#### **Refund/Cancellation/Transfer Policy**

Refunds will not be made on any cancellation unless notice has been given to the Parks & Recreation Call Center at 237-1386 AT LEAST 10 days prior to the date of the reservation or start of the program. No refunds/rescheduling for inclement weather on the day of a facility rental. There is a \$10 processing fee for transfers or cancellation (rentals under \$100) and a \$30 processing fee for transfers or cancellations (rentals over \$100). If less than 10-day notice, you forfeit all fees.

# **Scholarship Programs**

Des Moines Parks and Recreation offers two different scholarships.

#### Greater Des Moines Recreational Activity Scholarship Program (GRASP)

Discount program for families to receive 50–75% off recreational activities offered through Des Moines Parks and Recreation.

# Youth Recreational Scholarship Program (YRSP)

Offered in partnership with Des Moines Public Schools (DMPS) and allows students to receive \$5 swim lessons and/or youth sport experiences.

#### **Qualification Criteria**

Des Moines residents with a qualifying household income. Total income based on number in household. For family sizes exceeding 8, add \$12,850 for each additional person.

Students enrolled in Des Moines Public Schools who qualify for free and reduced fees based on their household income.

#### **Eligibility Verification**

Verification of total income through IMPACT Community Action Partnership using approved list of documents (i.e. paycheck, taxes, etc.).

Call (515) 518-4770 to set up an appointment with IMPACT at one of their two locations.

Opt-in for Des Moines scholarship program via DMPS website. Promoted during annual enrollment. Available anytime on DMPS website.

### Registration

After obtaining a GRASP card from IMPACT Community Action Partnership, community members can activate registration discounts through CivicRec by contacting the Des Moines Parks and Recreation Administration Office.

To confirm the child's eligibility on the approved DMPS list (opt-in required first), please reach out to Des Moines Parks and Recreation Office. Once verified, participant accounts will be updated, enabling electronic registration via CivicRec.



Players will enhance their patterns of play, vary spin and shot depth and select appropriate footwork patterns. 
#### **Rose Garden Deadheaders**


