be closed off by manning, taping and tagging. To ensure the safety of the public, officials and the crews the following procedure will take place.

- Before the road closure time, unused gates will be tagged
- At the road closure time the roads will be closed and officials will begin to tape and tag all driveways and gates
- Before the Rallysprint starts, the Safety Official Car 000, will inspect that all roads, gates and driveways have been closed
- Safety Official Car 00 will then check that all officials and the public are in a safe location
- A few minutes before the stage starts, Safety Official Car 0, with flashing lights and sirens will be a warning that the stage is about to begin
- The TSD (without cages) and the T130 will start competing
- After the Tarmac130 cars, the Competition Rally Cars will then commence
- They will be followed by the Official Car FIV with a medical team to check on the safety of the stage
- Once all competition is finished, Official Car SWEEPER with a GREEN FLASHING LIGHT will then traverse the stage notifying Officials to open up roads, driveways, gates and remove Chicanes from the road
- The Tape & Tags will be removed and the roads will then be opened to the public



SPECTATOR INFORMATION CAR

This vehicle provides residents with Spectator information. It traverses the course between 60 and 30 minutes before the first competitor.



ADVANCE 1 CAR

These vehicles assist the Officials in the setup of the stage. They are also available to assist residents to enter or leave their properties after the roads are closed and before the competition starts. They traverse the course between 60 and 30 minutes before the first competitor.



CAR 000 & CAR 00

Car 000A checks the stage is set up correctly and spectators are in safe areas. It passes approximately 30 minutes before the first competitor. Car 00 re-checks the stage is secure and reports to Rally Command that the competition can begin. It passes approximately 15 minutes before the first competitor.



Targa 130 to TSD

These vehicles warn the spectators and residents that the competition is about to start. Car 0A passes approximately 5 minutes before the first Targa 130 Car and conducts another safety check to ensure residents and spectators are in a safe location. Car 0B conducts another check before the Competition Category Cars commence their runs.



MIV & RALLY RESCUE & RECOVERY CARS

The MIV & Rally Rescue cars carry medical and rescue personnel. They may travel at various times along the competition route to attend an incident. They always follow the last rally car through to ensure all crews finish safely. They are also available to attend any resident's emergency. Simply call the emergency number.



SWEEP CAR (GREEN FLASHING LIGHT)

This vehicle travels approximately 15 minutes behind the MIV after the last running of the stage. Many stages run two to four times, and the Sweep Car provides safety for the officials by opening the driveways and roads. No spectator or resident's cars may have access to the competition route until this car passes with its GREEN flashing light.

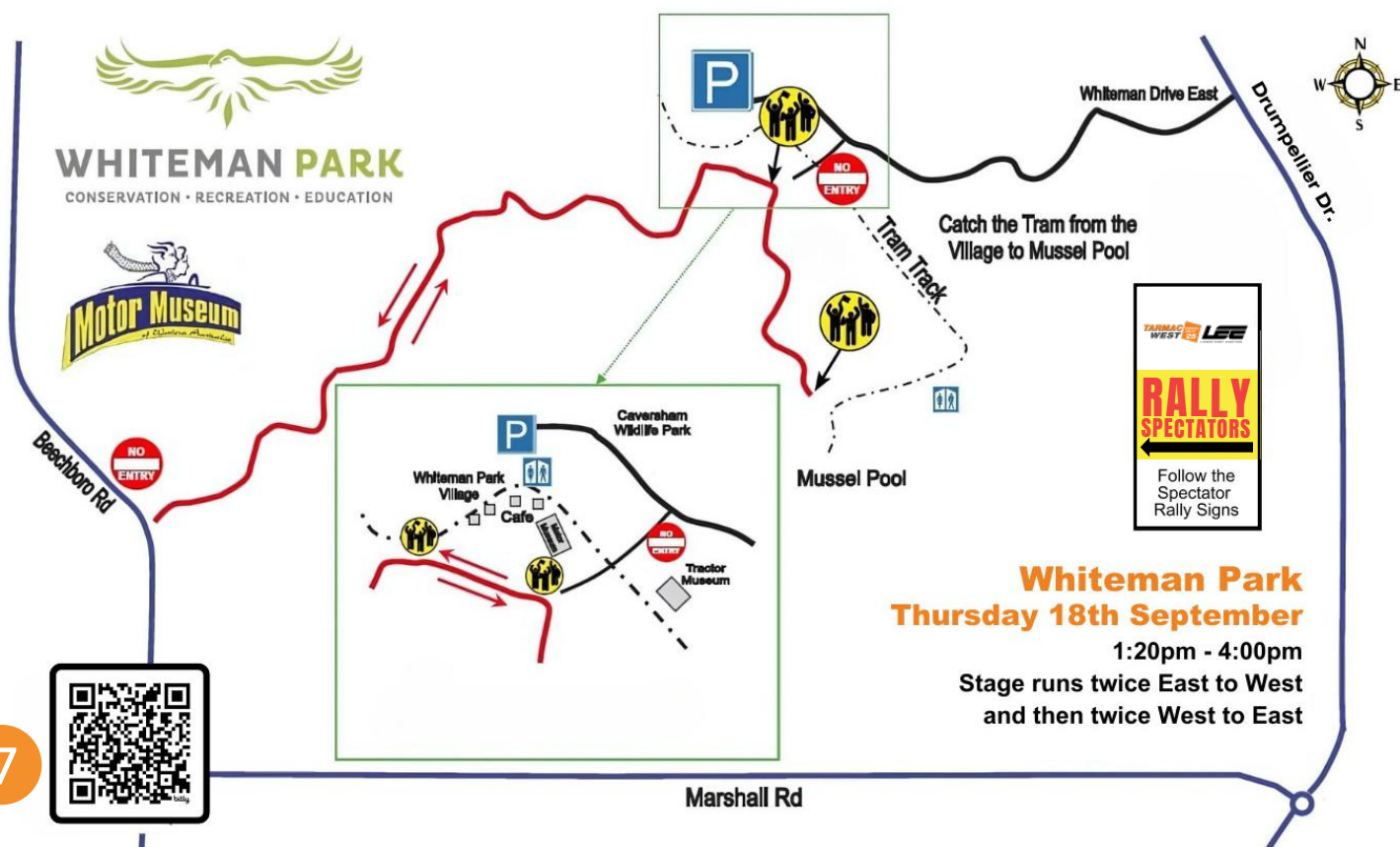

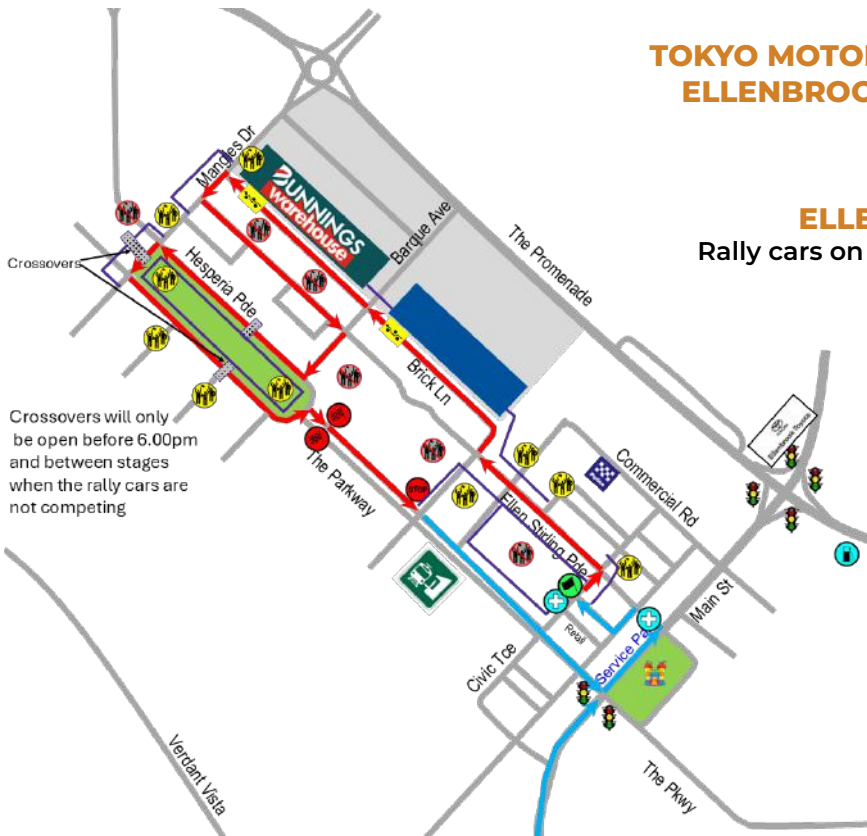

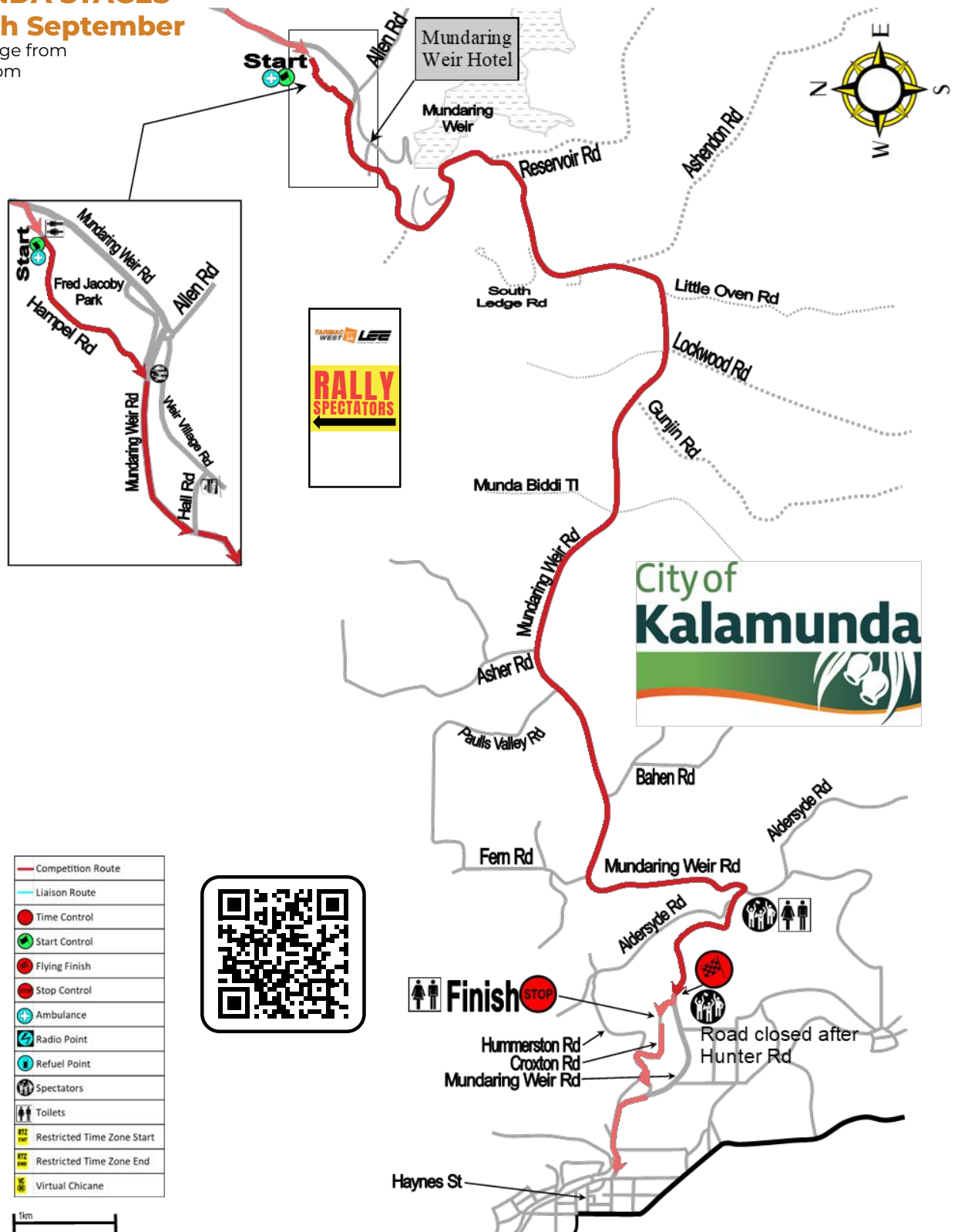

SEPTEMBER RALLYSPRINTS



The Lance East Exotic September Rallysprint is an add on event we started running as support events for Tarmac West. Competitors who are unable to enter Tarmac West can do the Rallysprints.

The event runs on the Ellenbrook, Malaga and Perth City Stages. In Ellenbrook & Malaga the cars will run 4 times, starting before and finishing after the Tarmac West cars that do 3 runs.

In the City both groups do 3 runs.

The Rallysprint cars can either be eligible for Tarmac West or they can run with more freedoms that are permitted for the smaller stages, hence they can be faster than the Tarmac West cars.

We also run a category for the gravel rally cars, they run with gravel tyres.

THE ENGINE SHOP PERTH CITY SPRINT



The Engine Shop Perth City Sprint has been run for almost as long as Tarmac West. When we first started running in the City, close to 20 years ago, having the track set up, it was decided to allow other cars to use it before Tarmac West came to town.

It originally ran though the Point Fraser Car Park and up and down Riverside Drive. We now start on Riverside Drive and go through the Terrace Road Car Park twice before finishing on Riverside Drive.

The Perth City Sprint is for drivers only, no Co-Driver is this event. We also allow for open top cars and no cages due to most of the stage being slower than most rally stages. It also allows for a wider selection of cars.

They will all get 4 runs of the stage.

Awards will be presented on the BMW Stage at 12.30 in the middle of Langley Park.
